RESOLUTION NO. 2025-05

WHEREAS, the City of Valley is the owner of certain personal property, namely a Belgian Malinois canine, “Officer K-9 Sonic”, who has served as a K-9 Officer for the Valley Police Department; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 17-503.02 and Valley Municipal Code § 153.026 the City is authorized to direct the sale and the manner and terms of the sale of the City’s personal property; and

WHEREAS, a motion was made and sustained by the Valley City Council on January 14, 2025 wherein the City Council, in consideration of Officer K-9 Sonic’s dedicated service to the city the special bond and established trust between the dog and his handler, Officer K-9 Sonic shall be conveyed to his former handler, James Deemer, for the sum of One Dollars (\$1.00); and

WHEREAS, the Valley City Council desires to exercise its power to direct the sale and the manner and terms of the sale of Sonic pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 17-503.02 and Valley Municipal Code § 153.026 through the passage of this Resolution.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VALLEY, DOUGLAS COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

1. The City hereby directs that the City’s personal property, namely a Belgian Malinois canine, “Officer K-9 Sonic”, who has served as a K-9 Officer for the Valley Police Department, be sold to his former handler, James Deemer, for the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), said sale to take place on and be effective as of February 7, 2025.
2. Following passage of this Resolution, a notice of the sale, including the terms and conditions thereof, shall be posted in three prominent places within the City for a period of not less than seven days prior to February 7, 2025.
3. Following passage of this Resolution, a notice of the sale, including the terms and conditions thereof, shall be published once in *The Daily Record*, a legal newspaper in or of general circulation within the City of Valley at least seven days prior to February 7, 2025.
4. The Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary in order to effectuate the transfer, conveyance and sale of Officer K-9 Sonic to James Deemer.
