MINUTE ORDER:

"In accordance with the attached Order, the Alamo Community College District (ACCD) Board of Trustees canvasses the unofficial election results, provided by the Bexar County Elections Administration, of the June 13, 2026 Runoff Election for Trustee Position for Single-Member District Nine (9); declares the returns and election results official; and approves any other actions necessary to canvass the election results."

PURPOSE:

To canvass the results of the June 13, 2026 General Election for Trustee Position for Single-Member District Nine (9) in accordance with the attached Order and declare the unofficial election results official, as required by the Texas Election Code.

BACKGROUND:

On May 12, 2026, the Board called a Runoff Election to elect a Trustee for Single-Member District Nine (9), since no candidate received a majority of votes cast in the May 2, 2026 General Election for the ACCD Trustee position. The candidates with the two highest number of votes became the candidates for the Runoff Election. The Texas Election Code Sections 67.001-67.004 require the Board as the governing body to canvass the unofficial final election results of a Runoff Election and declare the results of the Election official.

**ORDER CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE
RESULTS OF THE ACCD TRUSTEE RUNOFF ELECTION
HELD ON JUNE 13, 2026
AND OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH**

WHEREAS, on January 20, 2026, the Board of Trustees (the “Board”) of Alamo Community College District (“ACCD”) called a General Election to be held on May 2, 2026 for the purpose of electing trustees to serve six-year terms for single-member Districts Four (4), Eight (8), and Nine (9); and

WHEREAS, upon the expiration of the deadline on February 13, 2026 at 5 p.m. for filing an application for a place on the ballot and February 17, 2026 at 5 pm for filing a declaration of write-in candidacy, Lorena “Lorraine” Pulido was the sole candidate for the Trustee position for District Four (4), and Clint Kingsbery was the sole candidate for the Trustee position for District Eight (8); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 2.052, Texas Election Code, Roxella Cavazos, ACCD Associate General Counsel and the person responsible for preparing the ACCD ballot, certified in writing to the Board that Lorena “Lorraine” Pulido and Clint Kingsbery were unopposed for election to the offices of Trustee for single-member Districts Four (4), and Eight (8) respectively; and

WHEREAS, on March 24, 2026, as authorized by the Texas Election Code, Chapter 2, Subchapter C, the Board accepted the certification that Lorena “Lorraine” Pulido and Clint Kingsbery were unopposed for election to the offices of Trustee for single-member Districts Four (4), and Eight (8), respectively; declared Lorena “Lorraine” Pulido and Clint Kingsbery elected to Trustee positions for Districts Four (4) and Eight (8), respectively, commencing after the May 2, 2026 election; and cancelled the elections for Trustees for single-member Districts Four (4) and Eight (8); and

WHEREAS, on May 2, 2026, a uniform election day, the General Election for Trustee position for single-member District Nine (9) was conducted for ACCD by Bexar County Elections Administration, jointly with other local non-county political subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2026, as required by the Texas Education Code, the Board canvassed the election results received from Bexar County Elections Administration; and

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2026, the Board determined that none of the four candidates for Trustee for single-member District Nine (9) received a majority of the votes cast in the May 2, 2026 General Election, and therefore called a Runoff Election for June 13, 2026 between Robert Garcia and Carolyn DeLecour, the candidates who received the highest number of votes cast in the May 2, 2026 General Election; and

WHEREAS, the Board has received from Bexar County Elections Administration the unofficial runoff election results for ACCD Trustee for single-member District Nine (9) and is prepared to canvass the election results as required by the Texas Election Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ACCORDINGLY FOUND, DECLARED AND ORDERED BY THE ALAMO COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT THAT:

Section 1. Conduct of Election; Returns. The Board officially finds, determines, and declares that the ACCD Runoff Election for Trustee for single-member District Nine (9) was duly and properly conducted, that proper legal notice of such Election was duly given in the English language and the Spanish language (to the extent required by law), that proper election officers were duly appointed prior to the Runoff Election, that the ACCD Runoff Election for Trustee for single-member District Nine (9) was duly and legally held on June 13, 2026, that all resident, qualified voters of ACCD single-member District Nine (9) were permitted to vote at the Runoff Election, that due returns of the results of the ACCD Runoff Election were made and delivered by Bexar County Elections Administration.

Section 2. Returns; Canvass. The Board hereby CANVASSES the returns of the ACCD Runoff Election for Trustee for single-member District Nine (9), consisting of votes cast by resident, qualified voters of ACCD single-member District Nine (9) for the following candidates:

Carolyn DeLecour

From the returns, the Board hereby finds that the following votes were cast in the June 13, 2026 ACCD Runoff Election by voters who were resident, qualified voters of ACCD single-member District Nine (9), as indicated by the ACCD unofficial election results provided and signed by Michele Carew, Bexar County Elections Administrator, and attached as Exhibit “A” and Exhibit “B” to this Order. Based on the signature certification provided by Ms. Carew, the Board declares the election results as follows:

The Board has duly canvassed such returns, all in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and of the United States of America, the results provided by the Bexar County Elections Administration Department, and the May 12, 2026 Order Calling the Runoff Election. The Board hereby DECLARES the unofficial election results, attached as Exhibit A hereto, as OFFICIAL based on the certification provided by Michele Carew, Bexar County Elections Administrator.

Section 3. Election Results for Single-Member District 9. The Board finds and certifies that Robert Garcia received a MAJORITY of the votes from resident, qualified voters of ACCD single-member District 9, as required to be elected to office as Trustee for ACCD Single-Member District Nine (9).

Section 4. Oath of Office. Robert Garcia may be sworn in to serve new a six-year term as Trustee for ACCD Single-Member District Nine (9). The required Certificate of Election is issued.

Section 5. Notice of Meeting. The Board officially finds, determines, recites and declares that written notice of the date, hour, place and subject of the meeting at which this Order is adopted was posted for the public on a bulletin board located at a place convenient to the public at the ACCD's administrative offices and posted on the Internet on the ACCD website for at least three business days preceding the scheduled time of the meeting; that special notice of the meeting was given by telephone, facsimile transmission or electronic mail to any news media that requested special notice and agreed to reimburse ACCD for the cost of providing the special notice as required by Section 551.056 of the Texas Government Code, as amended; and that such meeting was open to the public as required by law at all times during which this Order and the subject matter thereof was discussed, considered and formally acted upon.

Section 6. Preamble Incorporation. The recitals contained in the preamble hereof are hereby found to be true, and such recitals are hereby made a part of this Order for all purposes and are adopted as a part of the judgment and findings of the Board.

Section 7. Inconsistent Provisions. All orders and resolutions, or parts thereof, which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Order are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Order shall be and remain controlling as to the matters ordered herein.

Section 8. Governing Law. This Order shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the United States of America.

Section 9. Severability. If any provision of this Order or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be held to be invalid, the remainder of this Order and the application of such provision to other persons and circumstances shall nevertheless be valid, and the Board hereby declares that this Order would have been enacted without such invalid provision.

Section 10. Authorization to Execute. The Chair or Vice Chair of the Board is authorized to execute and the Secretary of the Board is authorized to attest this Order on behalf of the Board; and the Chair and Vice Chair of the Board are authorized to do all other things legal and necessary in connection with the holding and consummation of the Trustee Election. The Board declares that the canvassing of the Trustee election results is completed.

Section 11. Effective Date. This Order is effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
