1. LEA

LEA President Kristie Mitchell was in attendance of the meeting and presented comment to the Board. She informed that the LEA has always felt support by the School Board and Administration, especially since the Student's Come First Legislation. She continued to inform that currently House Bill 67 regarding Labor Negotiations and Senate Bill 1040 regarding Continuing Contracts are going before Legislation. Additionally, she commented that the ISBA and ISSA are behind these bills and the labor group is disappointed in these associations' attempts to bring back these laws. She requested that the LEA would like the board to make a statement sometime in the future regarding their support or non-support of these bills.

2. Visitor Presentations

a. Lakeland High School Senior Project Presentation (2 students)

Lakeland High School Principal Shannon Hall introduced the two students who were in attendance to present their Senior Project. Mrs. Hall also explained each of the 3 components of the project. Tonight the students will be doing the oral component of the project.

Lakeland High School Senior Brice Frank presented on the increasing wolf population in Idaho and the problems they present to humans and other wildlife in the forests.

Lakeland High School Senior Dustin Hannawalt made presentation regarding Federal Marijuana Laws and why the Federal Government should legalize marijuana.

Both students answered short questions at the end of their own presentation.

4. Staff Reports

a. Mr. BJ DeAustin & Tammy Cass- BASE Program update

BASE Program Coordinator Tammy Cass updated the Board on the piloted before and after school care program at Garwood Elementary. Currently there are approximately 30 students enrolled in the program at Garwood. Other schools in the District that are interested in offering the program next year are Twin Lakes Elementary, Spirit Lake Elementary, and Betty Kiefer Elementary. Ms. Cass informed that there is also a desire and need to continue the program throughout summer, however with one central location at Garwood Elementary. She further informed that the program has been mostly a self-supporting program with the exception of building costs.

Tom Taggart also provided input and emphasized that the program has been self supporting. He commented that although there have been more custodial needs and longer utilities the program is still ahead of the game.

b. Tom Taggart

1) Financial

Tom Taggart reported that there has been nothing out of the ordinary in regards to current finances and that it had been a good winter as far as expenses. He further reported that Special Education will go over budget, however that is no surprise. He informed that some districts are already feeling the fiscal impact because of the repeals.

2) School Safety

Both Spirit Lake and Rathdrum Police Chiefs were present for this meeting. Retired Principal Steve Rasor also present. Rasor has been doing a detailed school safety check list with each building. All three gentlemen spoke briefly regarding cooperation between the schools and law enforcement.

3) Plant Facility Dollars

Tom Taggart provided a handout which has been made a part of these minutes. The handout provided plant facility needs of each building. He informed that there will be a big investment in technology.

Weighted Grade Proposal

We would like to ask the Lakeland Board of Trustees to consider a proposal to weight grades for Honors and Dual Credit College Classes.

Rationale:

There is a clear focus in the Lakeland School District and the State of Idaho to encourage students to pursue a more rigorous high school curriculum and therefore becoming better prepared to be successful in college. Currently Lakeland student who choose to take challenging honors and dual enrolled classes earn no grade point advantage for taking these classes. In some cases they earn a lower grade in these classes which puts them at a disadvantage, based on grade point average, compared to students who take a less challenging curriculum. By placing weight on Honors and Dual Credit classes there would be incentive to take Honors and Dual Credit Classes. The advantage for taking more challenging classes would result in a potentially higher grade point average. This higher G.P.A. would put these students in a more competitive position when being considered for scholarships.

Reduction in Force Procedures

A Reduction in Force may become necessary due to lack of funds, program reduction or deletion, and/or general reorganization of the district. The following definition and procedures shall be used for conducting a Reduction in Force.

Definition

As used in this policy, “teacher” shall apply to any employee of the District who holds a certificate issued by the State Board of Education who is employed in a teaching or administrative position, below the position of Superintendent.

Procedures

1. Prior to commencing action to terminate teacher contracts under these procedures, the Board will give due consideration to its ability to effectuate position elimination and/or reduction in staff by:
 - a. Voluntary retirements
 - b. Voluntary resignations
 - c. Transfer of existing staff members
 - d. Voluntary leaves of absence

~~2. In the event a Reduction in Force is required, teachers who are retained pursuant to these procedures may be reassigned if suitable position openings are available in instructional areas for which they are Highly Qualified and for which the principal has approved transfer pursuant to Idaho Code.~~

2.
3. In the Board’s determination as to the individuals to be released or programs to be eliminated, consideration will be given to the criteria set out below. Each criterion shall be considered in terms of the total context when selecting those employees who are to be considered for release pursuant to the provisions of these procedures:

- The individual and cumulative effect of each criterion on the welfare of students
- The individual and cumulative effect of each criterion on the best long-term and short-term interest of the District
- Area(s) of certification for which the teacher is Highly Qualified which are classified by the District as Hard to Fill positions
- Number of areas of certification for which the teacher is Highly Qualified
- Educational/Degree Status
- Position as a Lead or Master Teacher within the District

- Whether or not the teacher is Highly Qualified in a course necessary for High School Graduation requirements
- Whether or not the teacher is Highly Qualified in a course necessary for middle school advancement
- Contribution and/or involvement in extra-curricular or co-curricular positions with students
- Compliance with Professional Standards and Conduct over the course of employment with the District
- Teacher evaluation, including components required by Idaho Code to be encompassed in teacher evaluation
- In the instance where all of the above factors are equal for two (2) or more certificated professional employees, the board of trustees then may consider seniority of the certificated professional employee in making its final decision of employee selection.

It is further the intent of the Board that primary consideration be the quality of instruction in order for the District to be compliant with federal and state education requirements. Thus, each criterion shall be considered in terms of this total context.

The factors for consideration shall be reviewed on an annual basis by the District's Administration to determine whether factors should be added, eliminated, or weighted differently. Such recommendations for modification will then be brought before the Board for consideration.

4. The Human Resources Department shall advance notice of the possible Reduction in Force to all teachers who may be released, based upon the number of teachers who may be released, in full or in part, and the school programs, teacher positions, or categories of positions that may be affected.
5. It is recommended that the teachers periodically review their personnel file materials with the District's Administrative Office to assure that the school has appropriate information relating to the various criteria referenced above.
 - a. After receiving notice of the possible Reduction in Force, if a teacher believes that there is an error, the teacher shall notify the District's Administrative Office of the concern of an error, in writing by close of the school day on the third (3rd) school day after notice has been received.
 - b. This written notice shall specifically identify what element or elements of the teacher's personnel file and criteria are believed to be erroneous and explain specifically why the element(s) is believed to be in error.
 - c. If the District receives notice of possible error, each such written notice, timely received, shall be individually reviewed for possible reconsideration or evaluation of the information used in consideration of the Reduction in Force.
 - d. Should a teacher fail to inspect his/her personnel file and has inaccurate information in his/her personnel file and/or has failed to provide the District with updated

information, the information contained in the file will be utilized for the Reduction in Force determination and the teacher will not have the opportunity to subsequently correct such information after the Reduction in Force has been implemented.

6. If the Board determines that a Reduction in Force in fact will be implemented, the Superintendent shall submit a list of the teachers recommended for release, through use of the above process, and shall make recommendation to the Board as to what due process, if any, the Board needs to implement for each individual personnel situation.
7. All releases shall be done in conformance with the applicable provisions of Idaho Code and all affected teachers will be promptly notified, in writing, of the Board's decision or actions that need to be taken by the Board relating to applicable due process activities, if any.



Casey has been attending NIC on a full time basis and will graduate with an AS from NIC and receive his high school diploma at the same time. Trevor has taken every rigorous class that Timberlake High School has to offer. The committee felt that they were both deserving of valedictorian and did not really want to set precedence of sending our best students to NIC to become valedictorian or salutatorian.

Tim Young has earned a 3.9444 gpa. He has taken rigorous classes in the core academic areas throughout his high school career and he is very involved in school activities (football, track, and leadership).


