HOMESTEAD AND FARMSTEAD EXCLUSION
RESOLUTION
2026-2027**

RESOLVED, by the Board of School Directors of the Penn-Trafford School District (School District), that homestead and farmstead exclusion real estate tax assessments reductions are authorized for the school year beginning July 1, 2026 under the provisions of the Homestead Property Exclusion Program Act (part of Act 50 of 1998) and the Taxpayer Relief Act (Act 1 of 2006), as follows:

1. **Amount available for homestead and farmstead real estate tax reduction.** The following amount is available for the homestead and farmstead real estate tax reduction for the school year beginning July 1, 2026:

a. **Gaming tax funds.** The Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) has notified the School District that PDE will pay to the School District during the 2026-2027 school year pursuant to Act 1, 53 P.S. § 6926.505(b), as a property tax reduction allocation funded by gambling tax funds, the amount of \$1,779,760.37.

2. **Approved homesteads/farmsteads.** Pursuant to Act 50, 54 Pa. C.S. § 8584(i), and Act 1, 53 P.S. § 6926.341(g)(3), Allegheny County and Westmoreland County have provided the School District with a certified report listing approved homesteads and approved farmsteads. The number of approved homestead and approved farmsteads within the School District is 7,647.

3. **Real estate tax reduction calculation.** The Board of School Directors has decided that the homestead exclusion amount and the farmstead exclusion amount shall be equal. Dividing the above Gaming tax funds, paragraph 1(a), amount available during the 2026-2027 school year for real estate tax reduction of \$1,779,760.37 by the combined approved homesteads and farmsteads, above paragraph 2(c) aggregate number of 7,647, the maximum real estate tax reduction amount applicable to each approved homestead and approved farmstead is \$232.52.

4. **Homestead exclusion calculation.** Dividing the above paragraph 3 maximum real estate tax reduction amount of \$232.52 the School District real estate tax rate that is in effect as of July 1, 2026 shall equal the maximum real estate assessed value reduction to be reflected on the tax notices as a homestead exclusion for each approved homestead, and shall equal the maximum real estate assessed value reduction to be reflected as a farmstead exclusion for each approved farmstead.

5. **Homestead/farmstead exclusion authorization – July 1 tax bills.** The tax notice issued to the owner of each approved homestead within the School District shall reflect a homestead exclusion real estate assessed value reduction equal to the lesser of: (a) the Allegheny County or Westmoreland County established assessed value of the homestead, or (b) the above paragraph 4 maximum real estate assessed value reduction for approved homesteads. The tax notice issued to the owner of each approved farmstead within the School District shall reflect an additional farmstead exclusion real estate assessed value reduction equal to the lesser of: (a) the Allegheny County or Westmoreland County established assessed value of the farmstead, or (b) the above paragraph 4 maximum real estate assessed value reduction for approved farmsteads. For purposes of this Resolution,

“approved homestead” and “approved farmstead” shall mean homesteads and farmsteads listed in the report referred to in above paragraph 2 and received by the School District from the Allegheny County or Westmoreland County Office of Property Assessments on or before May 1 pursuant to Act 1, 53 P.S. § 6926.341 (g) (3), based on homestead/farmstead applications filed with the Allegheny County or Westmoreland County Office of Property Assessments on or before March 1. This paragraph 5 will apply to tax notices issued based on the initial tax duplicate used in issuing initial real estate tax notices for the 2026-2027 school year, which shall be issued on or promptly after July 1, and will not apply to interim tax notices.
