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## Agreement for Cooperative Sponsorship

This Agreement is made between/among the School Boards of:

The parties agree as follows:

- Joint Application.** The above-named governing boards shall jointly make an application to the Nebraska School Activities Association (NSAA) Board of Directors before July 1, 2025 for fall activities; October 1, 2025 for winter activities; and January 1, 2026 for spring activities for approval for cooperative sponsorship of a joint high school program.

2. **Term.** This agreement shall be in effect for the following school years:

- 2024-2025
- 2025-2026
- 2026-2027
- 2027-2028

3. **Agreement to Cooperate.** If the joint application is approved by the NSAA Board of Directors, the above-named governing boards agree that they will cooperatively sponsor the combined program in the school years specified, provided that nothing in this provision shall be deemed to require that the governing boards offer that combined program at all in any particular year.

4. **Terms and Conditions of Cooperative Sponsorship.** Any combined program shall be cooperatively sponsored upon the following terms and conditions:

**Contracts.** Except as otherwise provided herein, contracts related to the cooperatively sponsored team with groups such as referee associations, with individuals, or with other schools or school districts, shall be made by the governing board of **Platteview** after consultation with the governing board of the cooperating school district. ***In the event this co-op qualifies for reimbursement for any state championships, the check should be written to the head school.***

5. **Interdistrict Advisory Board.** An Interdistrict Advisory Board may be formed from members of the schools to work on the improvement of the various co-sponsored programs.

6. **Resolution of Disputes.** Any disputes related to this Agreement, or items in this Agreement requiring clarification, will be investigated by the school superintendents from each school, and they will present their findings and recommendations to their respective boards.

7. **Term, Dissolution.** The term of this Agreement shall be for school years **2025-2026** through **2026-2027**. The Agreement shall terminate at the end of the last school year specified, unless extended by mutual agreement. If the parties determine to extend the Agreement beyond the period specified, they agree to submit a *Cooperative Program Renewal Agreement* form to the NSAA Board of Directors prior to July 1 for fall activities; October 1 for winter activities; and January 1 for spring activities, preceding the school year or

season in which the co-op program is to be implemented. If the parties determine to dissolve the Agreement at an earlier date, they agree to submit a request in writing from both schools signed by the Superintendent and Board Chairperson prior to July 1 for fall activities; October 1 for winter activities; and January 1 for spring activities. If the early dissolution of the Agreement is not approved, the combined program must be offered cooperatively, or not at all, during the remaining terms of the Agreement.

8. **Liability Insurance.** Nothing contained in this Agreement shall relieve any party to this Agreement from liability for its negligence or that of its officers, agents, and employees. Each party shall carry a minimum liability insurance limit in the amount of \$  for any one liability occurrence and carry a minimum aggregate liability insurance limit of \$  for any accumulation of liability occurrences that may occur during the insured policy period. The policy shall name the officers, agents, and employees of the other party as named insured. Each party shall provide the other party with a certificate evidencing such insurance coverage.

**Updated Proposal Feb 2, 2026**

**Established parameters for the boys' soccer cooperative agreement between Platteview High School and Plattsmouth High School**

**Host school** - Platteview (This will be re-evaluated for each two-year cycle.)

**Uniforms and Team Name-** Uniforms, colors, and team name do not change. The financial cost of uniforms would be split 50/50.

**Length of agreement** - Per NSAA bylaws, cooperative agreements are two years in length with participating schools being allowed to agree to dissolve cooperative agreement at any point provided both parties agree.

**Terms of agreement** -

1. Platteview would provide a head coach and an assistant coach; Plattsmouth would provide two assistant coaches. All four coaches would work as a team, being involved with both levels and all having input during the tryout process.
2. Practice locations and home contest sites would be determined based on the percentage of participants that each school brings to the cooperative program (# of participants that report for the first day of required practice each year). For example if each school has 15 students report, 50% of the practices and home competitions would be held at each site. Each school would have their own designated, senior day.
3. The coaching staff will prioritize a culture of character, leadership, and sportsmanship. Parents from both schools will be expected to model these behaviors/attributes.
4. Each school will complete the checkout process for students interested in participating in boys' soccer and will notify the coaching staff of who is eligible to participate.
5. Each school will also supply a list of those students who are academically eligible to represent their school in the cooperative program.
6. Students will follow the athletic code of conduct for their respective school.
7. The coaching staff will work together to develop a program handbook with clear expectations for the tryout process, and expectations for both students and parents.
8. Whoever is the host school for a contest(s) would pay for the officials throughout the season.
9. Any entry fees to attend a tournament would be split 50/50.
10. Plattsmouth would keep all entry fees when hosting their tournament.
11. Each school would provide transportation for 50% of the away events.
12. Each school will assure that their home practice and competition site is in good, safe condition.
13. Each school will provide all supplies and equipment necessary to hold practices and/or competitions when hosting at their school (i.e. balls, goals, cones, practice jerseys, etc.).
14. No other financial terms will be required of either school.
