



## **OVERVIEW:**

*The Hayden Arts Commission invites artists, artist teams and organized groups to submit applications to display art in the Hayden City Gallery. The Hayden City Gallery was established by the Arts Commission to **promote art and local artists** in the community. The display of art is a valuable benefit to artists and the public.*

## **BACKGROUND:**

*In 2008, after years of planning, the 'Central Business District' was established in downtown Hayden. With the help of grants, the city began improving the District by widening Government Way, burying utilities, and adding sidewalks, street lights, and greenspace. In 2009, Hayden City Hall received a facelift and addition in order to set an example for businesses in the District. As a result, a new entry and hallway was created to facilitate visitor traffic. This area, now referred to as the Hayden City Gallery, provides a corridor of natural light, large wall spaces, display cases and pedestals for the display of local art.*

## **ALL ART DISPLAYED SHOULD:**

- Provide a positive impression and lasting memory for visitors.
- Be original work.
- Be no wider or longer than the space will allow.
- Be labeled with a card including, at a minimum, the following:
  - Name of the piece
  - Artist name
  - Contact information
  - Price (or NFS)

## **WALL REQUIREMENTS:**

- No projecting points or sharp edges.
- Artwork must be professionally presented (framed & matted, on canvas, metal print, wood print, etc.)
- Wall art must hang from the existing ceiling grid. No nails!
- Artist is responsible for providing wire/line and hardware.
- Minimum grouping or individual size framed of 16"x20"
- Standard display height: 57" – 66" 'on center' (eye level)

## **CASE REQUIREMENTS:**

- Artwork must fit into the cases with the doors closed and locked.
- Be positioned for optimal viewing, including the use of easels for 2-dimensional pieces.

## **PEDESTAL REQUIREMENTS:**

- No projecting points or sharp edges.
- Art must not impede pedestrian traffic.

## USE OF THE FACILITIES:

The City will execute an agreement with the artist for use of the facilities. The agreement states that artwork will be displayed as to not cause damage to the walls and other parts of the premises. The art will not obstruct the flow of City Hall visitors and staff through the lobby and hallway area. **Artists will not display any art piece(s) that depict nudity or violence or that foster discrimination against persons based on their race, religion, gender, age or ethnicity.**

If an art piece is sold during the term of the agreement, the artist shall either replace the piece or notify the gallery manager that the space will be available for another artist and not remove the sold piece until a suitable replacement is found. **Customer interaction and sales shall be between the artist and the customer.** No commissions will be collected by the City.

It is the artist's responsibility to provide any equipment or materials necessary for the placement of the art and the protection of the artwork while it is on display.

## ELIGIBILITY:

Individual artists, artist's teams, and organized groups are eligible to apply, including teams of artists from multiple disciplines. Artists may submit multiple designs and medium groupings, including requests for use of the walls and cases at the same time.

## SELECTION:

The Arts Commission will consider applications based on the following criteria, including, but not limited to: Artistic quality, theme, content, context, media, performance, public safety, originality and diversity.

1. A completed Hayden City Gallery Application.
2. A brief, one-page artist bio (separate bios for each team member in a team, one bio for a group).
3. A one-page description of the art, including information on the type of medium, materials used, framing/mounting/presentation style, approximate number of total pieces proposed for the gallery space, average size of pieces, size of smallest piece, and size of largest piece.
4. A least 3 images of artwork proposed that accurately represents the artwork, provided on 8 ½" x 11" pages in color or electronically by email in pdf. or jpeg. format.
5. **The Arts Commission will require physical samples or additional electronic images in order to make their decision.**

## **Sharon Cruson – Artist Biography**

Sharon Cruson is a Canadian-born sculptor based in North Idaho, whose work blends classical technique with a deep sense of storytelling. Her artistic journey began in childhood with private drawing lessons from a neighbor, sparking a lifelong passion for visual expression. After moving to the United States in 1991, Sharon explored a range of creative mediums while balancing the demands of family and full-time work, always returning to sculpture as her truest form of expression.

Her work is grounded in the traditions of classical sculpture, informed by private mentorship, self-directed study, and formal training. A pivotal influence was her mentorship with artist Tallman Miller, who introduced her to mold-making and the intricacies of casting. She later refined her technique under the instruction of nationally recognized sculptor Terry Lee, and attended a figure sculpting workshop with Philippe Faraut.

Sharon specializes in representational sculpture that celebrates human dignity, cultural heritage, and the strength of the human spirit. Many of her subjects are inspired by women and historical figures whose stories are foundational yet underrepresented. Her sculptures emphasize expressive detail, anatomical accuracy, and emotional nuance—crafted in clay, hydrocal, resin, and bronze through the lost-wax casting method.

Today, Sharon works from her home studio in North Idaho alongside her husband, where they operate Sharon's Inspirations, a studio dedicated to fine sculpture and woodworking. Her work has been juried into multiple regional art festivals and continues to evolve through commissions, exhibitions, and public art projects that honor the enduring narratives of American history.

Title: Moment of Reflection

Date: 2022

Material: Hydrocal with Bronze infused paint / patina

Dimensions: 24 H x 8 W x 8 D

Description: Moment of Reflection captures the stillness of contemplation. A graceful woman sits upon a tree stump, clutching a bouquet of flowers close to her chest. Her quiet posture and gentle embrace suggest both vulnerability and resilience, inviting viewers to connect with the delicate balance between solitude, beauty, and strength.

Title: A Mothers Love

Date: 2023

Dimensions: 8 H x 8 W x 8 D

Material: Resin with Copper infused paint

Description: *A Mother's Love* beautifully captures the intimate and timeless bond between a mother and her newborn child. This figurative sculpture depicts a tender moment as the mother gently kisses the forehead of her baby, symbolizing unconditional love, protection, and devotion.

Title: Souffleur une Bulle

Date: 2023

Dimensions: 24 H x 6 W x 24 D

Material: Resin w/ Polyacrylic background

Description: Souffleur une bulles ("Blowing Bubbles") is a handcrafted resin sculpture that captures the playful spirit of a young lady sitting in a window, blowing bubbles that float gently into the air. Her flowing dress billows with the breeze, embodying a sense of freedom and lightheartedness.

Title: Bubbles of Innocence

Material: Resin w/ Polyacrylic background

Description: Bubbles of Innocence celebrates the carefree joy of childhood. A young child crouches down in oversized shoes and coveralls, cheeks puffed as she blows delicate bubbles into the air. Her playful expression captures a moment of wonder, innocence, and lighthearted fun.

Title: Cowgirl Spirit

Date: 2023

Dimensions: 8H x 8W x 8D

Material: Resin with Copper infused paint

Description: Cowgirl Spirit captures the essence of the Western woman — resilient, graceful, and unyielding. Her gaze is lifted with quiet strength and determination,

embodying both beauty and courage. Flowing hair and detailed features highlight her confidence, while her hat and attire reflect the rugged yet elegant spirit of the American West.

Title: Dreams of Serenity

Date: 2021

Dimensions: 6 H x 21 W x 11 D

Material: Hydrocal with Bronze infused paint / patina

Description: Dreams of Serenity captures the quiet beauty of peaceful rest. A graceful woman lies in tranquil repose, her body relaxed as sleep gently embraces her. Draped lightly in soft covers, one arm stretches outward as if reaching toward the world of dreams.

Title: Flourish

Date: 2025

Dimensions: 30 H x 24 W x 10 D

Material: Resin with Bronze infused paint / patina

Description: *Flourish* celebrates the beauty of uplifted spirit. A graceful woman rises with arms outstretched, billowing cloth swirling above her in flowing arcs. Her form merges earth and sky, embodying grace, renewal, and the timeless harmony between strength and elegance.
