BOARD OF EDUCATION ELECTION RESOLUTION

TO: Comanche County Election Board

FROM: The Lawton Public School District, Independent School
District No. 16-1008 of Comanche, County, Oklahoma

The Board of Education of the Lawton Public School District has approved the following resolution calling for an election to be submitted to the voters of the district.

Date of the Election:

A Board of Education Primary Election shall be held on February 10, 2026, only if three or more candidates file for the Board of Education position scheduled to be on the ballot or for a Board of Education position appearing on the ballot as an unexpired term. A Board of Education General Election shall be held on April 7, 2026, under the following circumstances: if only two candidates file for a position scheduled to be on the ballot or for a position on the ballot for an unexpired term or if no candidate in the Board of Education Primary Election receives more than 50% of the votes cast. The polling places shall be open from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Board Member Position on Ballot:

The voters shall elect a board member for board position No. 1, which has a 5-year term of office.

Qualifications of Candidates for Office:

To be eligible to be a candidate for member of the board of education of a school district, a person must have resided in the district for at least six months preceding the first day of the filing period, and have been a registered voter registered with the county election board at an address located within the geographical boundaries of the district for six months preceding the first day of the filing period. In school districts that have been divided into election districts, a candidate must have resided in the district for six months preceding the first day of the filing period and have been a registered voter registered with the county election board at an

address located within the geographical boundaries of the election district for six months preceding the first day of the filing period.

No person shall be eligible to be a candidate for or elected to be a member of the board of education of a school district unless the person has been awarded a high school diploma or certificate of high school equivalency.

A person who has been convicted of a misdemeanor involving embezzlement or a felony under the laws of this state or of the United States or who has entered a plea of guilty or nolo contendere to such misdemeanor involving embezzlement or felony or who has been convicted of a crime in another state which would have been a misdemeanor involving embezzlement or a felony under the laws of this state or has entered a plea of guilty or nolo contendere to such crime shall not be eligible to be a candidate for or be elected to any school board office for a period of fifteen years following completion of his sentence or during the pendency of an appeal of such conviction or plea.

No person shall be eligible to be a candidate for or serve on a board of education if he or she is currently employed by the school district governed by the board of education or is related within the second degree by affinity or consanguinity to any other member of the board of education or to any employee of the school district. The following are relatives within the second degree: A candidate's spouse, child, parent, grandchild, grandparent, brother, sister, spouse's child, spouse's grandchild, spouse's brother, spouse's sister, spouse's grandparent, grandchild's spouse, parent's spouse, and child's spouse. The prohibitions in this paragraph shall not apply if the board member candidate is related within the second degree of affinity or consanguinity to an individual employed as a substitute teacher by the school district or as a temporary substitute support employee if the school district has an Average Daily Membership of less than five thousand (5,000).

Candidates must affirm that upon being elected as a new member of the Board of Education, within fifteen (15) months of election, they will complete at least twelve (12) hours of instruction on education issues, including school finance, Oklahoma education laws, and ethics, duties and responsibilities of district board of education members. Three (3) of these twelve (12) credits must be earned as follows: one (1) credit in ethics, one (1) credit in open meeting act and open records act, and one (1) credit in school finance. Incumbents must affirm that they will complete six (6) hours of instruction within fifteen (15) months of election emphasizing changes in school law. Three (3) of these six (6) credits must be earned as follows: one (1) credit in ethics, one (1) credit in open meeting act and open records act, and one (1) credit in school finance.

Voters Eligible to Vote:

To be eligible to vote, a voter must be registered with the county election board at an address within the geographical boundaries of the district.

Ballot Titles:

The ballot to be submitted to the voters shall call for the voters to:

1. Select one candidate for Lawton Public School Board Position No. 1.

Fall 2025 Cohort Dropout Report Summary

The Fall 2025 Cohort Dropout Report indicates that Lawton Public Schools has made significant long-term progress in reducing high school dropout rates, with a 63% decrease from 2021 to 2025, though there was a slight increase from 2.24% in 2024 to 2.95% in 2025. Middle school dropout rates, which had declined in 2024, also rose again in 2025 to 2.79%. Graduation rates improved from 77.56% in 2021 to 87.78% in 2024 before declining in 2025, reflecting statewide and national trends influenced by academic struggles, poverty, attendance issues, and student disengagement. It is important to note that data discrepancies have occurred in recent years due to exit code errors and communication issues between the district's student information system (Infinite Campus) and the State's accountability system, which limited accuracy in some reports. Despite these challenges, LPS is addressing student needs by expanding access to alternative and virtual education, career readiness programs, concurrent enrollment, and micro-certification opportunities. The district remains committed to improving graduation outcomes by boosting student engagement, providing real-world learning experiences, and ensuring students are prepared for success in college, careers, or both.

Fall 2025 Cohort Dropout Report

Oklahoma Schools are required to report student dropout numbers for grades 7-12 (70 OS 35E). The data is gathered annually between October 1 of the previous school year (SY) through the start of the subsequent SY. Data gathered for this report stems from Oklahoma State Department of Education's (OSDE) Accountability Report and the LPS student information system (SIS): Infinite Campus. Additionally, the graduation rate is reported via student cohort specifications. While both the dropout rate and the graduation rate are different, together, they provide a snapshot of yearly dropout percentages.

Dropouts: Figure 1 elucidates the high school 5-year dropout data from 2021-2025, and Figure 2 elucidates the middle school dropout data from 2021 to 2025. Current data demonstrates an overall decrease in high school dropout rates of 63% from 2021 to 2025, but an increase from 2024, 2.24% to 2025, 2.95%. Middle school dropout rates across the nation and Oklahoma have been on the increase since Covid in 2019-2020. However, in 2024, middle school dropout rates fell from 2.89% in 2023 to 1.86% in 2024, but advanced again to 2.79% in 2025.

It is important to note that the SY 2025 dropout data is not available yet in OSDE Accountability Reporting and the 2025 data stems wholly from the student information system, Infinite Campus. Also, there have been points of departure in the past two years that caused the dropout numbers to be skewed due to exit code errors discovered in the SIS, Infinite Campus. While these errors were corrected, many were not reflected in the OSDE Accountability Report due to the closure of the correction window at the time. It is also important to note that in SY 22/23, Lawton's 5.17% dropout rate was significantly attributed to the 8.6% dropout rate at Lawton High School.

Graduation: Figure 3 illustrates the LPS 5-year, site graduation percentages, and Figure 4 portrays the 5-year graduation trend. Graduation rates increased 13.18 % from 2021 to 2024 from 77.56% to 87.78% but declined in 2025. LPS is just one of many districts experiencing an increase in dropout rates and lower graduation rates. Project Oklahoma identifies academic struggles, growing poverty, poor attendance, and student disengagement as reasons for the dip in graduation and rise in dropout rates.

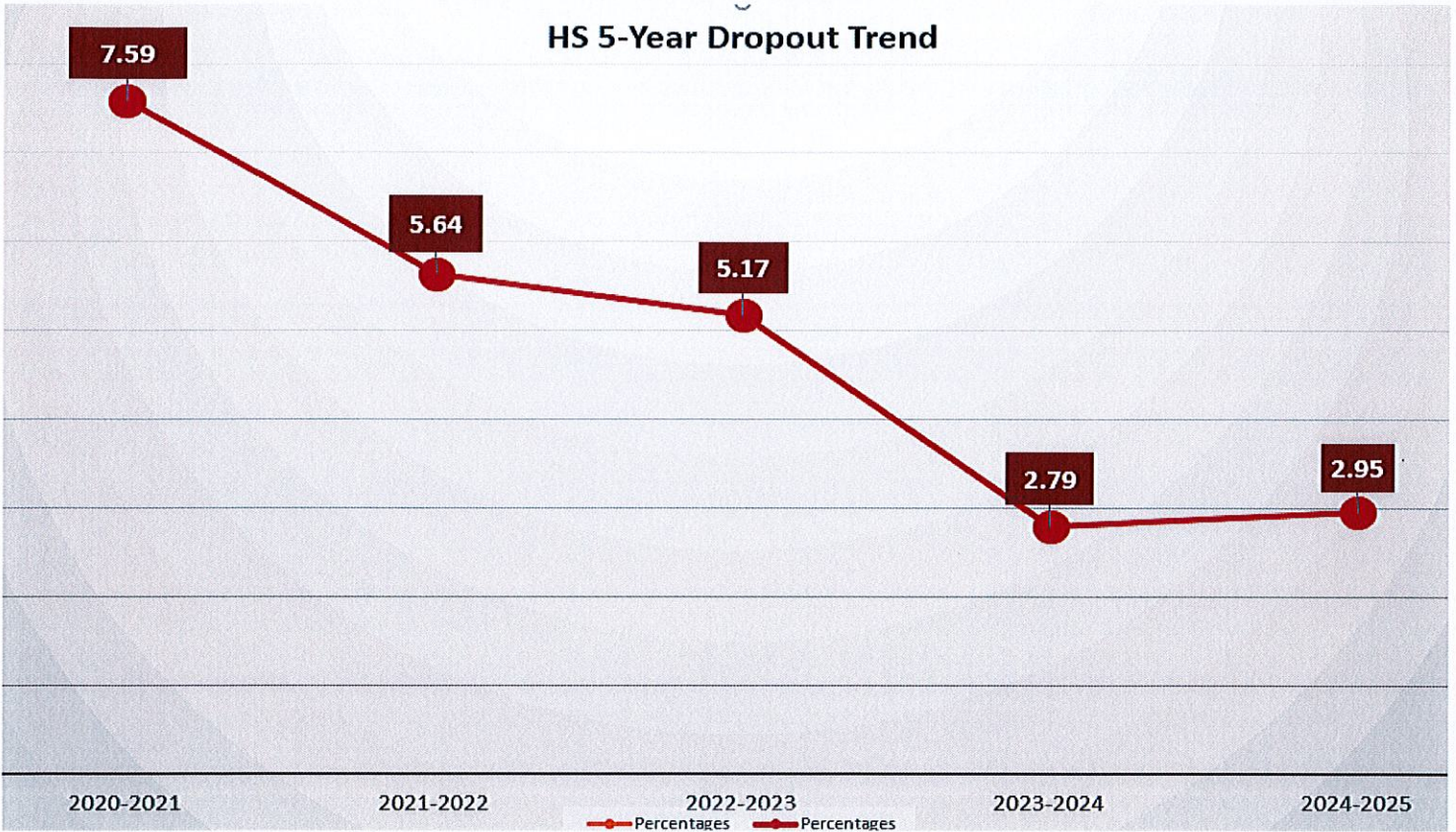
While there were many venues of learning available for LPS students, the constant revolution of environmental strife for many LPS students has an effect on dropout and graduation outcomes. However, LPS is transforming how students learn, focusing on providing them with the real-world skills needed for success in school and beyond. The district is boosting student engagement and making learning more relevant through a new curriculum and innovative opportunities. While graduation and dropout rates have recently seen a slight dip, LPS is dedicated to improving student outcomes and will continue to expand access to learning opportunities.

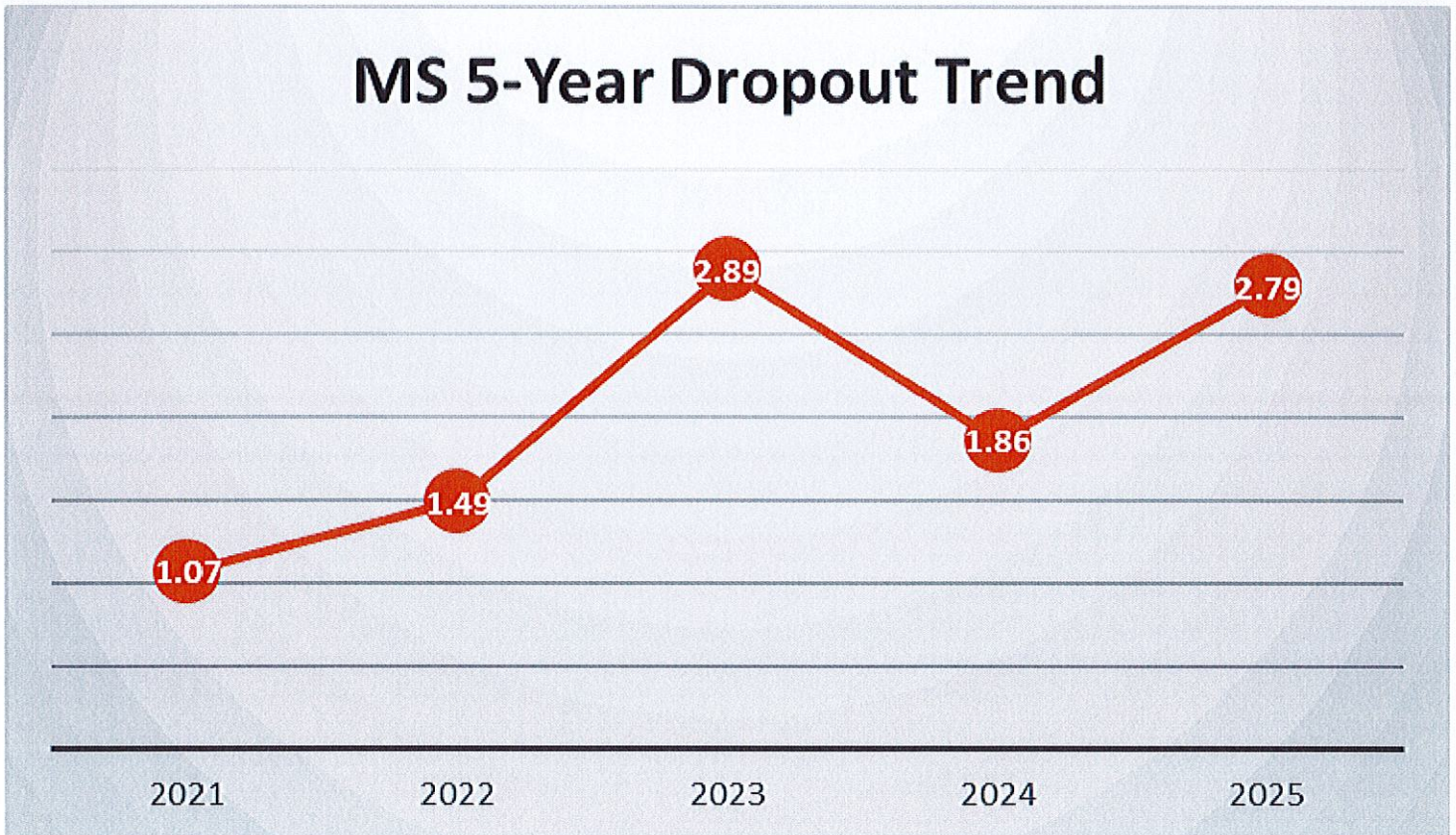

HS 5-Year Dropout Trend



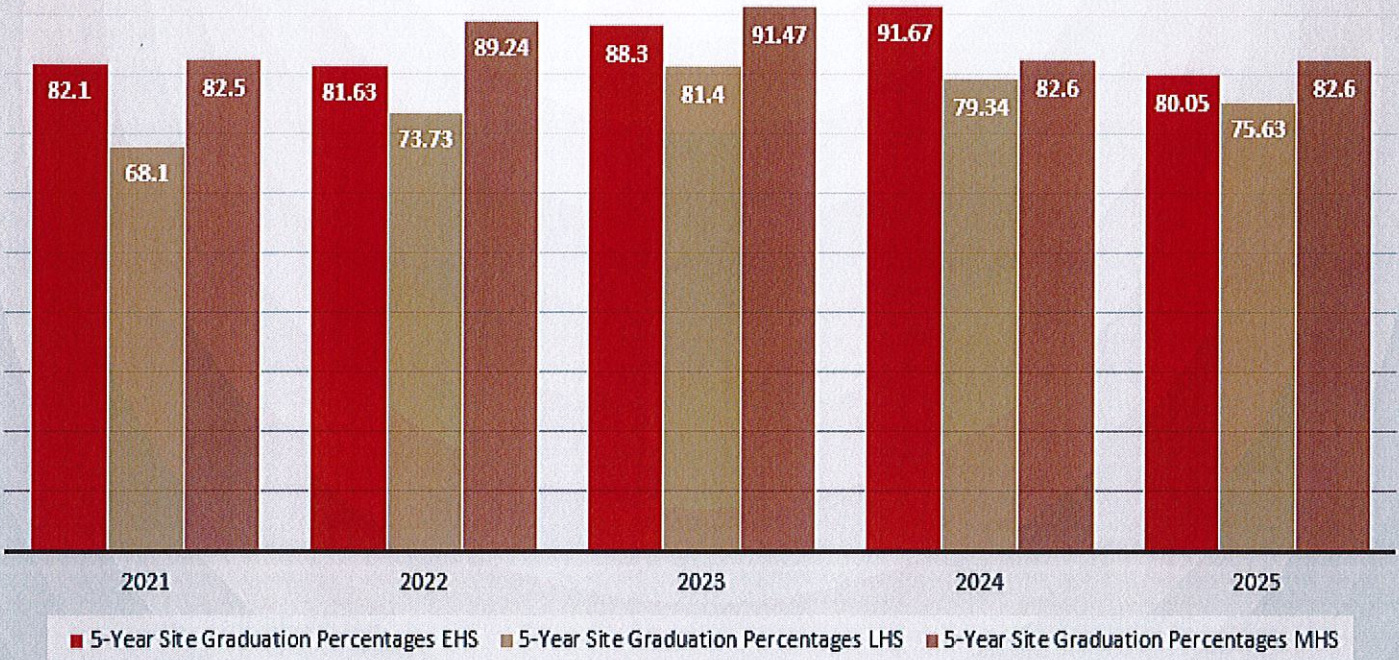

MS 5-Year Dropout Trend



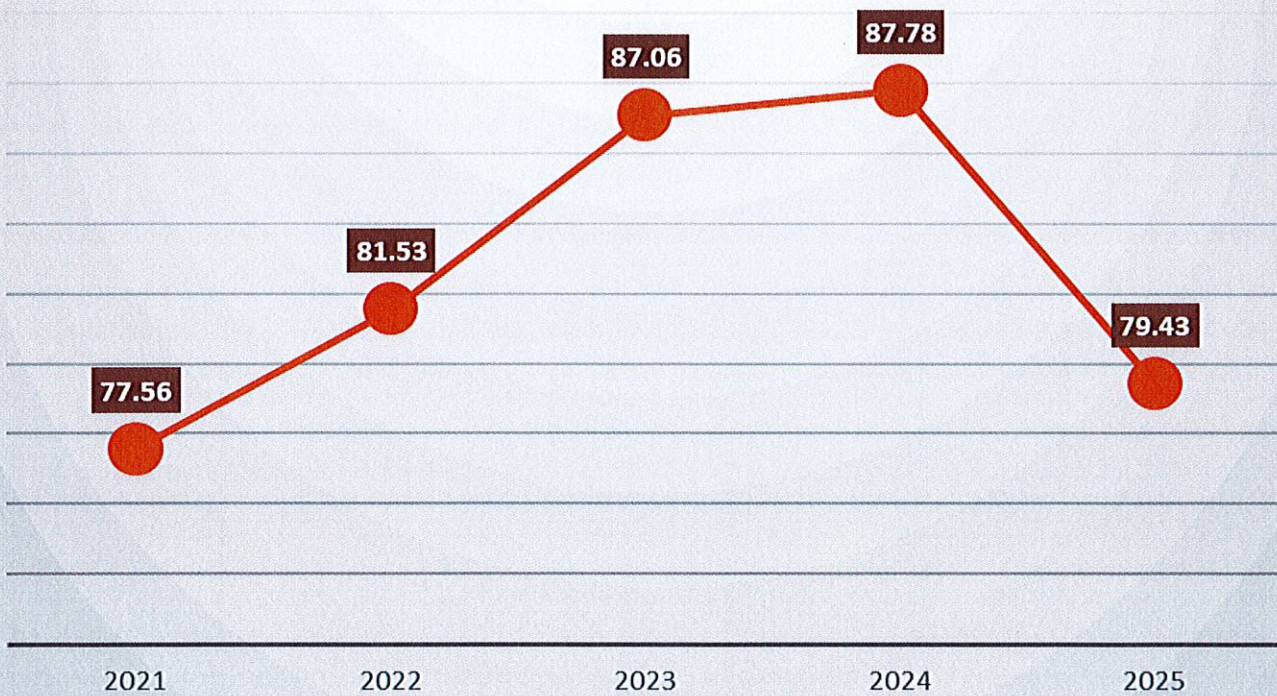
