6.A. RETIREMENT: PERSONNEL ACTION AND AGREEMENT

Vice President Hamme stated that the Retirement Agreement for Dr. Davies is in alignment with the Superintendent's Contract.

President Rice acknowledged Dr. Davies for his nine years of work with the District and for having done an admirable job.

Director Herman acknowledged that Dr. Davies will be missed. She appreciated that everything he had done was done with purpose and in the District's best interest.

9. DISCUSSION ITEMS

9.A. CONTRACTS / AGREEMENTS

Ms. Jacoby presented the Liberty University contracts and Ms. Holman presented the Commonwealth University of PA MOU and the LIU12 ECYEH Program LOA.

9.B. ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ASSESSMENT COMMITTEE

Ms. Holman presented that the District is requesting the establishment of an Assessment Committee. The first task of the Committee will be to finalize a new Board Policy 605.1 using a draft that has been provided to the District. Vice President Hamme and Director Deardorff both indicated interest in being on the new committee. Vice President Hamme shared that with the economic pressure on the District, the District's assessment revenue appears to be low, and establishing this committee and a new Board Policy will assist with bringing assessment in better alignment.

9.C. LEAD TESTING

Ms. Holman shared that the District has consistently, over the last several years of testing, recorded very low lead levels. As a result, we are not recommending additional testing at this time. Should the time come that we feel testing is warranted, we will resume testing.

9.D. ARTIFICIAL TURF SWEEP

Ms. Holman shared that discussions at the latest Facilities meeting concluded that we are not in need of the Artificial Turf Sweep.

The Utility Terrain Vehicle and the field groomer will keep the artificial turf in shape.

9.E. BASEBALL FIELD UPDATES

Ms. Holman shared that the District will be requesting approval of fencing (\$4,000) and stone removal (\$9,000), as well as the moving of the existing bleachers to make them closer to being ADA compliant. These costs are covered by the current construction fund. Director Herman asked about the area in right field that was fenced in and now the fencing is gone, as it had been determined the area was a sinkhole. Ms. Holman shared that the fencing came down as a result of the Township determining it was not a sinkhole. Director Gettys asked about the leveling of the outfield and requested that the topic be added to the next Facilities agenda. Director Deardorff, Facilities Board Chair, indicated he would have it added to the next agenda.

9.F. UTILITY TERRAIN VEHICLE

Director Deardorff inquired about the approximately \$1,000 in freight charges and during discussion it was confirmed that the freight charges are for the delivery of the vehicle from the manufacturer to the local dealership, not the cost of the delivery of the vehicle from the dealership to our facility. The cost is covered by the construction funds and was a known piece of equipment needed to care for the facility. The quote from Don's Kawasaki will be on the September 15 agenda for Board approval.

President Rice shared that during a Committee of the Board meeting held prior to the Work Session, the Board identified four additional questions to have the applicants complete by noon on Friday, September 11. At the September 15 Board Meeting, the Board members will vote on the final candidates to invite for in-person interviews at the Board Meeting on September 22, where the final candidate will be selected and sworn in.

President Rice shared that the first meeting is scheduled for September 15th. We have a lot of great things happening, and we are looking at the field usage and the teams.

Director Shah indicated that the first meeting is scheduled for October 20.

Vice President Hamme shared that the first meeting was held earlier this evening. The Committee reviewed various trainings currently planned such as Structured Literacy, CRP/AED, etc. We also reviewed the HMH Trial, as well as Middle School curriculum impacts with schedules around Social Studies and Exploratories. The next meeting is November 10.

11.E. FACILITIES COMMITTEE (Deardorff)

Director Deardorff shared that there is a bi-weekly meeting with the construction team tomorrow and there will be more to share at the September 15th Board Meeting.

11.F. FOUNDATION FOR THE WYASD (Dugan)

Director Dugan spoke about the upcoming Harlem Wizards Basketball fundraiser event and the need for volunteers and sponsors.

11.G. WELLNESS COMMITTEE (Dugan)

Director Dugan shared that the first meeting is scheduled for September 24.

11.H. WEST MANCHESTER TOWNSHIP RECREATION COMMITTEE (Harlacher)

Director Harlacher shared that at the last meeting, he provided them with our construction update.

11.I. YORK COUNTY SCHOOL OF TECHNOLOGY (Gettys) and YCST AUTHORITY (Gettys)

Director Gettys shared that at the last YCST meeting, they discussed a curriculum review and rolled out participation levels as they are still having excessive wait lists. Next month they will have a breakdown by majors, students applied/accepted, etc. by school district. President Rice asked about whether YCST is looking at the impact of AI on their classes and what they are offering. Director Gettys shared that they have an Advisory Council looking at it. They are going to establish goals for their Executive Director - CTE for juniors and seniors in member districts. This will move slower than districts would like, but it's on the radar.

Director Gettys shared that there hasn't been a meeting of the YCST Authority.

11.J. YORK ADAMS ACADEMY (Rice)

President Rice shared that, with so many pulling together to support Dr. Mancuso at Eastern York SD, the York Adams Academy canceled their scheduled meeting.

11.K. YORK/LIU JOINT AUTHORITY (Gettys) and LIU BOARD (Gettys)

Director Gettys shared that there is a meeting later this month for the York/LIU Joint Authority. Preliminary project approvals from most districts were received and will be finalized next month. This will be a 3–4 year project.

Director Gettys shared that the LIU Board shared about the Health Center Partnership and services for county employees and other public community entities. Possibly something for us to look at as well.

Buildings may then be leveled to a maximum of 3 feet at the highest corner. If leveling requires one (1) foot or less, pressure treated wood may be used. If placement of the building requires it to be set on concrete blocks, the customer must have them ready PRIOR to delivery OR have a clear agreement with the driver to supply the blocks at a price to be negotiated with the driver. In very rare cases, underground footers may be required by local building codes. Old Hickory Buildings does not offer digging or footer services, and these services are not included in free setup. However, we can work with Customer or a contractor when required for an additional cost. Free delivery covers one trip up to thirty (30) miles one way. 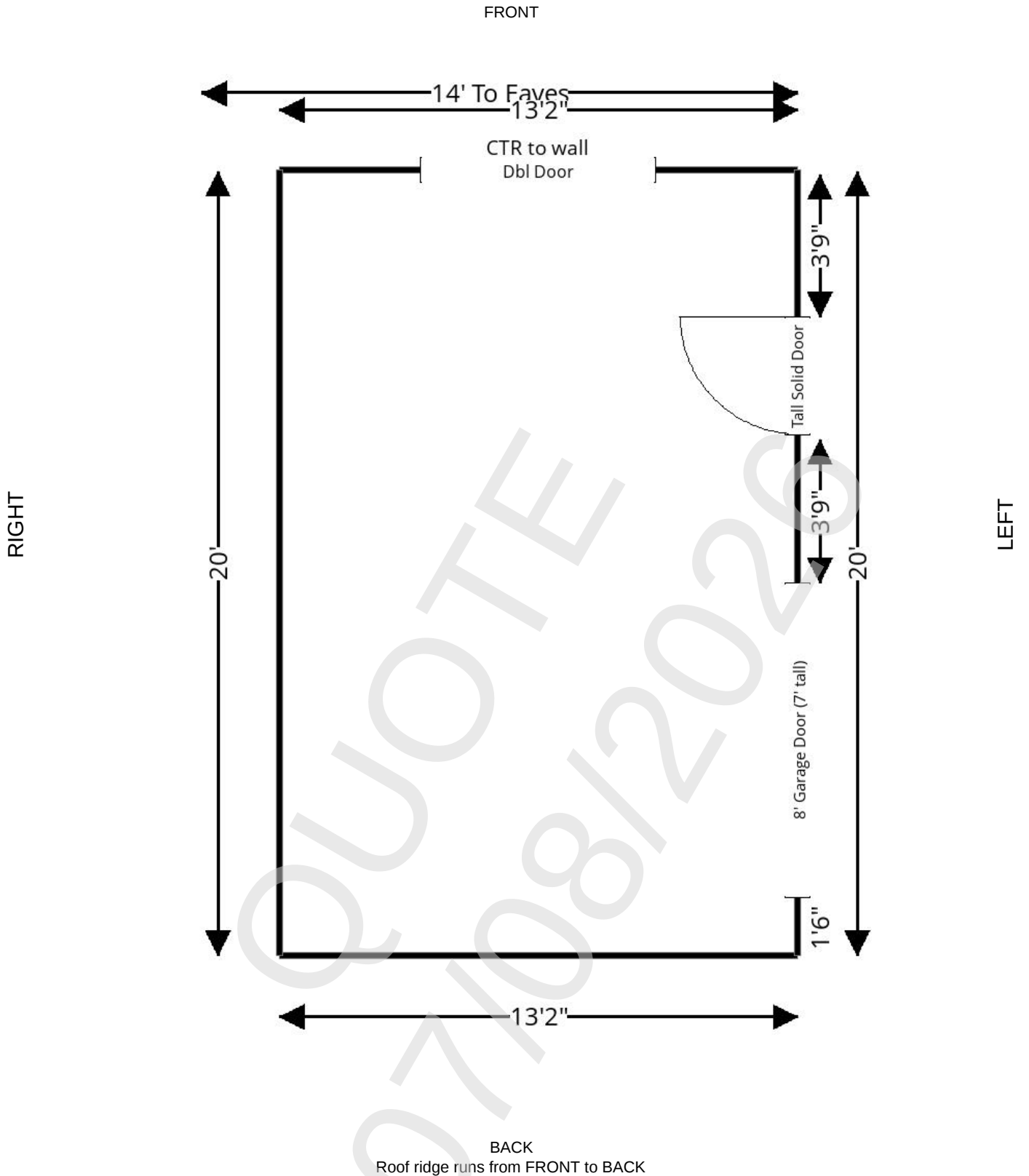

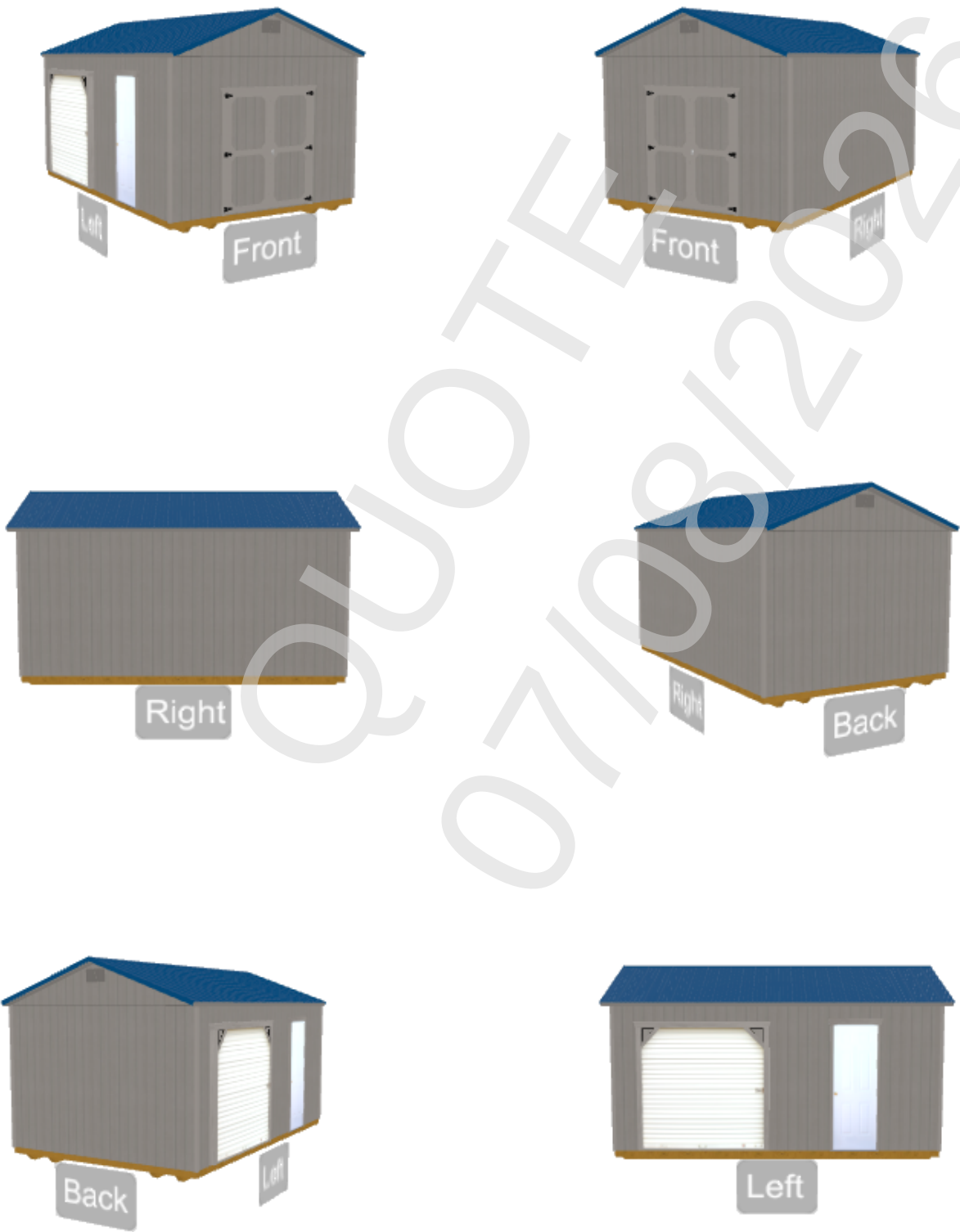

Additional Terms, Conditions and Warranties

1. SALE IS NOT FINAL. This Agreement is subject to approval and execution by Old Hickory's corporate office. Old Hickory has the right to refuse any sale up until the time when the building is set up at customer's location. Old Hickory shall have the right to correct any errors in this Agreement concerning pricing or taxes.

2. LIMITED WARRANTY. Customer will receive a limited five-year warranty. The details of this warranty can be found online at www.oldsickorybuildings.com. Customer acknowledges that Customer has been provided a copy of this warranty or have had adequate time to review this warranty online. Discounted Buildings do not carry a warranty on cosmetic issues.

3. DELIVERY AND SETUP. Old Hickory strives to deliver all buildings in a timely manner consistent with our customers' expectations; however, Old Hickory does not guarantee dates or times of delivery. Customer expressly understands that inclement weather, vehicle problems, difficulties at other delivery locations, and/or other unforeseen circumstances can affect the date and time of delivery. Old Hickory is not responsible for any of Customer's lost work time associated with any delays or rescheduled deliveries. Customer represents that the delivery location will be accessible by a truck and trailer. It is the Customer's responsibility to decide if ground conditions are unsuitable or too wet for delivery. Customer is responsible for informing the delivery driver of any utility hazards or any other relevant matter prior to commencement of setup.

4. LIMITATIONS. Old Hickory is not responsible for permits, snow/wind load requirements, covenant searches, restrictions, setbacks, yard damage, or underground damage. Please contact your local building inspector and/or homeowner's association for information on requirements and restrictions. Customer shall be solely responsible for and shall obtain any necessary permits PRIOR TO installation. Customer agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Old Hickory and its independent contractor delivery drivers for any yard damage done during installations and/or any violation of any government ordinance or code resulting from the installation of any Old Hickory product at Customer's location. Customer releases Old Hickory and its independent contractor delivery drivers from any claims for punitive, indirect, incidental, special, or consequential damages.

5. PAYMENT. Drivers do not take credit cards. All balances due must be paid by cash or check on delivery. Balance due paid by credit card must be paid prior to delivery. Credit card price is 3% higher than discounted cash price listed on the work order. In the event building is not paid for before or on delivery, driver will not leave building and additional trip charges will be incurred. All amounts not paid at delivery will be considered past due. If customer chooses to postpone construction start date, the customer still must pay the balance due within 90 days of construction completion regardless of whether building is delivered.

6. CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS. If Customer is dissatisfied with the Old Hickory product upon acceptance of delivery by Customer or Customer's authorized agent, Customer's sole recourse is to file a warranty claim.

7. LATE PAYMENT, COSTS OF COLLECTION, AND RETRIEVAL. Unless otherwise prohibited by state law, if Old Hickory must engage in any effort to secure payment or otherwise seek to compel Customer to fulfill any of Customer's obligations under this Agreement, Customer agrees to reimburse Old Hickory for any and all reasonable attorney fees, costs, and other expenses. For cash sales, Old Hickory may charge a monthly late fee equal to 10% of the amount due or the maximum amount allowed by law. 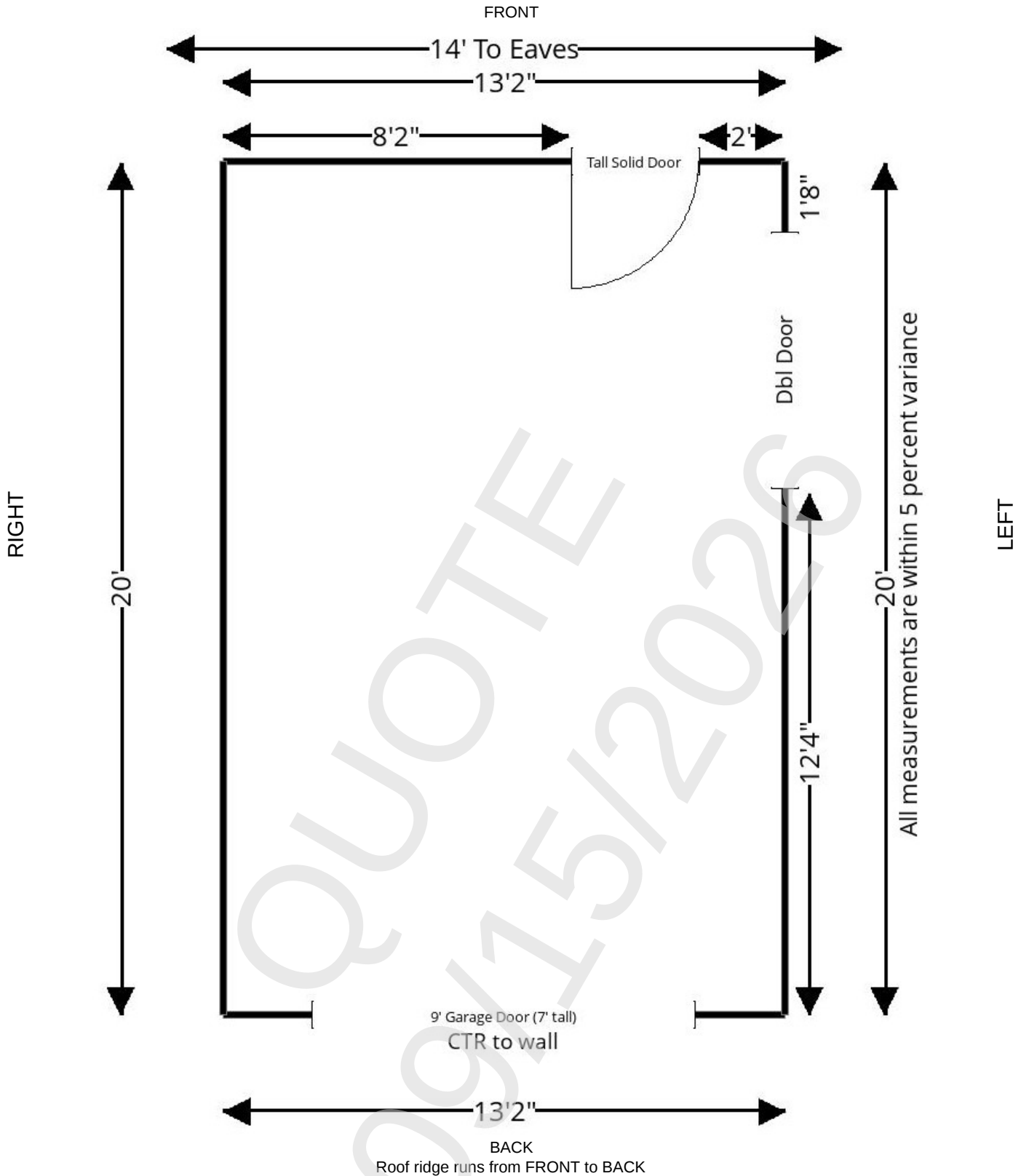

Public Schools and Liberty University Student Teaching Agreement

THIS AGREEMENT ("Agreement") made this 15 day of September, 2026 (the "Effective Date"), by and between LIBERTY UNIVERSITY, INC. ("Liberty") and West York Area School District ("Public School"), on behalf of itself and its affiliates and subsidiaries, if any;

Liberty's Student Teacher Program is approved by the Virginia Department of Education, and as part of Liberty's formal, educational course of studies require clinical/occupational experiences of students, and desires to assign certain of its students to one or more of Public School's facilities to obtain such clinical/occupational experience; and

Public School, in service to the community and to promote high standards of preparation and training for students, is willing to provide the necessary facilities for clinical/occupational experiences;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing premises and mutual covenants and promises contained herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

The duties and responsibilities of Liberty, Public School and Student found within the Liberty Student Teaching Program are hereby incorporated by reference into this agreement. It can be found at www.liberty.edu/education/field-experience/host-educator-training/.

Student Teachers are to complete placements at the end of the degree program. The length of placement shall cover the entire span of a 15 week semester. Student Teachers shall complete a minimum of 150 Direct Teaching Hours. Direct Teaching hours include, but are not limited to, classroom teaching, tutoring, and group instruction. Non- Instructional hours including observation, bus duty, cafeteria duty, and coaching are recorded separately. A Student Teacher candidate shall submit a completed application and meet all requirements prior to an application being approved to be considered for a student teaching position, including following the Public School system's requirements regarding background checks. All Student Teachers shall have Professional Liability Insurance and provide evidence of this as part of their application process. The Student Teacher shall abide by both Liberty's and Public School's rules and regulations.

The Student Teacher is to conduct herself/himself in a professional manner. Failure to abide by this provision shall be grounds for removal from the program. The Student Teacher shall not act as a substitute teacher in the absence of the Cooperating Teacher.

Public School shall help facilitate and provide an environment where Student Teachers can fulfill the requirements of the Student Teacher Program. Public School shall have sole discretion in determining whether to allow a placement for each Student Teacher.

Liberty and Public School shall assume joint responsibility to educate Cooperating Teachers of the duties and obligations of working with a Student Teacher. County School Board shall work with Liberty to identify properly qualified and certified teachers to serve as a Cooperating Teacher from within the school system under whose direct supervision the Student Teacher will teach.

Commonwealth University of Pennsylvania
Memorandum of Understanding
Early College Program

THIS AGREEMENT is entered by and between Commonwealth University of Pennsylvania hereinafter referred to as "the University" and West York Area School District hereinafter referred to as "the District," a public-school district under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, "the Commonwealth."

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the University is a unit of higher learning of the State System of Higher Education of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature has determined by *Act 188 of 1982* that the primary mission of the State System of Higher Education of Pennsylvania is to provide high quality education at the lowest possible cost; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the State System of Higher Education is to provide undergraduate instruction, and opportunities for personal growth consistent with the legislated mission of the System; and

WHEREAS, certain students in the District may benefit from the opportunity to take classes offered by the University while enrolled in high school; and

WHEREAS, the University wishes to develop an Early College Program to recruit outstanding high school students to the University student body, and

WHEREAS, the District wishes to make certain undergraduate courses offered by the University available to the students of the District; and

WHEREAS, the District and the University desire to describe the features, purposes and mechanisms of the relationship by which the parties will establish a relationship in a collaborative arrangement; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement is intended to function as a collaborative agreement in accordance with said Board of Governors Policy 1999-02.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and mutual covenants contained herein, the parties hereto mutually agree and agree as follows:

1. Term. This Agreement shall be effective upon the review and approval of all the necessary parties and Commonwealth officials and in effect as of the date of the last signature. The term of this agreement shall be for a total of three (3) years commencing upon the review and approval of all necessary parties and Commonwealth officials. The agreement will be reviewed at the conclusion of each year, including the ability to suggest recommended changes that satisfy the interests of the District and the University. At the conclusion of the agreement's third year, the parties, at their mutual option, may extend this agreement for another subsequent period of time not to exceed two additional years.

2. Academic Suitability. The suitability of any course for the program will be determined by agreement between the District and the University on a course-by-course basis. The District will also determine, on a student-by-student basis, the suitability of a course for each of the District's students who wish to enroll in the course.

3. Enrollment. Students must meet the minimum guidelines established by the Early College office. When endorsing a student for the Early College program, please consider the student's character, integrity, and maturity to increase the prospect of success in the program. Students selected by the District for enrollment in an Early College Program course will be enrolled as non-degree students at the University. In order to aid the enrollment of the District's students, the District will provide, without cost to the University, the documentation necessary to the students' enrollment. This includes confirmation from the school counselor attesting to the academic preparedness of the student for college-level course(s). Each student will have to apply to the University for non-degree status.

4. Semesters and Sessions. Students selected by the District may enroll in online courses, hybrid or blended courses, and/or face-to-face courses under this agreement during both the academic year and the summer and winter sessions as non-degree University students. Enrollment is on a space-available basis.

5. Regular Admission. Early College students who are eligible for admission will be automatically reviewed and conditionally admitted to the University. Any other student from the District who wishes to become a fully matriculated undergraduate student upon graduation from high school must follow the normal application process. All students must meet admission criteria for Commonwealth University generally and for any admission criteria specific to the academic program the student is seeking to enroll in. Certain majors, including many in the health sciences, have additional admissions requirements. Tuition reductions described in paragraph 7 do not apply once a student enrolls in the University outside of this consortial arrangement under this Agreement.

6. Transcription of Courses. Courses offered under this agreement will be transcribed in the same manner as other courses offered by the University. Students may obtain official transcripts of their coursework from the Office of the Registrar.

7. Fiscal Issues. The University will offer courses to the District's students at a single, reduced rate for enrollment, inclusive of tuition and fees. Fees included in the rate exclude the usage of the Recreation Center and Student Health Centers on all campuses of Commonwealth University. The student will be responsible for the following fees:

- a) The Early College/dual enrollment program will be at a reduced rate of 75% off of the in-state tuition cost, which is limited to students of the District.
- b) University withdrawals and refunds will be handled under the University's refund policy.

8. Class Size. Certain minimum class size enrollment may restrict access to desired courses. The University reserves the right to set course enrollment size.

9. Rights, Privileges, and Responsibilities. Students registered as non-degree students at Commonwealth University under this agreement will have use of the library, and other academic resources. The Early College students will not have access to the Recreation Center or Student Health Center on any campus of Commonwealth University. All Commonwealth University policies and procedures, including, but not limited to, academic policies and student discipline policies shall apply.

10. Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act. All Parties shall agree to keep confidential all personally identifiable student information from educational records provided as set forth in the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act and its implementing regulations, 34 CFR CH. 99 ("FERPA"). The following requirements shall apply:

- a) All data shared between the University and the District is considered confidential and cannot be disclosed or re-disclosed to any other third party, except as provided below:
 - i. The School District and University may exchange information on the student.
 - ii. Information on the student should only be shared within the School District entity with District officials who have a legitimate need to view the information to verify or audit the qualifications of the student to participate in this program at the University.
 - iii. If the student is under 18, the parents still retain the rights under FERPA at the high school and may inspect and review any records sent maintained by the School District.
 - iv. The University may disclose personally identifiable information from the student's education records to the parents, without the consent of the eligible student, only with the student's written consent or if the student is a dependent for tax purposes under the IRS rules.
- b) For all other sharing purposes not described herein, the University will require students to sign a specific FERPA release.

11. Liability. Neither of the parties shall assume any liabilities to each other. As to liability to each other for death to persons, or damages to property, the parties do not waive any defense as a result of entering into this agreement. This provision shall not be construed to limit the Commonwealth's rights, claims, or defenses, which arise as a matter of law pursuant to any provisions of this agreement. This provision shall not be construed to limit the sovereign immunity of the Commonwealth, the State System of Higher Education, or the University.

12. Insurance. As an agency of the Commonwealth, public university and state instrumentality, there is no statutory authority for the University to purchase insurance. Instead, the University participates in the Commonwealth's Tort Claims Self-Insurance program administered by the Bureau of Finance and Risk Management of the Pennsylvania Department of General Services.

13. Amendment. This Agreement may be amended at any time upon the mutual written agreement of the parties hereto, with said amendments to be executed by the duly authorized representatives of the parties and with the same formality as this agreement.

14. Termination. This agreement may be terminated by either party upon 120 days written notice. Said notice to the University shall be sent to the President. Said notice to the District shall be sent to the Superintendent of the District.

15. Choice of Law. This Agreement is executed pursuant to and shall be construed under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

16. Entire Agreement. This is the entire Agreement between the parties hereto and supersedes all prior negotiations and oral understandings between the parties hereto.

8. Ensure that disputes are resolved and assistance to access transportation is provided.
9. Ensure that unaccompanied youth are enrolled in school and experience no barriers that prevent them from receiving credit for full or partial coursework satisfactorily completed at a prior school.
10. Participate in appropriate professional development and technical assistance.
