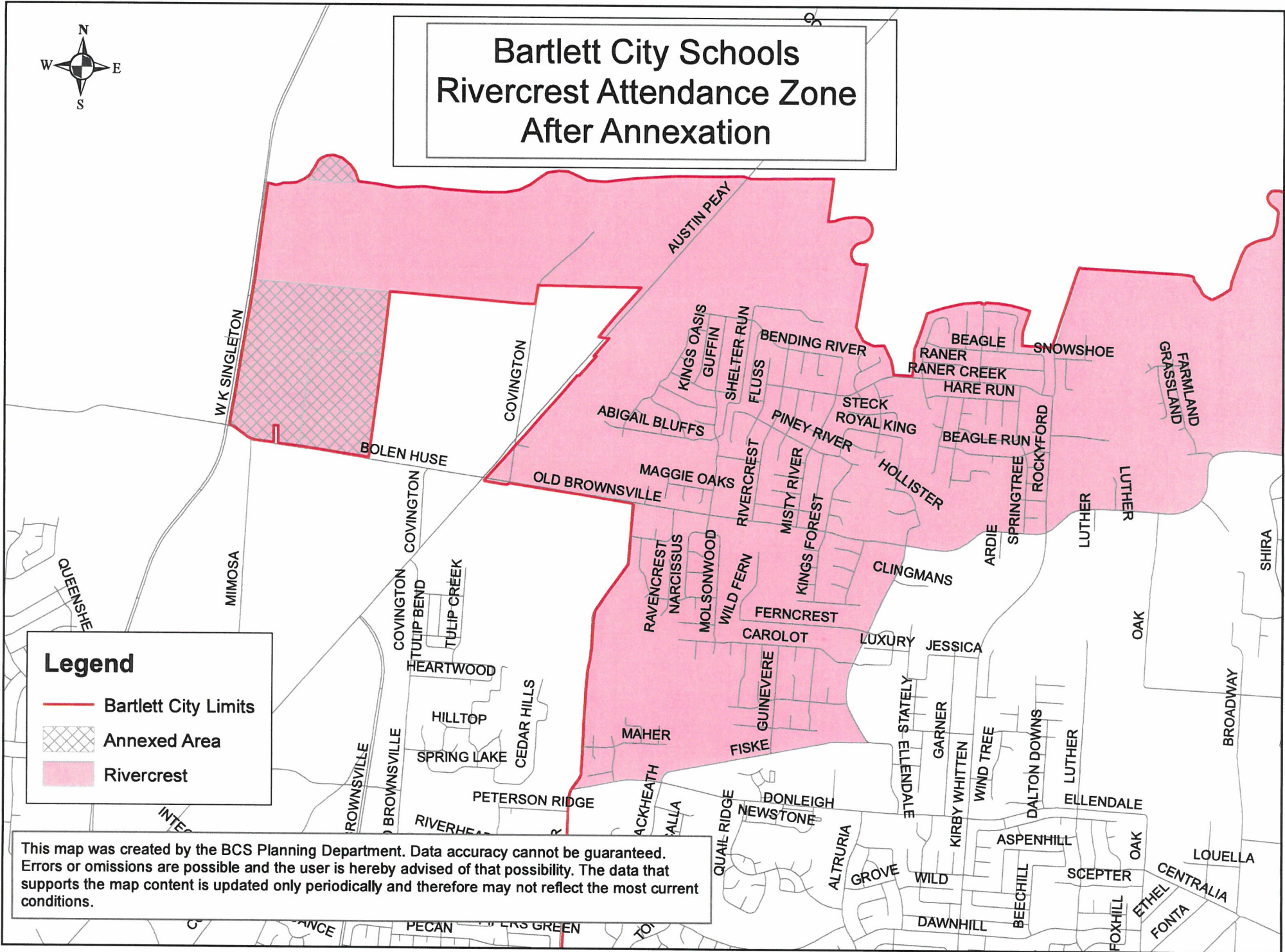

(K - 5)

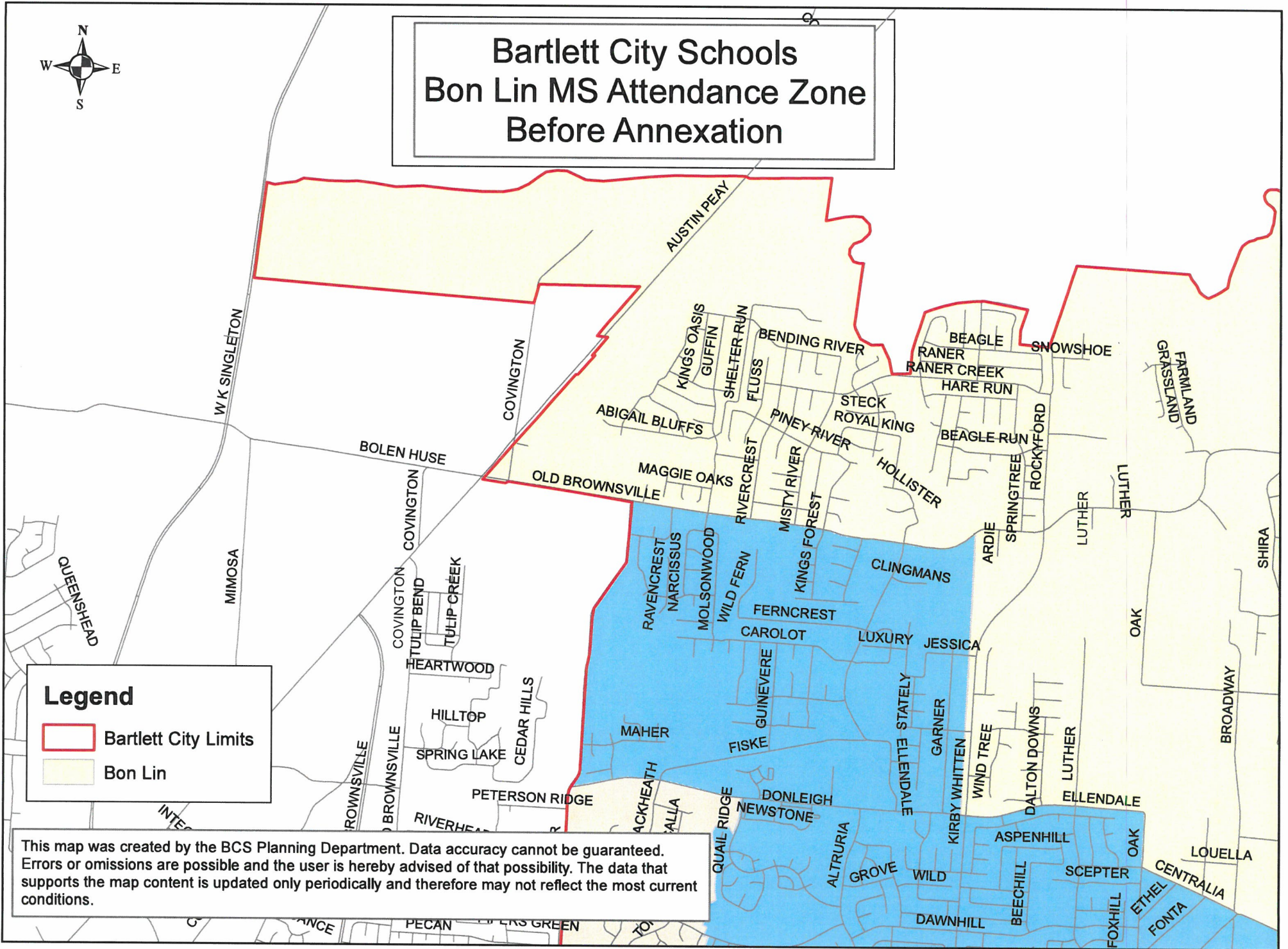
Beginning at the intersection of Austin Peay Highway and Old Brownsville Road; east on Old Brownsville Road (north side included) to Billy Maher Road; south on Billy Maher (east side included) to Fiske Road; east on Fiske Road (north side included) to Ellendale Road; north on Ellendale Road (west side included) to Old Brownsville Road; east on Old Brownsville Road (north side included) to the L&N Rail line; northeast along the L&N Rail line to the Bartlett city limits; north along the Bartlett city limits to a point due west; continue west along the Bartlett city limits to Singleton Parkway; south on Singleton Parkway (east side included) to Bolen Huse Road; east on Bolen Huse Road (north side included) to Bartlett city limits; north along Bartlett city limits (west side included), then east along Bartlett city limits towards Austin Peay Highway; south on Austin Peay Highway (east side included) to the intersection of Austin Peay Highway and Old Brownsville Road, the point of beginning.

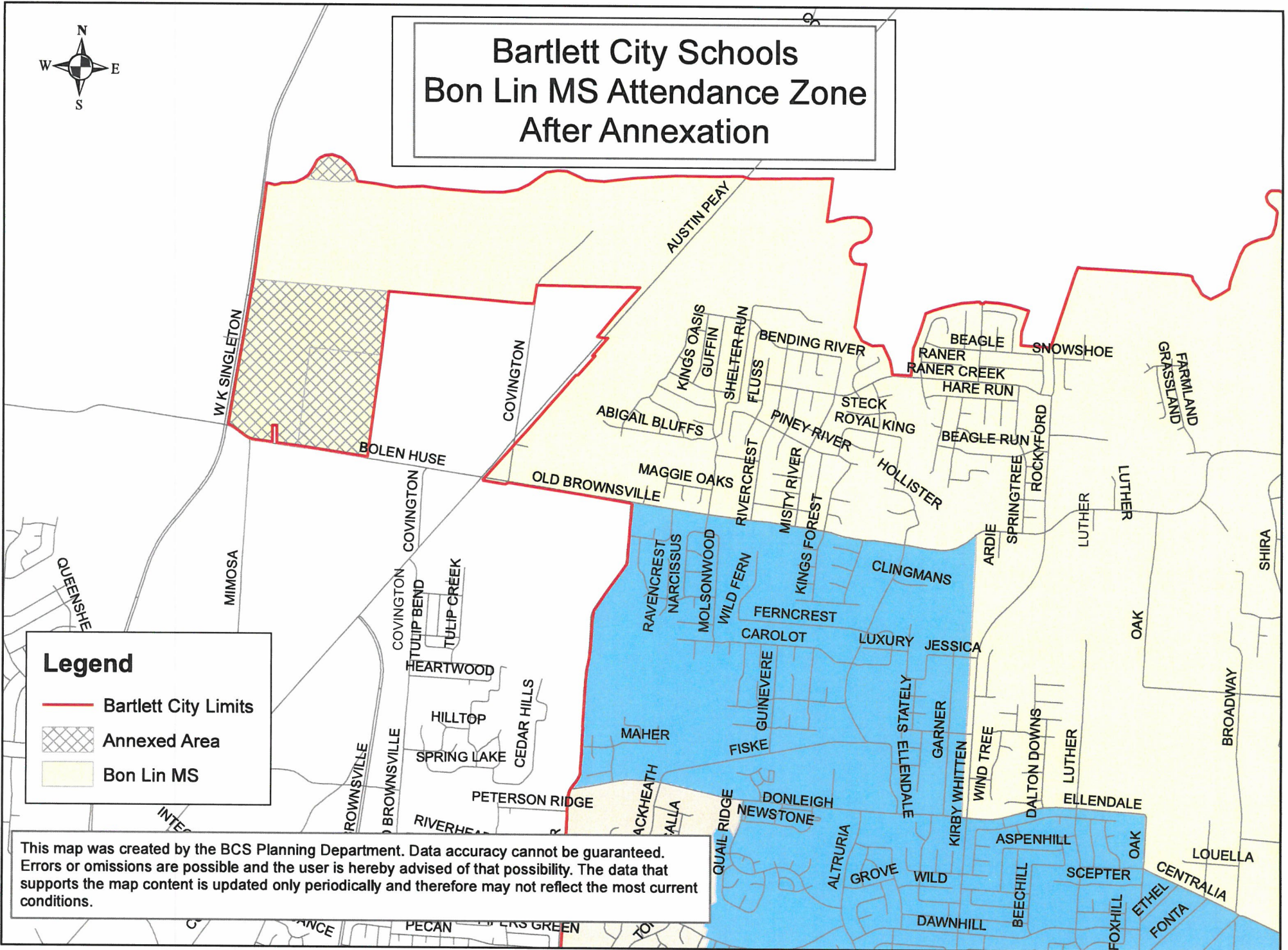


Bartlett City Schools Bon Lin MS Attendance Zone Before Annexation

Summer Avenue); east on U. S. Highway 70 (north side included) to N. Germantown Parkway; south on N. Germantown Parkway (east side included) to the point of beginning.
