1. Comments From the Public

The Ponca City Public School Board of Education recognizes the value of school governance of public comment on educational issues and the importance of involving members of the public in board meetings. The board has established guidelines to govern public participation in board meetings necessary to conduct its meetings and to maintain order. After checking in with the board clerk, individuals or groups wishing to speak during the public comment period must provide the following information, in writing, in order to speak before the board:

- Name and address of the individual
- The agenda action item(s) the individual wishes to address
- The organization the individual represents or is affiliated with, if applicable

Anyone who would like to speak to the board during the public comment period of the meeting must check in with the board clerk at least 15 minutes prior to the start

of the board meeting. There will be a form available they will need to fill out and return to the board clerk before they can be heard by the board.

Participants must be recognized by the president or other presiding officer and must preface their comments with an announcement of their name and group affiliation, if applicable. Comments by the speaker must relate to an item on the meeting agenda. Generally, participants shall be limited to comments of a maximum of three (3) minute duration unless altered by the presiding officer, with the approval of the board. All public comments during any one regular meeting shall be limited to no more than fifteen (15) minutes. No participant may speak more than once during a single meeting. All statements shall be directed to the presiding officer; no participant may address or question board members individually.

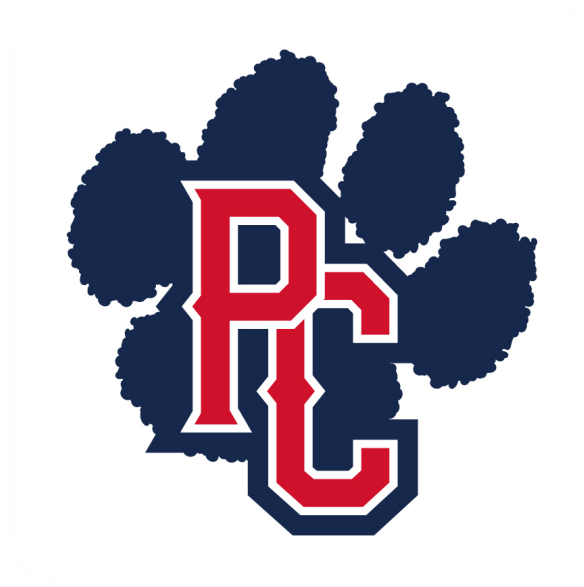

Legislative Update



Still Watching

- ▶ SB 652 - Adjusts all elections to 5 per year, (Nov BOE elections are effectively dead, SB 6)
- ▶ HB 1727 - Expands OHLAP for teachers' children
- ▶ HB 2288 - Removes educator retire and rehire restrictions (possibly dead)

Sent to the Governor:

- ▶ SB 364 - Prohibits corporal punishment on any student with a disability
- ▶ HB 2047 - Requires schools to contact emergency services and a child's parents as soon as possible after epinephrine is administered
- ▶ HB 1393 - Requires BOE to adopt separate consent forms for districts to use to obtain parent consent that a student with an IDEA disability will participate in OAAP and receive instruction based on alternate standards

Sent to the Governor

- ▶ SB 139 - Bell-to-bell cell phone ban on school grounds (one year mandatory). Every Board of Education (BOE) must adopt a policy prohibiting students from using electronic devices while on campus.
- ▶ SB 758 - Prohibits school districts from counting virtual days to fulfill classroom instruction time. Beginning in 26-27
- ▶ HB 1485 - Allows teachers with emergency or provisional certificates to be employed for more than four semesters
- ▶ The cell phone bill will pose a great challenge for staff

District Update

- ▶ Graduating 305 high school students
- ▶ New this year - seating will be on a first-come, first-served basis
- ▶ We will have plenty of capacity for all, including ADA seating on the track
- ▶ Little to no chance of rain!

District Update

- ▶ Data Reviews
- ▶ Staffing this summer - I predict one of the smallest recruitment of new employees in a decade
- ▶ Big law changes coming - Graduation requirements, cell phones
- ▶ STEM camps, Driver's Education, ESY, professional development

PreK Update

- ▶ Boxes have arrived for teachers
- ▶ Moving will occur in June
- ▶ Already nearly 100 parents enrolled for PreK next year! We may have to be ready to hire an additional teacher!
- ▶ Keeping kids until normal dismissal next year
- ▶ Investigating transportation

PreK Update

- ▶ CDC - Letter of Intent
 - ▶ 20% discount for PCPS employees for monthly childcare (must be at minimum 50% of time and not qualify for any subsidy)
 - ▶ CDC will cover maintenance and operation costs for the facility
 - ▶ 36 month termination clause
 - ▶ Must have approval from PCPS before any significant changes to the building
 - ▶ Must operate at a minimum from 7 am 4:30 pm, with a program available in the first year for parents needing care until 5:15 pm
- ▶ Next step - draft a contract
- ▶ The goal would be August for CDC to take over the facility - it's not imperative
