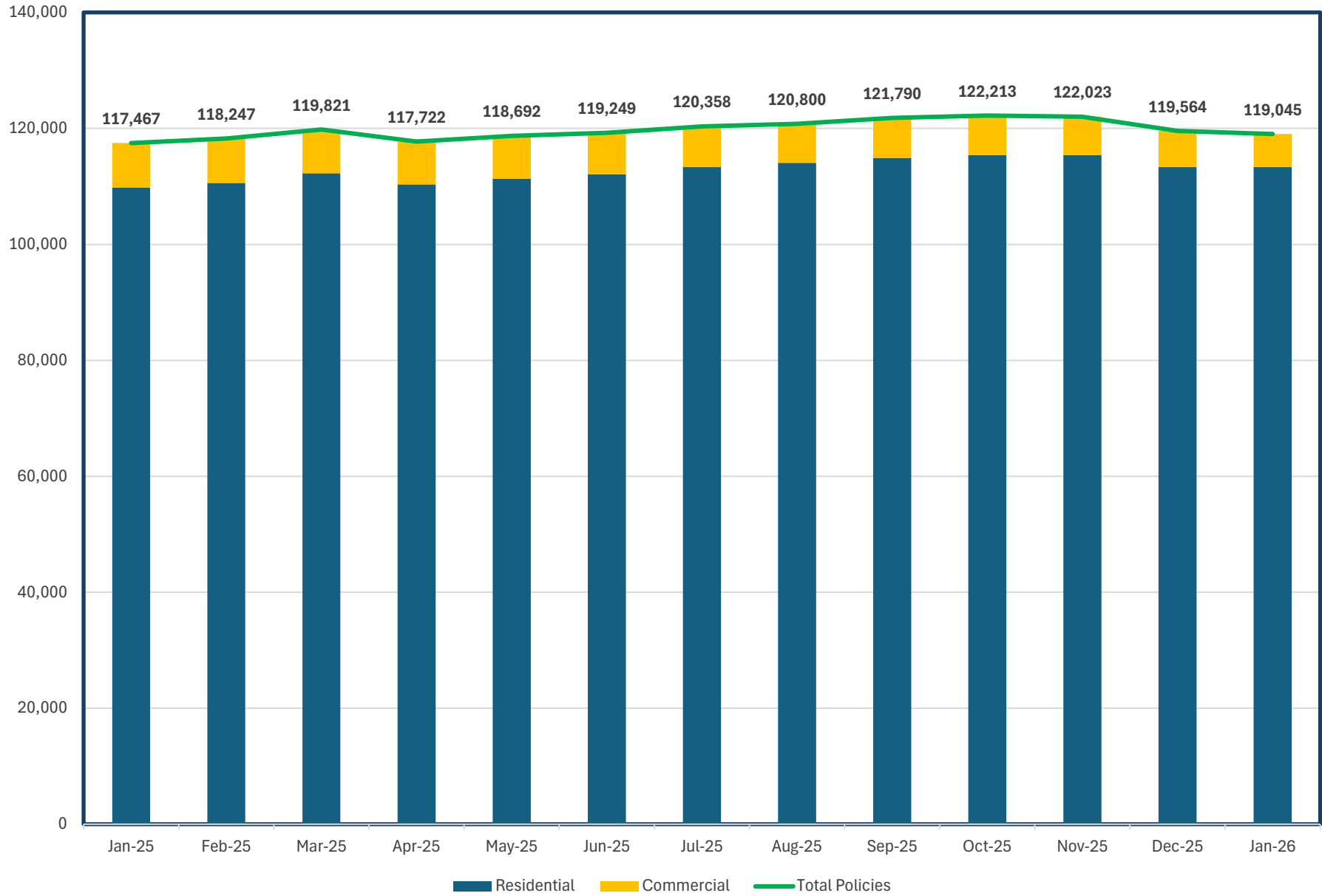

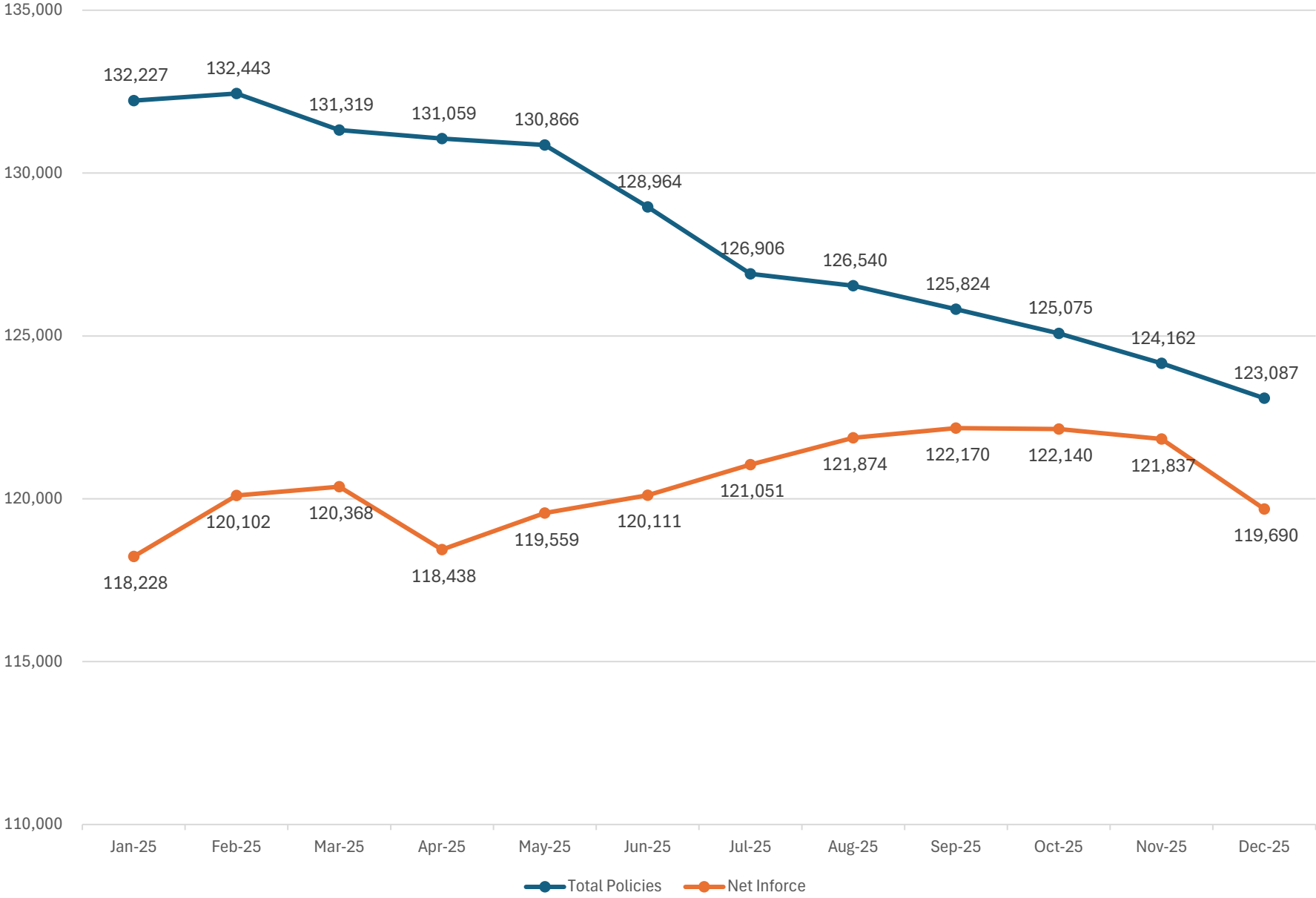

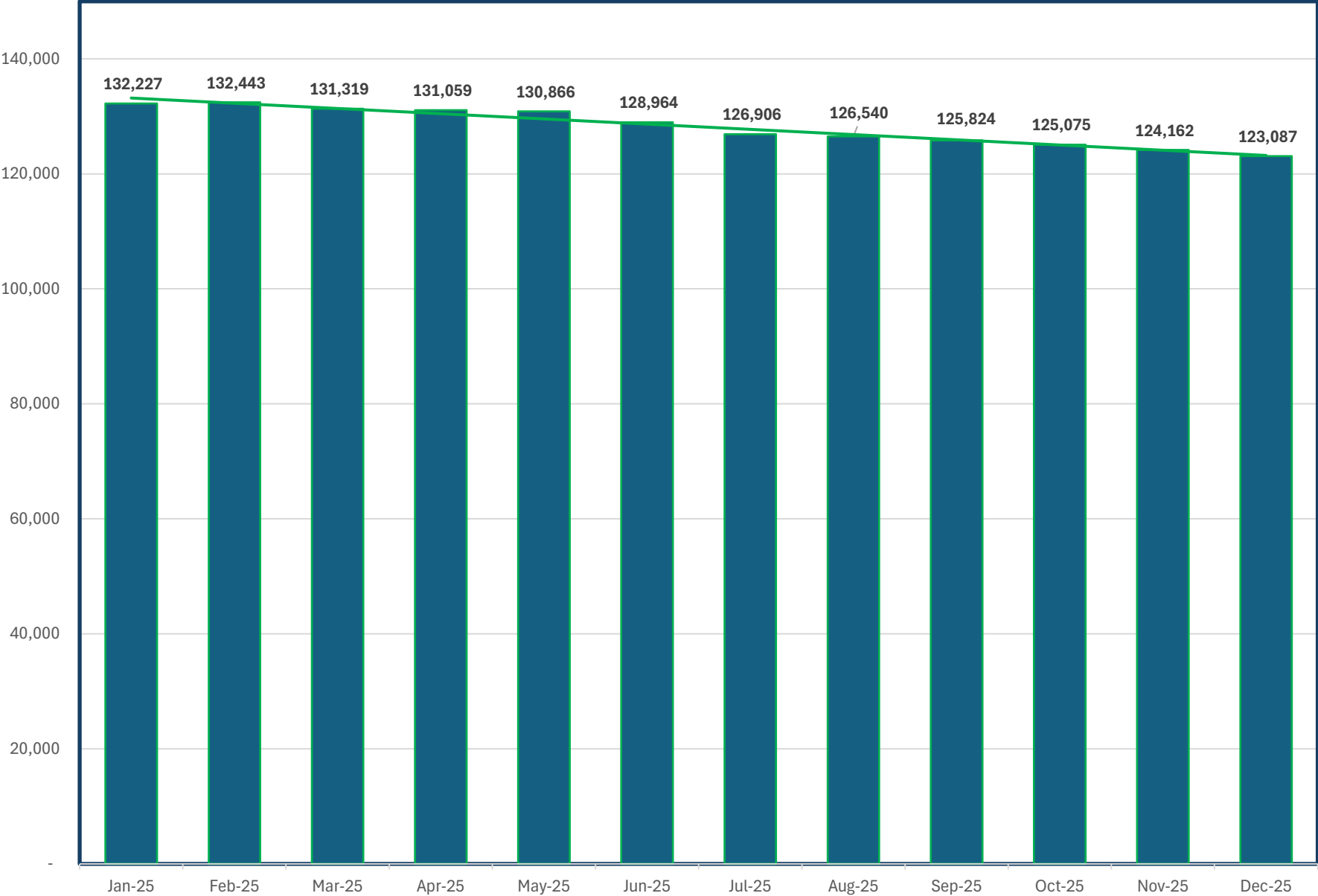
### Total Inforce Policies as of Beginning of Month



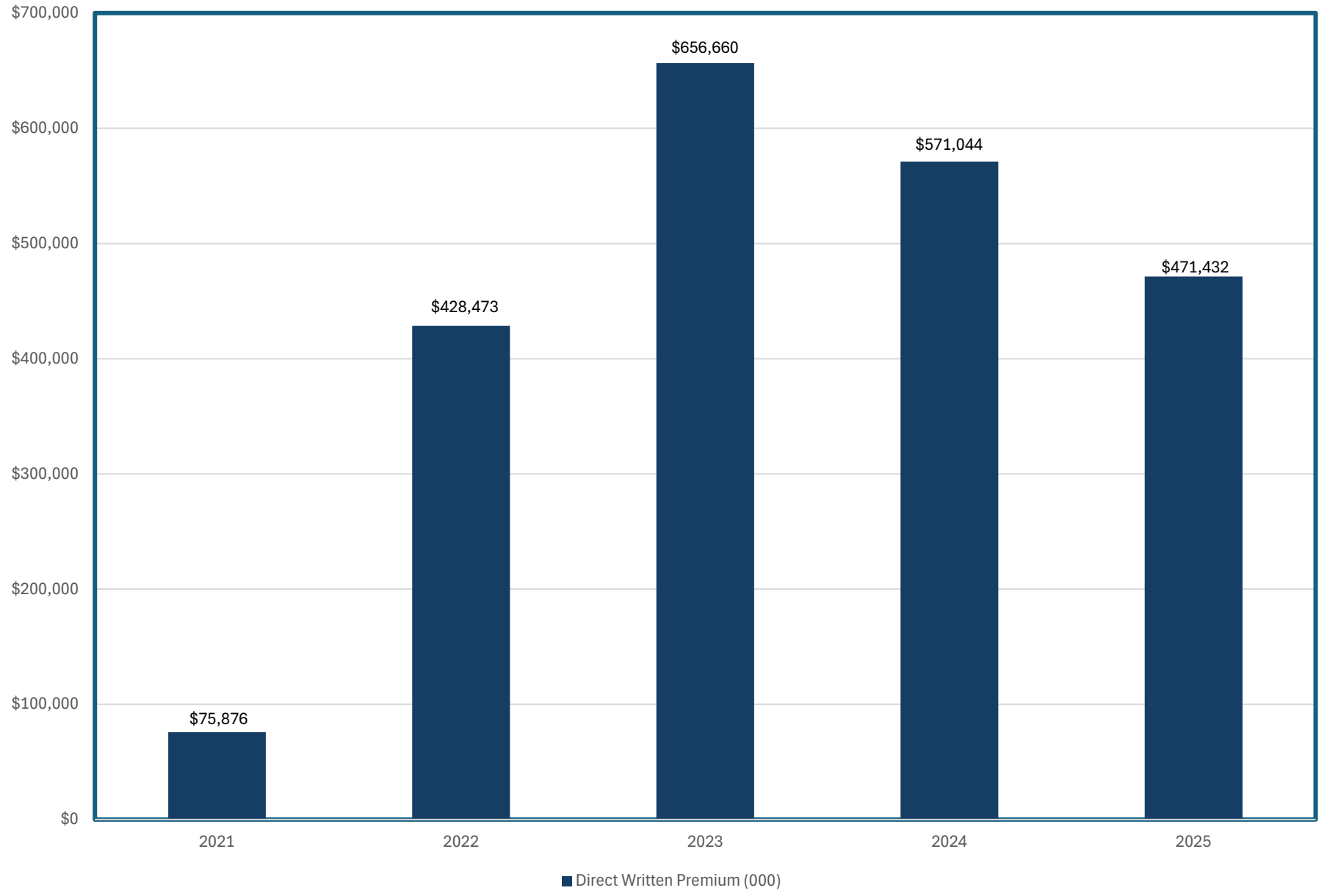
Direct vs Net Inforce

# 2026 Round 23 Offering and Selection Criteria Applied

For each of the policies selected by companies participating in this year's depopulation, an evaluation of risk was completed from the following two perspectives:



## Individual Level

A policy's expected annual loss from a PCS event (hurricane, severe convective storm, etc.) was estimated based on a 50/50 blend of RMS and AIR modeling



## Portfolio Level

Taking into consideration the geographic concentration of LCPIC's total book of business, each policy was ranked based on its contribution to the 100 and 250 year Probable Maximum Loss ("PML") relative to its premium

The portion of selected policies offered to each company participating was based on the two risk views above along with LCPIC's consideration of the level of depopulation that would be most beneficial.

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Note that the scientific approach to depopulation discussed above allows LCPIC to generate a higher percentage reduction in reinsurance costs relative to the percentage of premium lost. In addition, the metrics of risk are different for each company based on models used, geographic concentration, ratemaking, reinsurance structure, and numerous other considerations.

# Statute on Depopulation

RS 22:2314 B.(1):

“Not less than once per calendar year, the corporation, with the approval of the governing board of the corporation, **may offer some or all of its in-force policies for removal to the voluntary market.** The corporation shall include in any offers for depopulation policies that, **based on geographic and risk characteristics,** serve to reduce the exposure of the corporation.”

**Board approved plan for 2026 Round 23 offering:**

- 1. Allow companies to review LCPIC’s full book of business
- 2. Companies submit requested policies
- 3. LCPIC analyzes requested policies to project the financial impact
- 4. Present to the board in September which policies will be offered

## 2026 Round 23 Depopulation Timeline Next Steps

- Agents may begin authorizing policies to approved companies from January 12, 2026 through March 6, 2026.
- Coverage comparison worksheets and company financial summaries will be available on LCPIC's website.
- Agent authorization period will end March 6, 2026.
- Assumption notifications will be sent out to agents and policyholders March 20, 2026.
- Policyholders will until have until June 30, 2026 to opt-out.
- Policies effective July 1, 2026 will begin renewing with assuming companies.

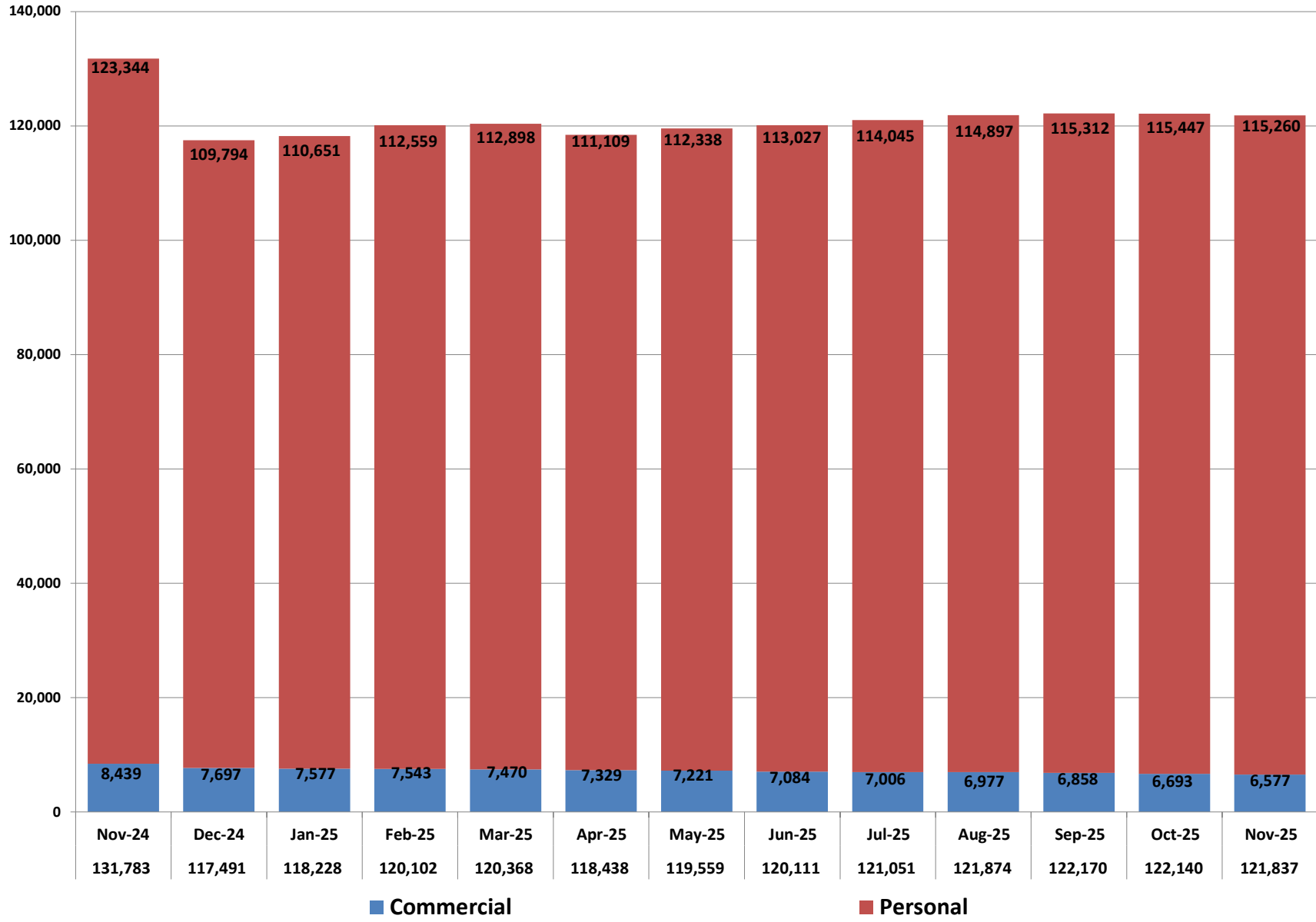

## LCPIC Policy Inforce Count by Month - Net of Depop

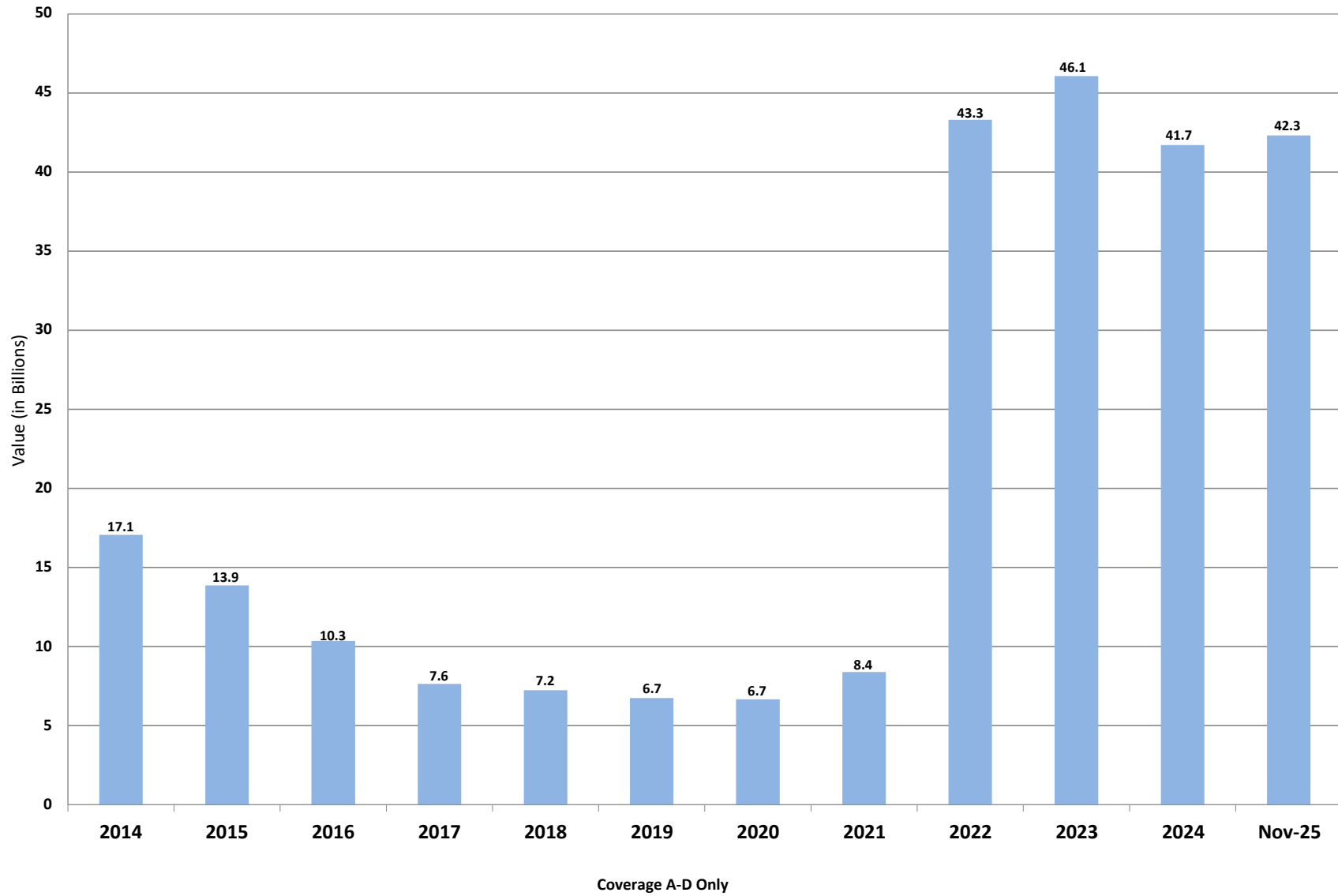

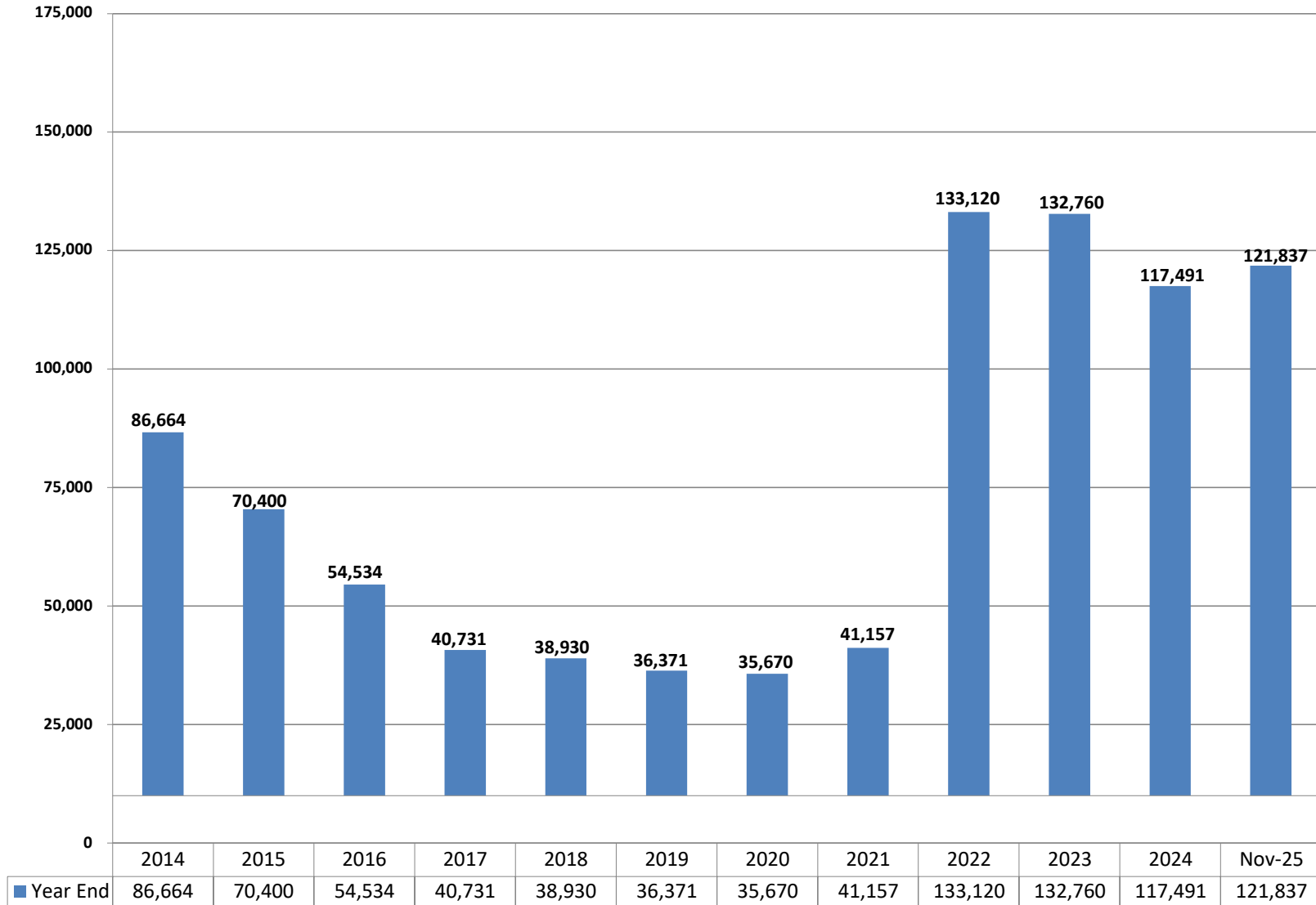

## Earned Premium Endorsement.

The change was implemented to reduce adverse selection. This adverse selection can lead to unbalanced costs for Louisiana Citizens and ultimately higher premiums for all policyholders that remain in the risk pool.

The largest expense incurred by Louisiana Citizens Property Insurance Corporation is reinsurance protection. That expense can be \$300M or more per year. Our premium to global reinsurers is based off an average TIV (total insured value) during storm season. Therefore, those who have policies in force during peak hurricane season and then cancel after a storm passes or prior to the end of their term with a full pro rata refund of premium, ultimately place more expense load/rate on those who remain as policyholders.

As a side note, Louisiana Citizens was an outlier without the endorsement. All other residual markets who operate in the Gulf and purchase reinsurance have earned premium endorsements. Texas, Mississippi, and Alabama all keep 100% of the premium (fully earned) to deter adverse selection. Florida Citizens retains at least 80% of the premium along with Louisiana Citizens.

**Please remember that the earned premium endorsement does not apply to the following:**

- If the insured replaces their policy with similar coverage of another company
- If the property is sold
- If the property is a total loss
- If the property has had continuous wind coverage no less than three years at LCPIC
- If the mortgage on the property is paid in full during the term.

The fourth bullet addressing those who have been with LCPIC for three or more years eliminates policies. Also, anyone with a mortgage on their home are required to have hazard coverage. That eliminates a tremendous number of policies as they are theoretically eliminated from the endorsement as they cannot simply cancel their

coverage unless their mortgage is paid in full. If that pay off happens, see bullet 5 above which removes them from the endorsement. 77,186 of the 119,305 (65%) are eliminated by having either 3 or more years of wind coverage, or mortgage companies. This is prior to any of the remaining bullet points above.

In November of 2024, Chairman Tim Temple, along with the Louisiana Citizens Board of Directors approved the endorsement by unanimous vote. It was then submitted and approved by the LDI.
