Consider approval of canvass votes and declare the winners of the May 2, 2026 School
Trustee Election

1. Background:

On May 2, 2026, Southwest ISD held a Board of Trustee election to fill two at large places on the Board currently held by James Gonzalez and Jose Diaz. There was a total of 4 candidates running for these two positions.

Early voting was conducted at the District Administration Building and other Bexar County polling sites from April 20 through April 28, 2026. Election day voting was conducted on Saturday, May 2, 2026.

2. Process:

The District contracted the Bexar County Elections office to perform the election duties on behalf of the district.

3. Fiscal Impact:

The District will expend about \$8,700 for this election.

4. Recommendation:

That the Board approve the canvass of the 2026 School Board Election results and declare the winners.

5. Required:

Board action.

Consider the election of Board officers to serve from May 2026 through May 2027.

All offices will be declared unfilled and new officers will be elected. Superintendent, Dr. Jeanette Ball, will conduct the nominations and voting for the office of Board President. The person elected Board President will then conduct the nominations and voting for the remaining officers.
