PK-5

- Build literacy (reading, writing, speaking, mathematical), media literacy, & critical thinking, & computational skills
- Learn ABOUT AI indirectly
- What AI is, how to spot when AI is used, AI is not human
- Avoid direct exposure to AI chatbots.

Grades 6-8

Engage with and manage age-appropriate AI tools with teacher oversight

- Decide *whether* to use AI or not based on the task.
- Manage simple tasks with AI tools
- Evaluate & critique AI outputs to ensure fairness and accuracy

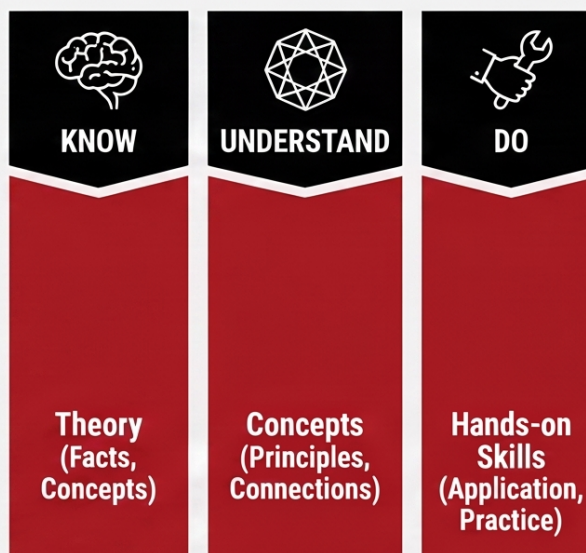
CTE curriculum is not just a syllabus; it is a professional roadmap designed to transform classroom learning into industry-ready mastery.

THE KUD FRAMEWORK

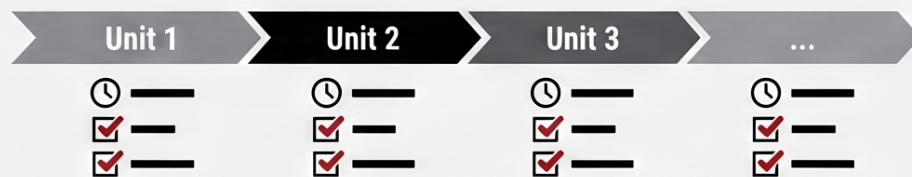


CLASSROOM TO CAREER ALIGNMENT
