OPENING ACTIVITIES

A. Call to Order

The Board of Education of Morgan County School District Re-3 met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. on December 8, 2025, in the Board Room at the District Support Center with the following members present: Mrs. Christi Chisum, Mrs. Amy Grantham, Mrs. Nancy Hopper, Dr. John Prouty, Mrs. Mindy Smith, and Mrs. Sarah Whitney. Also, present were Mr. Rob Sanders, Superintendent; Mr. Jason Frasco, Assistant Superintendent; Dr. Rena Frasco, Assistant Superintendent; and Ms. Toni Miller, Chief Financial Officer. Mrs. Kati Jess was absent.

B. Approval of Previous Minutes

Mrs. Amy Grantham made a motion to approve the minutes from the special meeting on November 17, 2025, and the regular meeting on November 17, 2025, as presented. Mrs. Mindy Smith seconded the motion. On Roll Call vote, "AYE" 6; "NAY" 0; "ABSTAIN" 0; "ABSENT" 1. Motion carried.

C. Agenda Changes; Approval of Agenda

Dr. John Prouty made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Mrs. Amy Grantham seconded the motion. On Roll Call vote, "AYE" 6; "NAY" 0; "ABSTAIN" 0; "ABSENT" 1. Motion carried.

SPECIAL PRESENTATION

A. Mill Levy – Ms. Toni Miller

Ms. Toni Miller presented the 2025 Mill Levy Certification to the Board. She reported that the District's total assessed valuation increased by \$24,000,000 compared to the prior year. The District's General Fund Mill Levy remains at 27 Mills, and the override is capped at \$550,000. This year, the District is able to assess \$540,983.38. Our total debt service requirements are \$2,700,000, which is equal to the 7.169 Mills. The District is permitted to include abatements, with the combined valuations totaling \$204,452, resulting in an additional 0.535 Mills. Overall, the total Mill Levy for 2025 is 36.144 Mills, which is a decrease from the prior year amount of 36.278.

REPORTS

A. Fort Morgan High School Representative – Ms. Kenzie Rau

Much of Fort Morgan High School's current focus is on preparing for final exams next week. In the spirit of Thanksgiving, the Student Senate assembled and distributed more

than 30 meal boxes to families in need. The drama department has selected *Tuck Everlasting* as their spring musical. Auditions are completed and the roles have been cast. The drama department will also be hosting a game night on December 9, 2025.

B. Board – Mrs. Nancy Hopper

Mrs. Amy Grantham attended her first CBOCES (Centennial BOCES, or Board of Cooperative Educational Services) meeting, which included introductions of new members. Most districts noted enrollment declines across the state for reasons similar to ours and that we are all facing the same challenges. The group reviewed the financial report and announced that the next meeting will be in January.

Mrs. Nancy Hopper reminded the Board of the upcoming CASB (Colorado Association of School Boards) 85th Annual Convention, scheduled for December 11–13, 2025. She requested that Board members plan to report on the sessions they attend at the next Board meeting.

C. Superintendent – Mr. Rob Sanders

Mr. Rob Sanders addressed our declining enrollment. One of the strategies being explored is recapturing students who have previously left our District. Last week, our administrative team met with Mr. Dan Morrison from Colorado Digital Learning Solutions (CDLS). He is excited to partner with us, and we believe we can offer an appealing online learning option for our students. This would be available to students currently in home schools and potentially others who may be interested. Our plan is to tie this program to one of our existing schools rather than creating a separate school entity. This approach simplifies administration, as it avoids the need for separate building codes, principals, or budgets. While it will require coordination, we do not anticipate it being overly complicated to implement. Even capturing 50 students could generate significant revenue for the District while allowing us to have our own staff monitoring and supporting the students. CDLS reports a graduation rate of 88%, which aligns closely with our outcomes.

The program offers flexibility for Kindergarten through 12th grade students. The administrative team is excited about the potential of this partnership. While it may be too early to formally launch in January 2026, a pilot plan with a few students is in the works. The goal is to formally roll out the program in the fall, giving us time to actively market it, and evaluate whether we can reach the enrollment levels needed.

Mrs. Christi Chisum shared that when she was a school counselor, her district worked with CDLS. At that time, there were not as many options for credit recovery. She added that this program was very user-friendly. The contacts and support provided were extremely helpful, making it a solid program to consider.

The administrative team was impressed with the presentation, particularly the fact that the program would utilize our staff for a significant portion of the instruction. CDLS is able to support special needs students, work with IEP (Individualized Education Program)

teams, provide ELL (English Language Learner) support, and collaborate closely with our staff. While it will not be the easiest program to implement, it is manageable and allows us to potentially bring students back into our District and ensure they receive a quality education. Mr. Dan Morrison, who recently became the co-director of CDLS, is a longtime colleague and trusted partner. The administrative team is looking forward to this partnership.

District Support Center administrators met with our elementary principals to review the four potential options for redistricting. Mr. Rob Sanders shared the final report from Mr. Shannon Bingham with the Board and District employees. While there was a minor error regarding classrooms at Sherman Early Childhood Center, this was corrected and did not affect the overall outcome.

There have been several questions regarding the redistricting process and hosting meetings with staff. To ensure consistent communication and shared understanding, Mr. Rob Sanders and Dr. Rena Frasco recorded a video outlining the rationale behind the four redistricting options. Each elementary principal will share the video with their respective staff during an upcoming staff meeting. Following the viewing, staff will engage in discussions to review the pros and cons of each option. This approach supports building-level dialogue while maintaining clarity for District-level considerations.

Mr. Rob Sanders scheduled a District Accountability Committee meeting to further discuss redistricting. Following winter break, recommendations will be presented to the Board. He noted that he meets monthly with FMEA (Fort Morgan Education Association) to address any questions and concerns. This ongoing communication helps prevent minor issues from escalating and reflects a strong, collaborative working relationship with the District's associations.

Lastly, the possibility of live-streaming Board meetings was considered. The Technology Department has confirmed that the District's system is capable of supporting live streaming. Legal considerations are currently being reviewed to ensure compliance prior to implementation. The goal is to live stream at the next Board meeting.

D. Assistant Superintendent Curriculum/Assessment – Dr. Rena Frasco

Dr. Rena Frasco shared that over the past month our Crisis Response Team has provided support across multiple buildings due to several incidents. She extended her appreciation to the members of this team, our counselors, and the Fort Morgan High School (FMHS) administrative team and staff for their professionalism, compassion, and unwavering commitment during these challenging circumstances. FMHS teacher Mrs. Liz Schmidt gave Dr. Rena Frasco permission to share a note she recently wrote.

To be a teacher is to be a keeper of countless stories, a witness to the spark of genius, and a constant recipient of pure, unbridled potential. There is no greater professional joy than the one found in the daily meeting of unique, amazing students. Each young person

who walks into the classroom is a universe unto themselves—a dazzling mix of dreams, curiosity, and boundless energy. We are privileged to watch them grapple with big ideas, find their voices, and evolve before our eyes. That tapestry of individual spirits is, quite simply, the reason we are here.

Yet, this calling places us in a uniquely vulnerable and complex space. The very intensity of the connection we forge with our students means we are not insulated from the harsh realities of life. We are, at times, asked to serve as anchors in the deepest, most turbulent waters.

We deal with far too much tragedy and loss. The truth is, when a student is lost—whether suddenly or after a long battle—a piece of the school's heart breaks, and a piece of our own goes with them. The grief for a student we have taught, mentored, and laughed with is a heavy, private sorrow. It is a loss that defies the typical professional boundary, because the relationship was never merely transactional; it was deeply human.

The truly extraordinary and demanding position we find ourselves in is this: we must manage our own deep grief while simultaneously trying to help a classroom, a grade level, or an entire community of young adults process their own profound feelings of loss, confusion, and pain. We must be the stable presence that guides them through the chaos of tragedy, even as we ourselves are trembling.

It is an almost impossible act of emotional courage—to mourn fully in your heart, but to stand strong and steady in your role. It is the quiet, unsung burden of the educational vocation. But in those moments of shared vulnerability, when we help a student find the words for their sadness or simply offer a moment of safe silence, we realize the full, deep meaning of our commitment: to teach not just the mind, but the heart.

Mr. Rob Sanders commented that the statement was very well articulated. It has been truly remarkable to witness the FMHS staff and administrators support students, both figuratively and, at times, literally, during these challenging circumstances. He extended his sincere appreciation to the team. This work is never easy, and seeing the broader community come together to support our students and families has been truly inspiring. He expressed his deep empathy for the families and students affected. Being part of the Fort Morgan Mustang community during times like these is challenging, yet it has also reinforced pride in our District. While it has been a difficult year, we are fortunate to belong to an educational community where we can depend on one another for strength, support, and guidance.

E. Assistant Superintendent Human Resources – Mr. Jason Frasco

Mr. Jason Frasco presented the Personnel Action Report to the Board and reported that the District has experienced some unexpected movement within certified positions. At this time, there are five certified vacancies, five classified vacancies, and one coaching

vacancy. He is optimistic that three to four of these positions will be filled shortly, allowing our new staff to begin at the start of the second semester.

The District is currently in week two of open enrollment with American Fidelity for employee benefits. American Fidelity was selected as an option for supplemental insurance for staff across the District and is now administering our HSA (Health Savings Account), HRA (Health Reimbursement Account), and FLEX accounts. HSAs will begin in January 2026, while HRAs will be adjusted in September. Overall, the process has proceeded smoothly, and American Fidelity has been highly responsive to staff questions and concerns.

F. Chief Financial Officer - Ms. Toni Miller

Ms. Toni Miller provided the Board with a brief update on the audit process. At this stage, she is handling the auditor's daily requests for additional information, and added how much she appreciates the work of our audit team. They have been notably more efficient than firms we have worked with in the past and avoid unnecessary testing and are performing responsibilities that previously were handled by our staff. One thing she emphasized is that our new auditors are drafting the financial statements. As a result, her primary responsibility will be limited to preparing the management discussion and comments, which represents a substantial improvement in efficiency. While our goal is to complete the audit by December 31, the timeline may extend a few weeks into January. Overall, selecting this audit firm has proven to be an excellent decision, as they are delivering higher-quality service at less than half the cost of our previous auditors.

A. Fort Morgan High School Registration Guide for the 2026-2027 School Year

Mr. Clint Anderson presented the Board with the Fort Morgan High School (FMHS) Registration Guide for the 2026-2027 School Year. He recognized Mrs. Kim Baker, FMHS Registrar, for her extensive work compiling the guide, and to the counseling staff for their support in managing the registration process.

FMHS worked with Ms. Laurie Hickson, consultant with the Colorado School Counselor Corps Grant, in developing the registration guide. They began the process earlier this year in hopes to align schedules with staffing more efficiently, especially given our shift to a four-day week and the stability of our FMHS teaching staff. The process begins with meetings between teachers and administrators to review course offerings and proposed changes. The counseling office then works with administration to finalize edits. Their goal is to have student schedules largely finalized by late March or early April, allowing both students and counselors to plan before the end of the school year.

Some of the key changes are transitioning to an integrated math model, restructuring science courses for more flexibility, potentially adding a Colorado History course, and removing Economics. The counseling office will be responsible to maintain a list of weighted classes. Students will be directed to the counseling office to view this list, which

will be posted on the website at a later date. This approach ensures that the list remains accurate and up to date as course offerings expand. Mr. Clint Anderson expressed gratitude to the FMHS staff for their dedication to this important process.




