Staff reports centered on the move from the elementary school into the other LOISD buildings - first day was smooth and the small issues seemed to be easily fixed. In person learning was much preferred to remote asynchronous learning - the small sacrifice of moving around staff was worth the face to face interaction with the student population.

Wayne discussed the use of the energy management system to dehumidify the school and work to make it more workable for demolition crews and construction in the near future.

College and Career Readiness update

My goals this year have been:

- Expand student's awareness of college, career and military opportunities and to help them be prepared.
- Increase our local scholarships
- Work closely with Mrs. Talbert and administration to to update our CTE programs of study in order to maximum CTE funds and help accountability as well as help students gain marketable skills

Preparation

- September 2020 SAT School day for approximately 50 seniors (this was postponed form Spring 2020 due to Covid)
- January 2021 ACT/SAT Test Prep workshop for Juniors—approximately 40 attended
- March 2021 ACT test to 50 juniors
- April 13 will give SAT school day to 50 juniors
- ASVAB test (military entrance exam and an excellent aptitude test) will be given to all juniors in May

Opportunities

- Each branch of the military has given classroom presentations to seniors (Air Force is scheduled to come). Each recruiter talked with interested individuals on a one on one basis. I have also had recruiters on campus to talk to students who showed interest later
- UTI (Universal Technical Institute) gave a classroom presentation and then talked with interested individuals one on one
- PJC classroom presentation covering their 2 year and certification programs as well as how to core curriculum and transfer to a University.
- I am planning at least 2 more speakers at this time.
- I plan to try to set up interviews with various companies for students who wish to go to work.

Results—approximately 82 seniors

- Approximately 48 seniors have applied and been accepted to at least one university or community college (3 of these are out of state)
- 4 students are currently talking with the military
- Approximately 10 students are currently applying and/or researching Technical schools

- I have been meeting individuals with seniors to determine a plan or offer assistance. I have seen approximately 90% of the seniors and I will continue this process.

Local Scholarships

- Local scholarships were due April 15. Many of our seniors will be receiving scholarships from the colleges they will attend.
- We have 20 local scholarships. 5 of these are NEW local scholarship opportunities.
- FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) approximately 30 students have completed the application and several more have started the application by completing the student portion. (There is parent portion to be completed before application can be submitted) I will continue to work with students to complete this application

CTE Development

- Working with Mrs. Talbert and Mrs. Carter to update the CTE programs of study/
- In the 2021-2022 school year., we will be adding CTE practicums and a Career Prep work program for senior students. These class will help students develop marketable skills needed in the work place.
