- B. Action: 2023-2025 St. Croix Education Association (SCEA) Master Contract. The new contract covers the period from July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2025, and includes some language adjustments, changes to health insurance and improvements to salary and benefits. Under the terms of the contract, the salary schedule was increased by 4% in year one (effective 2/15/24) and 4.5% in year two. Motion by Hockert and second by Kelzenberg, carried 7-0.
- C. Action: Staffing Adjustments. Thirty-seven probationary teachers were released as a result of adjusting staff to better align with student enrollment numbers and match programming with district goals. Motion by Sherman and second by Porbeni, carried 7-0.

**AGREEMENT FOR
SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER SERVICES**

This agreement ("Agreement") is made by and between Washington County ("County") and Stillwater Area Public Schools ISD 834 ("School District") for the provision of school resource officer services to the School District by the County.

WHEREAS, the School District is desirous of contracting for the performance by the County of the hereinafter described school resource officer functions through the Washington County Sheriff's Office; and

WHEREAS, the County is agreeable to rendering such services on the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement is authorized and provided for by the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Sections 471.59 and 436.05.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the terms of the aforementioned statutes and in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, it is mutually agreed between the County and School District as follows:

I. Scope of Services

1. The County, through the Washington County Sheriff's Office ("Sheriff's Office"), agrees to provide school resource officer services to the School District to the extent and in the manner hereinafter set forth:
 - a. The school resource officer services provided shall include a deputy who will have primary responsibility in serving as a resource person to faculty, classroom members, and school administrators in the prevention and diversion of behavior problems. The deputy will also provide enforcement of the Juvenile Code of the State as said code relates to the School District and other state and local laws.
 - b. Except as otherwise specifically set forth herein such school resource officer services shall only encompass duties and functions of the type coming within the jurisdiction of and customarily rendered by said Sheriff under law.
 - c. The Sheriff's Office shall comply with all state statutes including Minnesota Statute Section 626.8482.
2. Contractual Duties. In addition to any other duties specified in this Agreement, the school resource officer's contractual duties include: (a) fostering a positive school climate through relationship building and open communication; (b) protecting students, staff, and visitors to the school grounds from criminal activity; (c) serving as a liaison from law enforcement to school officials; (d) providing advice on safety drills; (e) identifying vulnerabilities in school facilities and safety protocols; (f) educating and advising students and staff on law enforcement topics; and (g) enforcement of criminal laws. The school resource officer must not use force or the authority of the office solely to enforce school rules or policies or participate in the enforcement of discipline for violations of school rules.

3. Disclaimer. Nothing in this subdivision limits any other duty or responsibility imposed on peace officers; limits the expectation that peace officers will exercise professional judgment and discretion to protect the health, safety, and general welfare of the public when carrying out their duties; or creates a duty for school resource officers to protect students, staff, or others on school grounds that is different from the duty to protect the public as a whole.
4. The County shall furnish and supply all necessary labor, supervision, administration, equipment, communication facilities and dispatching, and supplies necessary to provide the services required by this Agreement. The School District shall furnish a secure office for the employee to work at no cost to the County.
5. Violations of laws or ordinances for which an arrest is made shall be prosecuted in the appropriate court(s) of the County under the laws of the State of Minnesota or ordinances of the School District and the fines, if any, shall be remitted in accordance with the laws of the State of Minnesota.
6. The deputy will normally be scheduled to work an eight (8) hour shift concurrent with the regular school day or special school activities. The schedule may be changed from time to time to best serve the needs of the School District. The deputy shall serve as a full-time school resource deputy throughout the school year. The County will assign the deputy to other duties June through August and shall pay all personnel costs for that period of time.

II. Assumption of Liability/Insurance

1. Except as otherwise provided herein the School District shall not assume any liability for the direct payment of any salaries, wages, or other compensation to any County personnel providing school resource officer services to the School District under this Agreement and the County hereby assumes said liabilities. At all times and for all purposes, the deputy who is assigned to serve as a school resource officer shall be an employee of the County and not an employee or agent of the School District.
2. Except as otherwise provided herein the School District shall not be liable for compensation or indemnity to any County employee for injury or sickness arising out of their employment with the County and/or provision of school resource officer services to the School District and the County agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the School District against any such claims.
3. School districts are not able to enter into indemnification provisions. Therefore, each party of this contract agrees to be responsible for its own acts and the results thereof to the extent authorized by law and shall not be responsible for acts of the other party and the result thereof. The liability of both the County and School District shall be governed by the provisions of the Municipal Torts Claim Act and other applicable law.
4. The County agrees to maintain during the term of this Agreement automobile, general liability, workers' compensation, and professional liability insurance or self-insurance in amounts deemed appropriate by the County.
5. All deputy sheriffs, clerks, dispatchers, and all other County personnel performing duties pursuant to this Agreement shall at all times and for all purposes be considered employees of the County.

III. Payment

1. The School District agrees to pay to the County the actual direct costs and expenses of providing the School District with the school resource officer services provided for by this Agreement, including the full-time services of one (1) full-time equivalent (FTE) deputy sheriff.
2. Direct costs and expenses shall mean the salaries, payroll taxes, and fringe benefits of the dedicated employees of the County who perform the school resource officer services to the School District under this Agreement as well as other related and customary costs incurred by the County as a direct result of providing the school resource officer services to the School District under this Agreement. Direct costs and expenses shall not include items of cost and expense attributable to services and facilities provided or available to the School District that by law the County must provide. Computation of costs hereunder shall be made by the Sheriff's Office Budgeting and Accounting Division.
3. The County shall bill the School District on a semi-annual basis for the provision of services under this Agreement and the School District shall pay the amount required of the School District on a semi-annual basis by directing to the County a check or voucher payable to the County Treasurer.

IV. Cooperation of Parties

1. To facilitate the County's performance pursuant to this Agreement the School District and County shall work together to achieve the objectives of this Agreement for the benefit of the school. Each party to this Agreement shall designate a liaison for the purposes stated above. Meetings of the liaisons can be called by any of the parties as requested.
2. The manner and standards of performance, discipline and control of personnel, methods of providing school resource officer services and other matters incident to the performance of school resource officer services under this Agreement, including personnel to be employed, shall be determined by the Sheriff's Office. The Sheriff's Office will seek input from the School District throughout the evaluation process of the deputy.
3. In the event the School District notifies the County it is dissatisfied with the assignment of personnel for the performance of services under this Agreement and requests a change in assigned personnel the County shall make a reasonable effort to effect a change in the assignment of personnel provided such a change does not jeopardize the ability of the County to provide services to other areas of Washington County in a timely and efficient manner.
4. In the event of a grievance or dispute between the County and the School District as to the extent, nature, and level of duties and services to be rendered under this Agreement or the method of performances to be rendered under this Agreement there shall be a determination thereof by the Board of County Commissioners that shall be final and conclusive between the County and the School District except as provided in (d) below:
 - a. The grievance or dispute may be presented at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of County Commissioners and the School District and the County may attend and present

to the Board any information or data which will aid the Board in reaching a just, fair, and equitable determination of the grievance or dispute.

- b. When a party to this Agreement wishes to present a dispute or grievance to the Board it shall contact the County Administrator and arrange for the date and time of the hearing on said dispute and notify in writing the other interested party at least five (5) days before said hearing, except in the case of an emergency.
- c. In cases of extreme urgency or other emergency conditions the County or the School District may request a special meeting of the Board upon contacting the County Administrator citing reasons for the necessity of such special meeting.
- d. In the event an agreement cannot be reached between the County and the School District an arbitration panel shall be established and the finding of this panel shall be final and conclusive between the County and the School District. This shall be a three-person panel with one member selected by the County, one member selected by the School District, and the third member selected by the two previously selected members.
- e. The arbitrator's fees will be shared equally by both parties.

V. Additional Terms

- 1. It is understood this Agreement contains the entire agreement between the parties and that no statement, promises, or inducements made by any party hereto, or any officer, agent, or employee of any party hereto that is not contained in this written Agreement shall be valid and binding. This Agreement may not be modified except in writing, signed by all parties.
- 2. This Agreement shall supersede any and all preceding agreements between the County and the School District for the provision of school resource officer services. Any and all preceding agreements shall terminate on the effective date of this Agreement.
- 3. The effective date of this Agreement is August 1, 2024.
- 4. This Agreement shall remain in effect for a period of two (2) years, unless earlier terminated by operation of law. This Agreement shall automatically renew for periods of one (1) year following the expiration of the initial two (2) year term and/or any renewal term. The total duration of this Agreement including all renewal terms shall not exceed five (5) years.
- 5. This Agreement may not be terminated by any party during the first two (2) years from the effective date of the Agreement. This Agreement may be terminated at any time and without any financial penalty by any party during any renewal term of the Agreement by giving the other party written notice ninety (90) days prior to the termination date.

- 7. This Agreement may not be assigned without the written consent of all parties.
- 8. This Agreement shall be construed under the laws of the State of Minnesota.
- 9. If any provision of this Agreement shall be held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the validity, legality, and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not in any way be affected or impaired thereby.








Board Update Main Level Floor Plan


