The Lessee shall designate one competent adult person for each of said buses to supervise and control the activities of the passengers and to follow all rules, regulations, and directions of the driver/operator of each bus. It shall be the sole responsibility of the Lessee to assure that all passengers riding said bus to TAS Senior Grad Party shall re-enter said bus for the return trip promptly as directed by the driver/operator. A roster of passengers for each bus shall be prepared by the lessee appointed supervisor to assure re-entry and return by each passenger.

SECTION EIGHT

The Lessee and all passengers release the Lessor from any damages whatsoever suffered by them excepting insofar as said damages may result from the negligence of the driver/operator of said property. The Lessee shall, and does hereby indemnify the Lessor from any and all claims of passengers or third persons excepting for those claims arising out of the drivers'/operators' negligence.

Mr. Murray,

We are parents of two children attending Twin Lakes Elementary School. We wanted to express to you our sincere appreciation for Principal Keyes at Twin Lakes Elementary. Over the last several weeks, we had an unusual and stressful event occur involving a man in the girls bathroom and his unsettling behavior stalking me.

Although the incidents surrounding this event were unusual and potentially dangerous, Principal Keyes handled each incident perfectly clearly placing the safety of the students and myself as her first and foremost priority. Arguably it was because of the way she handled these incidents, that they did not grow into something worse.

She unquestionably presented and still presents a strong and protective presence to the offending person, making it clear that no child at this school will be a victim. The message given loud and clear is that this school is safe and protected. Despite things seeming to calm down over the last week or so, she is still vigilant and watchful even spotting this man coming to the school unannounced.

My children were initially shaken by the events and expressed fear about returning to school. However, after how Principal Keyes handled the situation, they now feel very safe coming to school and know that if this man comes to the school again, he will be "babysat" while there to assure their and every other child's safety.

Principal Keyes was also commendably open to suggestions on how to approach these events. In our professional lives, my husband and I have worked with perpetrators of varying degrees of child involved crimes. Often times, perpetrators will start with testing the limits and seeing how vigilantly a place is protected. Once these "field tests" are completed, if the perpetrator sees a lack of protection it is only a matter of time before a serious incident occurs.

Given the predictable escalating pattern of perpetrators, Principal Keyes has sent the right message to the offending person. Twin Lakes Elementary is not a place where a perpetrator will find an easy target because of the vigilance and care of Principal Keyes and all the staff there.

Despite these events, and expressly due to the way Principal Keyes and her staff have handled these events, Twin Lakes Elementary continues to have a prevailing atmosphere of safety, happiness and love where children can feel free to explore, learn and grow. The "feeling" of the school as one walks down the halls is of happiness, safety and innocence ... a feeling of what childhood should be.

We cannot compliment her and her staff enough over how this was and is continuing to be handled. She should write a field book for other principles on how to handle these unusual safety concerns. With all our heart, we sincerely want to express our deepest gratitude for her professionalism, protection and care. She is a model principal and truly is the absolutely best her profession has to offer.


