# People Working. Lives Improved.



**Goodwill Industries of Southwest Oklahoma and North Texas provides services to people with disabilities and disadvantages through our programs.**

## **Workforce Development Center**

Our Workforce Development Center provides vocational rehabilitation services to people with disabilities as well as those with disadvantaging conditions. Goodwill strives to restore an individual's dignity, self-respect and self-worth through integrated programs of evaluation, personal adjustment and skills training resulting in permanent employment.

## **Adult Day Service**

Our Adult Day Service is a community-based group program designed to meet the needs of functionally impaired adults. This is a structured, comprehensive program that provides a variety of health, social and other related support services. Regular day service attendance can give working families the comfort of knowing their loved one is being cared for by licensed and certified health care staff.

## **Youth Service (For Youth with Special Needs)**

Goodwill's Youth Service provides a safe place for special-needs youth in the Lawton/Fort Sill community. A DHS Licensed Center with certified staff operating during the school year with a before and after school program and all day during summer with a summer camp. Each youth has an individual plan of service to meet his or her needs to help reach their full potential.

## **Career Development Center**

Goodwill's Career Development Center helps people gain and maintain employment at their highest level of ability by learning various skills through services such as career assessment and exploration, resume building, interviewing skills, online job search techniques and dressing for success. Through workshops and one-on-one instruction, we strive to help each individual find a job to ensure their continued success.

## **Goodwill's Maximum Independence Scholarship**

Goodwill awards 15 scholarships annually to graduating high school students that meet the required criteria. Scholarships are in the amount of \$1,000 and can be used at technical/trade schools and 2-year and 4-year colleges.

## **Voucher Program**

Non-profit organizations that participate in our Voucher Program receive vouchers in exchange for goods donated to Goodwill. Vouchers are given out by our non-profit partners to those in need and can be redeemed in any of our store locations.

## **Professional Janitorial Service**

We offer a high quality cleaning service at a competitive rate. Our cleaning service is available on a contract or non-contract basis, provided daily, weekly or as needed during the day or after hours. Our service includes, but is not limited to, professional office cleaning, carpet/tile/floor and bathroom cleaning.

## **Goodwill Housing**

A 74 apartment unit that provides housing and services specially designed to meet the physical, social and psychological needs of elderly citizens and individuals with disabilities. Our goal is the health, security, and independent living of our residents.

## **VITA**

A free income tax return service provided by IRS Certified Tax Preparers, available during tax season at some of our stores.

## **Retail Store & Donation Center Operations**

Our donors and shoppers allow us to provide services to those with disabilities and disadvantages in our community. Through the sale of donated goods at our seven retail stores, we are able to fund our many programs. Goodwill puts 85% of the revenue generated from these sales back into maintaining and growing our programs.

Our retail store/donation centers are located in Altus, Chickasha, Duncan and Lawton in Oklahoma and Vernon and Wichita Falls in Texas.

## Services Provided:

## Benefits Offered:

**Medical Help** – We utilize prevention programs designed to avoid problems before they start, such as monitoring existing medical conditions, assistance with self-care, diet recommendations and rehabilitation assistance from professionals.

**Social Opportunities** – Adults have a chance to meet with others about the same age and/or circumstance, enjoy organized activities designed for their age group or special needs, and work together on group projects.

**Emotional Support** – We can help support those who feel inadequate or incapable, remind people that they are not alone in their problems or fears, and encourage participants to try new activities and continue those they have always enjoyed.

**Renewed Interest in Life** – We provide a schedule for each day of activities and encourage participation in these activities. We promote focusing on the future, not the past. We even help some find the desire to go on living their life to the fullest and enjoying each new day.

## Participants Rights

- To be free of mental and physical abuse
- To be treated as an adult with respect and dignity, regardless of race, color or creed
- To participate in a program designed to encourage learning, growth, and awareness
- To maintain one's independence
- To attain self-determination
- To be cared for in a supportive atmosphere
- To have privacy and confidentiality
- To be free of restraints
- To have access to a telephone to make or receive calls
- To be free of interference, coercion, discrimination, and reprisal

## What is Adult Day Care?

Adult day care is a community-based group program designed to meet the needs of the functionally impaired adults. It is a structured, comprehensive program that provides a variety of health, social, and other related support services.

## Who needs Adult Day Care?

Most participants are older adults or individuals with disabilities who may need some help in self-care or require supervision. For example they may be:

- Partially Dependent on Others - We assist people who can manage some of the tasks of daily living and do not need round-the-clock care.
- In Need of Good Nutrition - Hot, balanced meals and snacks are provided for our participants. Special diet accommodations are also available.
- Social Isolation - Many older adults don't get out often or have the opportunity to socialize. We provide activities and a place to socialize.
- Physically Impaired - We provide activities for our participants recovering from stroke, surgery, or those with disabilities, Parkinson's or other diseases and disorders.
- Mentally Confused - We offer structured activities and individual care to help those with Alzheimer's disease, dementia, and other disorders allowing them to stay involved in everyday life.

## Assistance for Caregivers

Caring for a loved one requires both time and energy. It can be an exhausting, full-time job. Regular day care attendance can give families time to meet their own needs, while having the comfort of knowing that their loved one is being cared for by licensed or certified professional care staff.

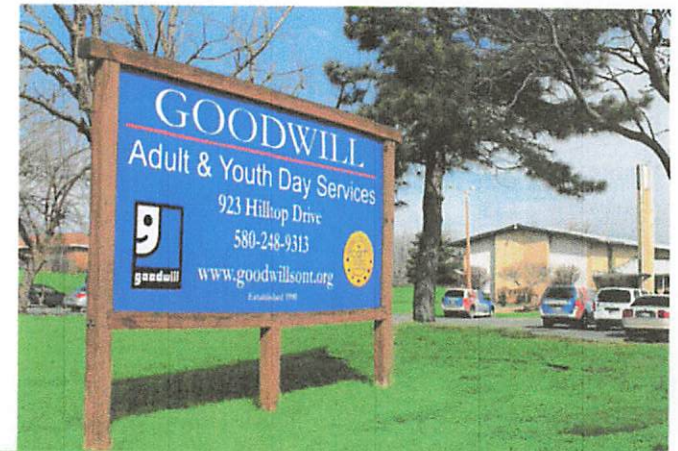
