Agenda Topic: Drinking Water Management Plan

Summary of Issue:

Michigan Filter First Legislation requires that school districts develop a Drinking Water Management Plan (DWMP), install filters to reduce lead on consumptive fixtures, and sample filtered water. With the possible adoption of the Thrun Policy Manual, the Board is required to approve the District's plans to meet these requirements. The District is in good standing but some updates are needed and must be completed by June 2026.
