## **H Discussion Agenda**

1. KTEC

Dr. Ranells asked if everyone had a chance to see the pictures of KTEC that she sent. The Executive Board recently met and so far there are 888 students who have expressed an interest in enrolling in KTEC. Mark Cotner, Administrator of KTEC has been presenting all over the region. The construction of KTEC is under budget and it will open on time. The next process will be hiring teachers who are interested.

2. Levy

Tom Taggart reported that we are off and running. District Administration has been meeting with the staff. Tom said the most confusing thing so far is where voters need to vote.

3. Republican Caucus, March 6<sup>th</sup>

Tom Taggart explained current policy that if a political event is being held in district facilities then it needs to be approved by the Board. The policy, from his understanding is more specific to a candidate rather than elections; this is an election event. The event will be held in the evening at Timberlake and Lakeland High Schools with a potential of up to a 1000 people in attendance.

4. Spirit Lake Elementary Evacuation

Dr. Ranells briefly spoke on the evacuation and was very complimentary towards Mrs. Morrison, the Spirit Lake Elementary Staff, Timberlake Junior High Staff, Mr. Ron Schmidt, Transportation, Food Service, Law Enforcement and the Fire Department. The cause was some insulation smoldering in the attic above the kitchen area.

Principal Patty Morrison also briefed the Board on the event.

Chairman Brown thanked Administrators and Staff for executing and following the district emergency plan.

Chairman Brown briefed the Board on the Day on the Hill event. He explained that it is an opportunity for Board members meet with Legislators and talk about the educational issues that we have. He updated the Board and some of the current legislation that is being presented this year.
