SGS MS band had All-region band auditions on November 29th in West Oso. 24 students auditioned that day with 20 students qualifying for a region band. The two percussion students will audition on December 3rd.

HS band will have region auditions on December 3rd in Alice. We will have results at the meeting.

HS Band and drill team will participate in the La Posada Parade on December 3rd.

The Region clinic will be December 9th and 10th. Our MS students will rehearse in the TAMUK SUB Ball rooms and our HS students will rehearse in the new School of Music building. Our Band hall will house a 2C/3C Region band and will be the warm-up area for each region band. The Region Concert will be December 10th in Jones Auditorium.

The Areilles will have a Christmas program on December 12th in the SGS gym at 6pm.

HS band concert (both HS bands, the jazz band, and Mariachi) will be December 12th (after the drill team program) 7:00pm ish

MS Band Concert will be December 13th at 7pm ish (pending the ending of the elementary program that day. The concerts will be in the new Performance Hall located inside the New School of Music building on the TAMUK Campus.

Drill team had auditions for next year's team for returning veterans.

Region Mariachi auditions will be December 14th at HM King HS.

Our HS Band students that qualify for the Area round of competition will compete on January 7th in Alice.

UIL Mariachi competition is January 21st at Robstown

State Mariachi is January 24/25th (if we enter as a "Traditional" Mariachi and advance.) We have to meet the criteria for entering as a traditional Mariachi. That would mean excluding a student since their instrument is listed as non-traditional. (Flute)
