School Police Officer Update



Policy Review

Policy Committee reviewed the proposed policy for school police officers. The policy outlines the boards direction and provide the administration the authority to implement the officers. This includes the level of authority the school police officer(s) has and the authority to carry a firearm while on duty.



Service Agreement

Cooperative Police Service Agreement between the district and local law enforcement authorities is currently in process.

Cooperative Police Service Agreement



Powers & Authority

Outlines specific powers, roles, and legal authority of police services under the agreement.



Geographical Boundaries

Defines the clear jurisdictions, physical limits, and active service areas.



Criminal Investigation

Establishes protocols and cooperative procedures for investigating criminal activity.



Reports & Records

Specifies guidelines for managing, filing, and sharing crime reports and database records.

Behavioral & Mental Health Crisis Management



Foundation & Support

One counselor assigned to support the district K-12 building a sustainable foundation for mental health counseling and crisis response.



Case Management

Counselor will manage high-profile cases and ensure seamless transitions across school levels.



Team Alignment

Conduct regular check-ins with Elementary and Secondary Social Work team to ensure alignment, assess ongoing student needs and provide ongoing support.



Crisis Response

Facilitate and support the school-based team's implementation of intervention management plan in response to substantive and imminent threats.

Restorative Practices Resource



Custom Courses

Provide students with custom built online courses to support a change in behavior.



Flexible Delivery

Students will complete the course(s) during detention or in-school suspension.



Assessment

All course(s) have a final test to measure comprehension and retention of the course material(s).



Core Subjects

Course subjects include but limited to: Vaping, Bullying & Title IX.
