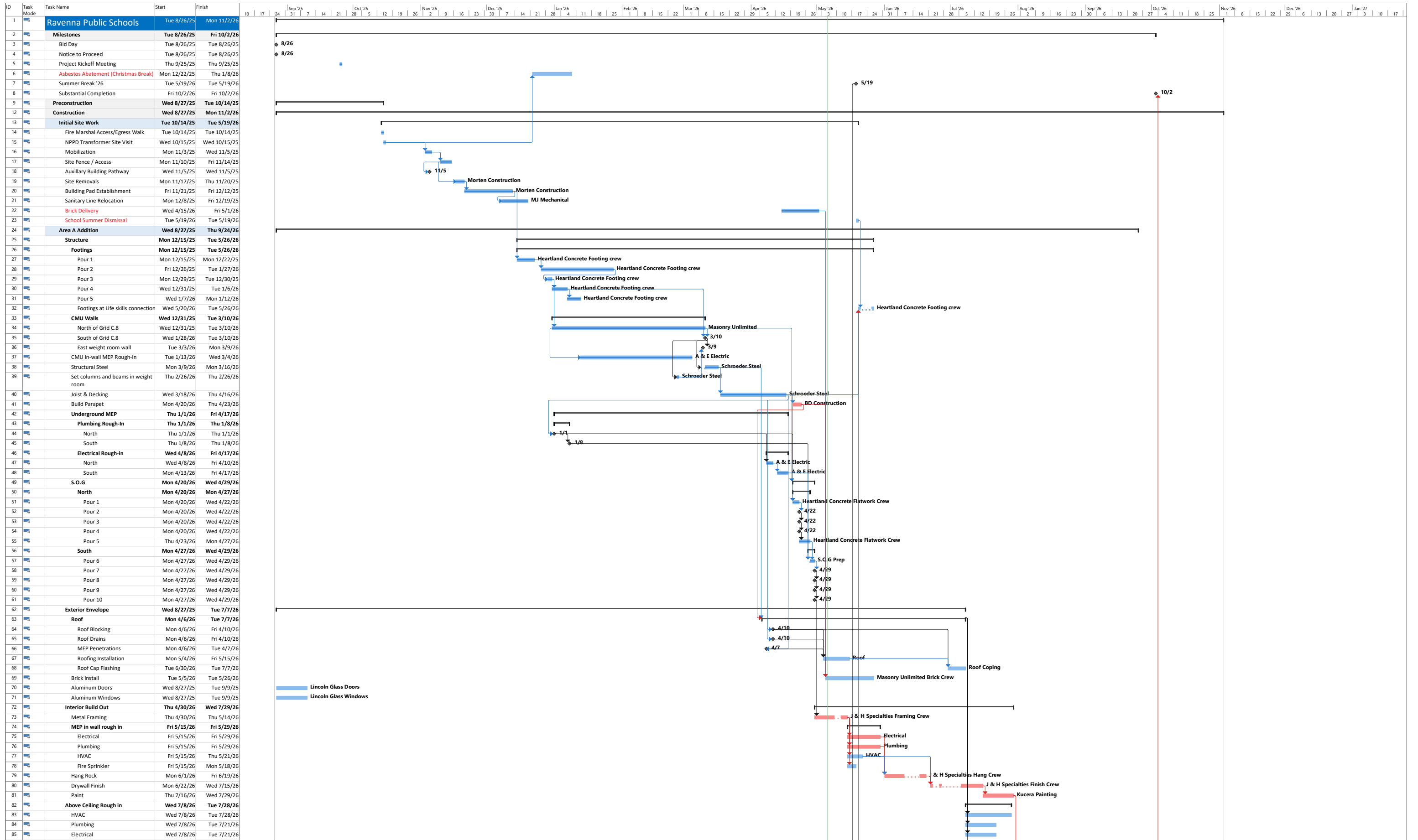

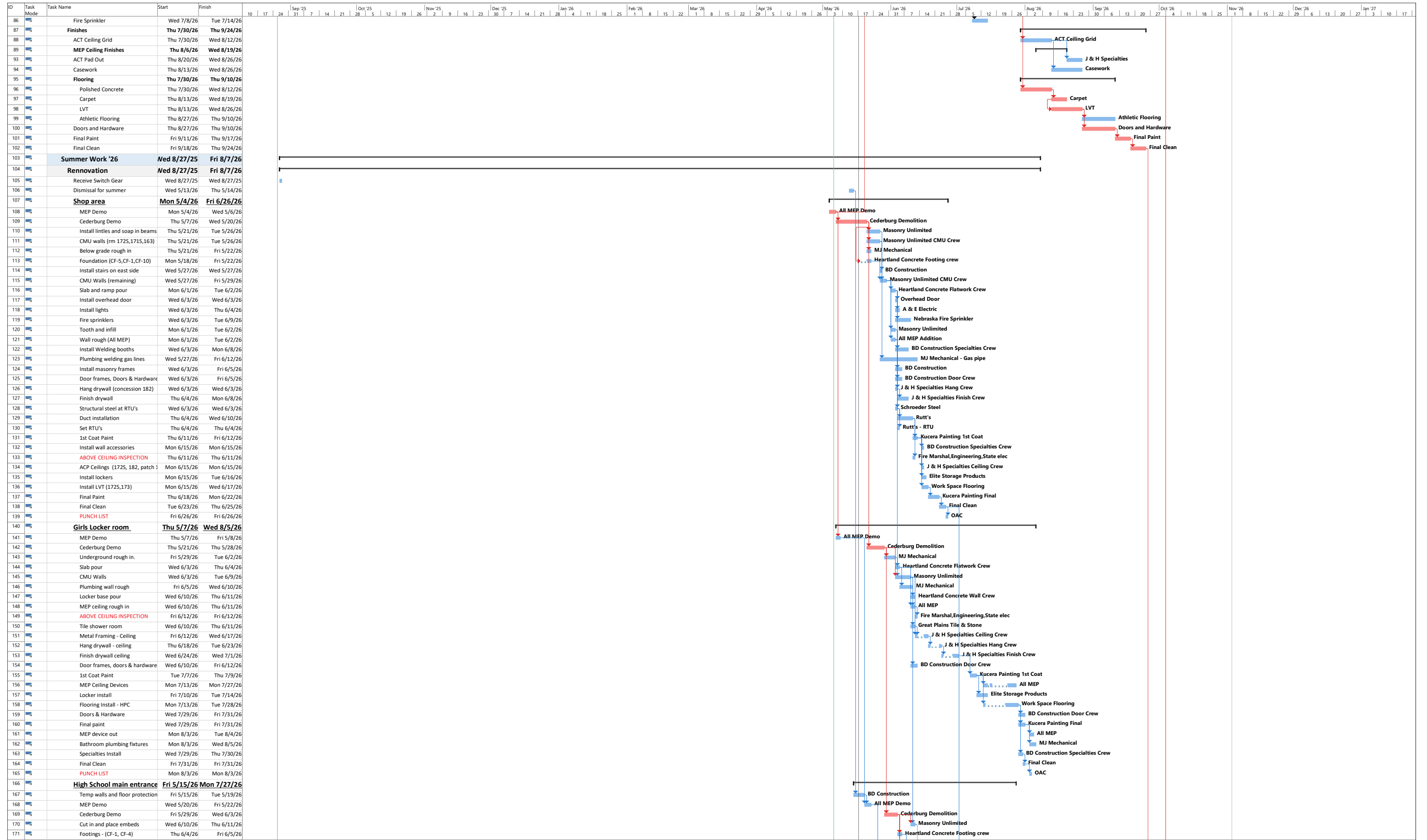
Tom Spaulding is doing a great job with the grounds. The grounds look fantastic and continue to improve! Keep up the great work! -Mike Voelker
