Statement of Finding

The failure to control noxious weeds on lands in this state is a serious problem which is detrimental to the production of crops and livestock and to the welfare of residents of this state and which may devalue land and reduces tax revenue (Neb. Rev. Stat. 2-945.02(1)).

Section 2-954 of the Nebraska Noxious Weed Control Act requires each weed control authority to establish a coordinated program for the control of noxious weeds within the county.

Goals

1. Continue the fight against Phrag.

Phragmites continues to spread and the fight will go on. More little infestations were located this past year so the time spent trying to control it is growing. As with most patches of Phragmites, when you do control measures the infestation just moves a little and a new patch forms. With at least one landowner on board to help with the control measures getting the message out will be the objective. Since word of mouth is the best source of information I need to get that one landowner to tell all his friends what Phragmites has done to his property already. I might try to come up with some kind of incentive to get landowners to be more active in their control efforts. Either doing some kind of cost share like the WMA or providing time or chemical on a one time basis might be an option. Just getting landowners to get started is half the battle. Once some progress is made I think it will be easier to get other landowners on board.

2. Better coordination on control measures

One area that I am going to try and get better at is the coordination of when somebody sprays or has somebody spray for them. For whatever reason whenever I tell somebody to spray an infestation I get "the COOP is going to do it or somebody else is going to do the spraying". Then when the follow up inspection is done and nothing happened I get finger pointing. I know it is the land owners responsibility but when they hire someone I take their word for it. Many times I check with the people doing the spraying and I am told "yea we didn't get to it or we were told it wasn't a big deal". Then by the time everything gets straightened out it is too late to do the control measure. This year I am telling landowners that they need to call me when they are going to do the spraying or if they hire it out they need to inform me so I can talk to whomever is doing the spraying and impress on them the importance of the control measure that needs to be done. Hopefully doing it this way this year I don't hear that everybody else was going to do the spraying and it actually gets done.

3. No more “Just enough”

This goal I hoped wouldn't have to be a goal but it is. Too many times in the past I get a landowner to do control measures and when I go back for a follow up inspection, minor effort was done. Then when I look into forcing more control efforts I am told “an effort was made” The landowners that do this know that is all they have to do to get off the hook. One way to achieve this is to get them to do their control sooner rather than at the last minute. Staying on these landowners, especially the chronic problem ones, hopefully will produce better results. Making the landowner do “minimal” effort over and over again might get them to actually just do a better job the first time. Once they see some progress maybe landowners will actually work to get things done before the county weed control has to step in and force things to happen. I think some of the chronic landowners really want to control their weeds they just don't know where to start. Helping them get started is half the problem. The county weed authority just has to be careful deciding what is not knowing where to start and not wanting to work to control anything and using excuses..

These goals can be met by being diligent about how we go about controlling the problems that we face. Getting the landowners on board to help out and educate them with what to do and look for will make it easier on the weed control authority. Getting the landowners to take the time to do the mechanical/spraying work will go a lot farther in controlling these weed problems. The county weed control authority might have to prioritize some of the problem areas in order to get ahead of the game so to speak.

General

In this section, list how your county achieved last season's goals and were they successful? Explain.

The goals were for the most part met last year. Even though Phragmites spread to more acres from the year before, the reason was more sites were found and not because of previous infestations spreading. I was able to communicate with multiple landowners that have some Phragmites on their property. Now these people at least know about Phragmites and what they can do to fight the infestations. One landowner came to me to report that he has an infestation on his land and some land where he farms. He asked for help because he wanted to start fighting the Phrag. I did a costs share and supplied chemical for the individual because he was spraying multiple sites. Further inspections showed the infestations were sprayed and the landowner is following the progress because he doesn't want the weeds to spread. Making teasel a county added noxious weed has provided results already. The number of sites of teasel increased between making teasel noxious and this year but I was able to spray all the sites on county right of ways this year. Also, the landowner that has the most teasel and is the root of the infestations refuse to do anything so I went to the FSA just to ask if the land was in CRP. It is and they must have notified him because a week or so later the teasel was either mowed or sprayed. Since almost all of the sericea in Saline County is located at a NRD lake my job has been to monitor the infestation. The NRD has almost completely gotten rid of the sericea. Just a few plants here and there are left. Every year there is less and less sericea.

2. List the procedure that the control authority has adopted for the weed superintendent to follow when notifying landowners of uncontrolled noxious weed infestations.

Twice a year a General Notice is published in the local papers. In the spring and again in the fall. This will give plenty of notice to the landowners what is expected of them in Saline County.

After a noxious weed infestation is found or reported, an inspection is done on the infestation. A letter along with the inspection report and any other information the county feels is needed is then sent to the landowner. The letter states they have 10 days to comply. On the 11th day another inspection is done to check for compliance. If not then forced control will begin with the cost going to the landowner. If the bill is not paid a lien will be placed on the property until the bill is paid.

3. List the guidelines or policy that the control authority has established for the weed superintendent to follow when **issuing and enforcing an individual notice**. (Include information regarding inspections, evidence, officials to be notified, etc.)

An inspection is the first thing to happen. The findings and all other evidence will be taken and filed. A letter and a copy of the inspection along with other useful information will be mailed to the landowner stipulating that they have 10 days to comply. On the 11th day another inspection will be done to check for compliance. If it is not done, then immediately a force control is done until it meets the Nebraska State Noxious Weed Law. All papers and work done will be filed in the weed control office. A bill for fees, chemicals, equipment and services will be sent to the landowner. If the bill is not paid, the control authority shall immediately cause a notice to be filed. If the bill is not paid, the control authority shall immediately cause a notice to be filed of possible unpaid weed control assessments against the property upon which the control measures were used in the register of deeds office. If unpaid for two months, the control authority shall certify to the county treasurer the amount of such expense and such expenses shall become a lien on the property which the control measures were taken as a special assessment levied on the date of control, The county treasurer shall add such expense to and it shall become and form a part of the taxes upon such land and shall bear interest at the same rate of taxes.

Public Awareness

Explain the type of public relations activities that your county will use in the upcoming year to increase public awareness (newspaper articles, interviews, presentations given, weed tours, landowner contacts, etc.). **Do not include the required general notice in this section.**

Contacting landowners with infestations directly this year should alleviate the “did not think about it” excuse. This way they have no excuse for “not seeing anything about it”. A new Extension agent is starting in the county this year and we have talked about sending more information on the extension mass e-mail list. More articles are planned on the County’s web site since most people in the county now follow what is going on in the county via the web site. A few more newspaper articles are planned in order to reach the masses of people that will see it and become educated a little more. 5 Rivers Weed Management is again involved with a cost share program to help landowners or renters to control certain troublesome weeds.

This year a special e-mail version of a newsletter might be tried since more and more people are using computers as their primary source of information. The 5 Rivers weed management area has printed some weed ID pamphlets to hand out that will help landowners identify weeds.

Cooperative Efforts

Does your county actively support and participate in a weed management cooperative group?

Saline County is a member of 5 Rivers Weed Management Area, this area consist of ten counties in Southeast Nebraska. This group has obtained grants and had test plots and put on public awareness meetings to educate the public on Noxious and troublesome weeds. The main weed we focused on last year was Sericea Lespedeza with Phragmites and Caucasian Bluestem, and Teasel the main weeds this year. This past year Five Rivers obtained a grant and hired a helicopter to search the river systems in the area. The Five Rivers WMA is the driving force behind the cost share program the county is involved in. The WMA continues to sponsor a cost share program with landowners to help cover the cost of controlling some troublesome weeds in Southeast Nebraska.

How does being part of a weed management cooperative group benefit your county?

Being in a cooperative group helps tremendously because you are able to utilize more resources than if you do it by yourself. Recently the WMA hired a helicopter to fly the river systems. Saline County by itself would not be able to afford or justify paying the cost by itself. Pooling together with other counties makes this activity possible. There are more ideas to bounce around and you are able to get more feedback from other members. The financial burden decreases because the group is able to obtain grants for the work that is to be done. It is also good public relations to join with our neighboring counties to work together. Saline County would not have been able to receive the grant to run the cost share program on its own. Being a member of the WMA has gained Saline County access to more funds to help people control weeds.

49716. Has your county's noxious weed infestations increased or decreased in the past year?
 ___increased___ Explain.

Saline County's noxious weed infestations have increased in the past year. Though that is a little deceiving because the increase is a result of a new weed being declared noxious when teasel was made a county added noxious weed. The historically noxious weeds have decreased as a whole last year. Some weeds saw a decrease in infestations and severity while some other weeds saw an increase in the number of infestations. Nothing was out of control but new little spots popped up. Hopefully, none of the new infestations will become a problem but they will need monitoring. The past infestations have decreased this year. Our counties main weed problems have shifted from musk thistle to leafy spurge. Even though we will always have a thistle problem leafy spurge is lesser now and harder to control. Phragmites is established in the county now and more locations have been found. The resilience of this weed makes it a hard fight to gain control. So more work will be required to stay on top of it. Teasel has been added as a county wide noxious weed and the number of infestations has grown substantially. Hopefully the numbers will go down once control efforts can be made. A better cooperation with the public and more trust from the public towards the weed department is the general reason for the decrease. Another year on the bad infestations better mapping of old infestations has also helped.

Some of the newly added noxious weeds that go unnoticed for a while and then explode causes some concern for the future levels but hopefully with the help of new chemicals and an informed public we can keep the levels down. With new weeds probably being added to the list during the year, the level might change. But hopefully we can get on top of things before the infestations get out of control.

The Saline County Board serves as the Weed Board. The Board supports the weed Superintendent in weed control issues and generally does not interfere or hinder any efforts in weed control. The Board also is supporting in making sure the weed department has the proper equipment needed to do the job. This support enhances the control efforts the superintendent has in dealing with public issues. The Board is also very helpful if questions come up from the superintendent. This comfort makes the job of the superintendent a lot easier.
