Thank you for the opportunity to quote on the detail cleaning needs for **East Allegheny Elementary School**

Detail Cleaning:

First Priority Phase

-  Clean (6) foyer entrances (extract carpet, remove cobwebs and sweep corners in stairwell landings, wipe horizontal surface)
-  Machine scrub ceramic tile floor in all restrooms (pay close attention to cove base, corners and around fixtures?)
-  Sweep/mop and deck brush stairwell steps (concentrate on removing old salt stains and over spray of stripper/wax)
-  Remove the built-up wax that is at eye level to the right as you walk up the yellow stair case, the wax here has run down the wall and will need repainted, not to attempt to remove the wax from the wall, but chisel out that area only by the steel railing

Second Priority Phase

-  Detail clean metal cove base in front of each classroom and cafeteria by removing stripper/wax overspray
-  Detail clean under water fountains

We would like to provide this service on a T&M basis. We estimate that it would take approximately take 50-60 man-hours at the rate of \$65.00 per man to complete EACH phase

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PROFESSIONAL BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES
AGREEMENT

This Professional Services Agreement ("**Agreement**") is effective as of the August 1, 2026 ("**Effective Date**") by and between **East Allegheny School District** and **Chestnut Ridge Counseling Services, Inc.**, (CRCSI) a Pennsylvania not for profit community mental health provider located at
1321 Connellsville Rd
Lemont Furnace PA 15456
(collectively, the "**Parties**" and individually a "**Party**").

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, East Allegheny School District seeks to make available to its students' mental wellness comprehensive behavioral health services, including but not limited to: classroom assistance, crisis, outpatient treatment, student and staff education and support;

WHEREAS, CRCSI possess the experience, expertise and staff necessary to provide comprehensive mental wellness behavioral health services, and is willing and able to provide said services to East Allegheny School District;

WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter into this Agreement to form a partnership to provide a school-based student mental health initiative based on the services provided by CRCSI.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants set forth herein, and intending to be legally bound, the Parties hereby covenant and agree as follows:

1. **ENGAGEMENT**. East Allegheny School District hereby engages CRCSI, and CRCSI hereby accepts the engagement, to provide comprehensive school-based behavioral health services ("Services"). CRCSI will perform the Services in accordance with the policies and procedures of East Allegheny School District and CRCSI, all applicable laws, rules, regulations and directives of all applicable federal, state and other government and regulatory authorities and all licensing agencies, and pursuant to the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth.

2. **COMPENSATION**

1.1 For the term of this Agreement, East Allegheny School District will reimburse CRCSI one hundred per cent (100%) of all costs associated with and incurred in providing the Services rendered under this Agreement. The cost of providing Services will be determined per Schedule "A" attached hereto. An inflationary adjust of 7% will be instituted 12 months from the Effective Date. East Allegheny School District will be invoiced Monthly for services and all invoices will be due within 30 days from the invoice date.

3. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR

3.1 The role of CRCSI and its staff shall be that of independent contractors.

3.2 Any employee of CRCSI under this Agreement shall not be considered to be an employee of East Allegheny School District the performance of the Services and shall not be entitled to any East Allegheny School District compensation or benefits, statutory or otherwise, including, but not limited to, workers' compensation or unemployment compensation.

3.3 CRCSI further agrees that it is solely responsible for payment of taxes, if any, arising directly out of the fees paid to CRCSI under this Agreement and that are reported on Internal Revenue Code Form 1099 relating to the payment of such fees, including business privilege taxes relating thereto, to the proper taxing authorities.

4. CRCSI's DUTIES

4.1 CRCSI shall keep and maintain appropriate time, financial and/or other records relating to Services rendered by CRCSI under this Agreement in the manner reasonably specified by East Allegheny School District, consistent with East Allegheny School District policies, industry certification standards, and by law. CRCSI shall prepare and maintain, in connection with such Services, all necessary and appropriate reports, records and correspondence in connection with the Services performed, all of which documentation shall be the property of East Allegheny School District. All medical records of Services created under this Agreement will be maintained and owned by CRCSI. CRCSI will comply with all federal and state laws regarding the documenting, maintaining and confidentiality of medical records.

4.2 East Allegheny School District shall notify CRCSI and CRCSI shall notify East Allegheny School District within twenty-four (24) hours of any and all incidents, occurrences, claims or potential claims arising out of the provision of Services. CRCSI shall fully cooperate in any investigation of claims or incidents in connection with the provision of Services hereunder.

4.3 CRCSI shall provide Services in conformance with the standards of good behavioral health services within the community. CRCSI shall provide patient services that are medically necessary, properly documented, and consistent with any utilization review, case management, best practices, or similar guidelines.

4.4 Employees of CRCSI providing Services hereunder shall be and remain qualified to perform the Services required under this Agreement and CRCSI shall require employees at all times to maintain all appropriate licenses in good standing as required by Pennsylvania law. Employees of CRCSI shall obtain and maintain all clearances required by law and CRCSI shall provide proof of the same to East Allegheny School District prior to any CRCSI employee having any contact with students at East Allegheny School District.

4.5 CRCSI's supervisory team will be based on roles defined in Schedule A, and such persons shall meet with the East Allegheny School District's team to ensure that service levels and coordination of Services in the various East Allegheny School District is meeting expectations. These meetings will occur quarterly or more often as needed.

4.6 If, and to the extent that, Section 1861(v)(1)(k) of the Social Security Act is applicable to this Agreement, CRCSI agrees that for a period of four (4) years following the furnishing of Services under this Agreement, CRCSI shall maintain and make available, upon

written request, to the Secretary of the United States Department of Health and Human Services or Comptroller General of the United States, or to any of their duly authorized representatives, this Agreement and any books, documents and records of CRCSI which are necessary to verify the nature and extent of the cost of the Services provided hereunder.

4.7 CRCSI represents that neither CRCSI nor its employees are currently subject to, or threatened with, any investigation, censure, probation, suspension, or other adverse action with respect to CRCSI's respective applicable state licenses or with respect to those employees providing services hereunder, respective medical staff privileges at any hospital, nursing home or other institution, if any. CRCSI represents that all employees are legally authorized to work in the United States, to be employed by CRCSI and to perform the Services contemplated hereunder.

4.8 CRCSI shall, during the term of this Agreement, maintain an occurrence based professional liability insurance policy for providing Services hereunder with coverage limits of \$1mm/\$3mm and other terms as required to meet Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Laws and to comply with applicable policies of East Allegheny School District. Upon request CRCSI will provide East Allegheny School District proof of said insurance before commencing any services at East Allegheny School District school.

5 TERM AND TERMINATION.

1.1 This Agreement shall take effect on August 1, 2026, the Effective Date and shall continue in effect for a period of two years ("**Term**"), unless this Agreement is earlier terminated in accordance with the terms hereof. Thereafter, the term of this Agreement shall automatically renew for successive one (1) year terms unless either party provides the other party with at least thirty (30) days' advance written notice of non-renewal prior to the end of the then-current term. Upon termination, this Agreement shall be of no further force or effect and each of the Parties shall be relieved and discharged therefrom, except as otherwise provided herein.

1.2 This Agreement may be terminated by either Party without cause at any time by providing the other party with at least ninety (90) days' advance written notice of the Party's desire to terminate the Agreement

MISCELLANEOUS

1.3 Notices and all other communications provided for in this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be hand-delivered, sent by first-class mail, or by federal express, or other nationally recognized overnight courier to the following addresses:

1.4 This Agreement shall be interpreted and enforced in and pursuant to the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

1.5 *Confidentiality.* All information relating to East Allegheny School District's employees, students and operations, specifically including information created by or revealed to CRCSI during the provision of Services shall be considered confidential information of East Allegheny School District ("Confidential Information"). No Confidential Information shall be removed from East Allegheny School District's premises or from East Allegheny School District's custody and control without the express written authorization of East Allegheny School District. CRCSI shall not, during the term of this Agreement, or thereafter, disclose to any third-party or use for any purposes adverse to the interests of East Allegheny School District any Confidential Information without the prior written authorization of East Allegheny School District, unless required by law to so disclose.

1.6 Neither Party may assign any of its rights or delegate any of its duties under this Agreement without the prior written consent of the other Party. Any unauthorized attempted assignment or delegation shall be null and void and of no force or effect.

1.7 No waiver of any term, provision or condition of this Agreement, whether by conduct or otherwise, in any one or more instances, shall be deemed to be or construed as a further and continuing waiver of any such term, provision or condition or as a waiver of any other term, provision, or condition of this Agreement. No amendment to any provision of this Agreement shall be effective unless in writing and signed by the Parties.

1.8 If any provision of this Agreement shall for any reason be held violative of any applicable law and be held to be unenforceable, then the invalidity of such provision shall not be held to invalidate any other provision of this Agreement which shall remain in full force and effect.

1.9 The Parties agree that, in the performance of this Agreement, the Services will be provided without discrimination toward any patients, employees, or other persons regardless of their race, religion, creed, color, age, sex, sexual orientation, marital status, physical or mental handicap, veteran's status, or ethnic background.

1.10 CRCSI shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless East Allegheny School District and its Board of Trustee member(s), officer(s), director(s), employee(s) and agent(s) ("**Indemnitees**") and each of them, from and against any and all loss, damages, liabilities, claims, suits, demands, costs and expenses, including, without limitation, reasonable

attorney's fees, in connection with or arising or relating in any way to CRCSI' negligent or willful breach of this Agreement or gross negligence or willful misconduct in the performance of any obligation under this Agreement. This provision shall survive termination of this Agreement. Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed to limit the indemnity or contribution rights that East Allegheny School District may have under law.

1.11 East Allegheny School District shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless CRCSI and its Board member(s), officer(s), director(s), employee(s) and agent(s) ("Indemnitees") and each of them, from and against any and all loss, damages, liabilities, claims, suits, demands, costs and expenses, including, without limitation, reasonable attorney's fees, in connection with or arising or relating in any way to CRCSI negligent or willful breach of this Agreement or gross negligence or willful misconduct in the performance of any obligation under this Agreement. This provision shall survive termination of this Agreement. Nothing in this Agreement shall be constructed to limit the indemnity or contribution rights that RASD may have under law.

1.12 This Agreement, Schedule, and Exhibit attached hereto and made a part hereof, contain the entire agreement and understanding between the Parties concerning the subject matter hereof, and supersede all prior verbal and written communication between the Parties concerning the subject matter hereof. This Agreement may be amended, revised or clarified only in writing signed prospectively by authorized representatives of both Parties.

Exhibit A

School Mental Health Support Specialist Guide

Chestnut Ridge Counseling Services, INC offers licensed school social work professionals who can provide school social work services, including fee for service/IEP social work services. Our school Mental Health Support Specialists will be eligible to obtain their Level 1/Level 2 PDE school Mental Health Support Specialist certification.

Some typical functions Chestnut Ridge Counseling Services, INC School Mental Health Support Specialists provide:

SERVICES TO DISTRICTS:

- Provide social work IEP services that can be billed for qualifying Medicaid services
- Develop and implement educational programs for exceptional children.
- Develop programs for students with attendance concerns
- Identify and report child abuse and neglect.
- Provide case management for students/ families who require multiple resources.

SERVICES TO STUDENTS:

- Provide crisis intervention.
- Develop intervention strategies to increase academic success.
- Assist with conflict resolution and anger management.
- Help the child develop appropriate social interaction skills.
- Assist the child in understanding and accepting self and others.

RELATED SERVICES:

- Participate in special education assessment meetings as well as individual Educational Planning Meetings
- Work with those problems in a child's living situation that affect the child's adjustment in school. (home, school, and community)
- Prepare a social or developmental history on a child with a disability.
- Lead therapeutic support sessions (group, individual and/or family)

SERVICES TO PARENT/FAMILIES:

- Work with parents to facilitate their children's school adjustment.
- Link parents with programs available to students with special needs, as well as school and community resources.

SERVICES TO SCHOOL PERSONNEL:

- Assess students with mental health concerns.
- Develop staff in-service training programs.
- Assist teachers with behavior management.

SCHOOL-COMMUNITY LIAISON:

- Obtain and coordinate community resources to meet students' needs.
- Advocate for new and improved community/school service to meet the needs of students and families.
- Help the system respond effectively to each child's needs.
