Summary of Issue:

Instructional Services is seeking support to adopt and purchase a new online curriculum for Grand Haven CyberSchool, credit recovery and summer school. The online resource is called Subject. It was piloted and recommended by GH CyberSchool teachers and principal for the following reasons:

- More robust and engaging
- Enhanced academic integrity safeguards
- Enhanced work generation tools (built-in spell check and editing capabilities)
- Tutor support capabilities
- Detailed pacing guides, customizable for individual student needs
- Teacher agency to adjust/accommodate courses to student needs (IEP, 504)
- Teacher agency to re-assign, re-grade as needed
- Enhanced teacher-to-student interactions, relationship-building, coaching
- Video content is superior
- Offers wide selection of classes with a growing course catalogue
- Optional CTE courses
- 3 year subscription will guarantee no price increase
- The cost is the same as the previous curriculum.
- Seeking support to bring the resource adoption and purchase to the Board of Education for 60 concurrent licenses at \$650/license for a total of \$39,000.

Summary of Issue:

Instructional Services is seeking support to adopt and purchase a resource that will support learner readiness. Students sometimes lack stamina, resilience, problem solving, self-regulation, or cooperation skills needed for learning. The Learner Readiness Team is recommending Wayfinder for students in grades K-12 for five years at a discounted rate of \$39,284.80 for each year.

- Purpose driven and engaging
- From Stanford University; research informed
- Includes Tier 1, 2, and 3 supports which creates fluency across RTI
- Prioritizes movement which is essential for young students
- Includes family letters for more family involvement
- Low preparation for teachers
- Student-led lessons to increase student engagement and student learning
- Deeper dive lessons/activities for students with 504 plans and IEPs
- Content is updated every year
- This resource has an appropriate scaffolding process
- Strong data and accountability measures
- Works nicely with the Board approved six learner traits

Summary of Issue:

The Grand Haven Area Public Schools and the Grand Haven Secretaries' Association, the Grand Haven Area Public Schools Education Association (GHEA), and the Grand Haven Area Public Schools Administrators Association (GHAPSAA), agree on individual, three (3) year bargaining agreements that will run through June 30, 2029.

SECRETARIES' ASSOCIATION

- Each year of the bargaining agreement, employees will receive a 3%, + step wage increase.
- In the second year of the agreement, effective January 1, 2028, the District's contribution toward medical insurance premiums shall be limited to the applicable statutory hard cap amount.
- Effective with the 2027-28 contract year, the District shall eliminate the employer-paid HSA contribution. Beginning with the 2028 plan year, the District will advance HSA amounts that the employee shall repay. Employees may opt of this during Open Enrollment
- Effective July 1, 2026, all leave time will be transitioned to Paid Time Off (PTO)
- Other items:
 - Increase retirement payments
 - Clerk reclassification
 - Updated ESTA language
 - Minor language updates

EDUCATION ASSOCIATION (GHEA)

- Each year of the bargaining agreement, employees will receive a 3%, + step wage increase.
- In the second year of the agreement, effective January 1, 2028, the District's contribution toward medical insurance premiums shall be limited to the applicable statutory hard cap amount.
- Effective with the 2027-28 contract year, the District shall eliminate the employer-paid HSA contribution. Beginning with the 2028 plan year, the District will advance HSA amounts that the employee shall repay. Employees may opt of this during Open Enrollment.
- Other items:
 - Increase 403(b) contributions
 - Schedule B stipend adjustments
 - Daily overage payment for teachers based on class size calculations.
 - Minor language updates

ADMINISTRATORS ASSOCIATION (GHAPSAA)

- Each year of the bargaining agreement, employees will receive a 3%, + step wage increase.
- In the second year of the agreement, effective January 1, 2028, the District's contribution toward medical insurance premiums shall be limited to the applicable statutory hard cap amount.
- Effective with the 2027-28 contract year, the District shall eliminate the employer-paid HSA contribution. Beginning with the 2028 plan year, the District will advance HSA amounts that the employee shall repay. Employees may opt of this during Open Enrollment
- Other items:
 - Cell Phone Stipend
 - Increase 403(b) contributions and 403(b) matches
 - Certification reimbursement
