5A. Superintendent's Report

i. I wish to personally thank Ashley Black and Mathew Cabanilla for declaring their interest in working as a school board member for Nicollet School district and running in Election 2024. Welcome to an exciting four years of service. I'd also like to thank the voters of District 507 for participating in the write-in opportunity and electing Abbi Carleton to the Nicollet School Board. Welcome!

ii. Personal Device and Cell Phone policy update: The cell phone recommended policy will be presented at the January 8, 2025 Board meeting for second reading and review. The Superintendent would like to provide more information for discussion and have the newly appointed Board members who begin in January 2025 to decide on the final policy. The superintendent is currently collecting information from staff and making revisions to the first reading. The final reading would be at the February 12, 2024 Board meeting prior to the March mandate for policy to be made.

The elementary K-4 has had zero problems with the current handbook expectations. There have been zero reports of misuse of personal devices.

Students 5-8 are all following the expectations of the handbook. They place their personal devices in their locker at the first bell. They request permission to check their devices at lunch and keep them in their locker until the last bell of the day.

We had a couple of problems with phones in locker rooms at away games and prior to games. The superintendent dealt with the incidents by contacting parents, meeting with the AD, and requesting coaches provide reminders and guidelines for use of cell phones at practice and games.

Students 9-12 struggle with the expectations. Many are used to taking their phones out when finished with their work. Some are not complying the first time when asked by the teacher to put it away. Most of the violations happen with the students in grades 11 and 12.

An assembly was held at the beginning of the quarter November 4, 2024 to review the handbook and provide students in 11 and 12 grade the opportunity to understand the expectations and consequences.

The superintendent will be recommending that we assert the 5th-8th grade expectations and add a grade each year until no cell phone is used or present during instruction. The plan is to Grandfather the practice of allowing cellphones in the classroom to eventually end.

iii. The MSBA conference is January 16 and 17, 2024. 2025 School Board members and Robin are registered for the conference. MSBA is offering new Board training Phases 1-3 on January 14 and 15, 2024. Robin has welcomed the newly elected Board members and shared the conference dates with them. If they are able to attend the early bird training sessions, Robin will register herself and the two new members for the valuable training.

iv. Staffing changes have occurred in the first quarter of school this year due to unexpected illness. The personnel report reflects some of the changes. Lee Ann Johnson was hired to finish the year as second grade teacher. Tom Murphy has been assigned Elementary Intervention Specialist for the remainder of the year. We continue to look to build a substitute call list and we have a minimum of one full time para position still available for the 2024-25 school year.

v. Staffing for 25-26 School Year - The superintendent will be meeting with Jim Freihammer to discuss the budget for 25-26 and begin looking at staffing adjustments and recommendations for the 25-26 school year. The Master Scheduling committee will meet for the first time this year and begin looking at the curriculum catalog to edit and create opportunities for students. We are planning on having a revised catalog and Master schedule prepared by February 1, 2025 so we can begin the process of registration in March of 2025.

vi. The auditors and Jim Freihammer are completing the FY 24 financial audit. They will present the audit to the school Board on December 11, 2024.

1. Elementary: Teachers reviewed UFLI implementation, discussed best practices and problem-solved common issues. Teachers reviewed MCA math data and began identifying Priority Standards in Reading and Math
2. Middle School: Teachers reviewed MTSS for work completion and the school's behavior procedures as written in the student handbook. Teachers also began identifying Priority Standards in each content area.
3. High School: Reviewed MTSS for work completion and the student handbook with a focus on attendance.

[READ Act](#)

READ Act Update:

There are 3 major components of the READ Act: assessment, science of reading training, and curriculum. Below is an update of where we are in our process to meet the requirements of the mandate.

1. Assessment:
 - a. FAST assessing is complete. The state is mandating an additional testing window during the winter, including the addition of the nonsense word assessment
 - b. Parents of students who did not meet the fall benchmark were notified by mail
 - c. Students who did not meet the fall benchmark are receiving a reading intervention and regular progress monitoring
2. Science of Reading Training (CORE OL-LA): Several teachers have already completed their coursework from CORE OL-LA. Teachers are working at their own pace to complete this coursework by July 1, 2025.
3. Curriculum
 - [UFLI](#) Foundations is being implemented in all K-3 classrooms. Teachers are using the lessons to provide explicit and systematic phonics instruction to all students.
 - *We will wait to purchase and implement a new comprehension/knowledge building resource until the 2025-26 school year.*


