Band Practice Field Tower

Director of Business, Jason Ray presented that the band practice field has a pressure-treated wood director's tower that has served its purpose for close to or possibly in excess of 20 years. The structure has been worked on and repaired as needed by the band boosters and band directors. The current structure's stairway is accessible at all times.

The band and band boosters would like to replace the current structure with a metal tower. The new tower would be a long-term upgrade. Specifications include two steel-supported observation decks, a metal roof, welded design, and an enclosed stairway entry with a locking gate.

Bids were accepted with Melhart Music, located in McAllen, TX providing a bid in the amount of \$45,770.00. If approved, this would be a joint project between TCS and the THS band boosters. The band boosters would contribute \$20,000.00 to this project, leaving the balance of \$25,770.00 to be district-funded.

Funding Model Resolution

Dr. Stephens shared that Governor Lee instituted a review of current school funding (BEP) with the intention of moving to a student-based funding model. Many stakeholders have been involved in providing feedback over the last several months. Eighteen subcommittees engaged in weekly discussions based on the expectations of the state-level steering committee. Dr. Stephens stated that she does remain hopeful that the proposed school funding formula, TN Investment in Student Achievement (TISA), will improve the amount of funds the state provides to ensure our students' needs are met and we can provide an excellent education meeting the needs of the whole child pre - 12. QUALIFICATIONS:

- High school diploma or equivalent with post-secondary courses in office practices, bookkeeping, computer operations, and office machines preferred. Must be able to type and operate a personal computer.
- Three to four years of secretarial/bookkeeping experience preferred.

JOB GOAL: The Bookkeeper/Athletic Secretary will perform duties under general supervision requiring the ability to utilize initiative and good judgment in the scheduling of work, ensuring the accuracy of work, and assisting staff with inquiries related to athletics. The Bookkeeper/Athletic Secretary will perform various bookkeeping and secretarial duties for the athletic department to ensure consistent procedures and reports are completed as athletic funds are assigned.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS or DUTIES:

- Interacts with a variety of persons and situations requiring a high degree of courtesy and tact.
- Devotes considerable attention to detail and accuracy.
- Manages the volume of work and meets deadlines pertaining to athletic schedules, events, transportation, and purchases.
- Assumes responsibility in the completion of duties.
- Displays a cooperative demeanor when working with teachers, students, and administration.
- Maintains confidentiality of information associated with the position.
- Performs bookkeeping tasks for the athletic department by typing purchase orders; receipting all monies received; preparing bank deposits, maintaining a journal of revenues and disbursements; writing checks; and preparing monthly balance sheet, cash balance, year-to-date income, and disbursements for Board meeting; maintains separate accounts for each club or organization, and for each type of fund, restricted or general.
- Purchases approved materials by typing purchase orders, receiving appropriate approval for orders, mailing orders, and receiving and distributing materials.
- Performs bookkeeping activities for funds by setting up books for each fund, posting transactions, and carrying a current cash balance; informs appropriate



staff of fund balance, and prepares an outstanding purchase order report monthly.

- Works within the allocation of money earned through fundraisers to be disbursed to appropriate accounts.
- Assists the athletic director by selling reserved seat tickets; mailing rosters, tickets, and schedules for out-of-town games.
- Assists the athletic director in posting and updating athletic schedules.
- Prepares and reconciles the cash box for home athletic events.
- Prints, completes, and pays officials for athletic events.
- Coordinates with the transportation department when scheduling bus transportation for athletes.
- Schedules gate workers for home athletic events and maintain records of workers.
- Maintains athletic department accounts by setting up books each year, posting transactions, and maintaining a cash-on-hand balance report.
- Enrolls students into voluntary student insurance program by receiving completed enrollment forms and premium payment, receipting money, and mailing it to the insurance carrier.

JOB GOAL:

Coordinate the athletics programs and related activities, provide information and serve as a resource to others; achieve defined objectives by planning, evaluating, developing, implementing, and maintaining athletic programs in compliance with established guidelines; serve as an administrator at games; engage with parents of athletes, and serve as a liaison for the District and its athletic programs.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS or DUTIES:
