Knapp Forest Elementary is intentionally focused on fostering a strong sense of belonging for every student, using both daily practices and school-wide systems to build connection and community. Through strategies such as personalized greetings, morning meetings, and recognition programs, they work to ensure students are consistently seen, valued, and engaged. The survey data has helped identify what is working well, such as relationship-building routines and inclusive classroom practices, while also guiding next steps, including developing PRIDE Pack connections across grade levels, Early Bird Recess choices, and expanding opportunities for student voice and connections. At Knapp Forest Elementary, they believe a strong sense of belonging in school fosters students' confidence, engagement, and willingness to take academic risks, all of which contribute directly to improved learning and achievement.




