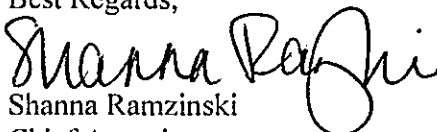
Enclosed you will find your ballot and the number of votes that your taxing unit is entitled to in this election. The upcoming term of office is from January 1, 2026 to December 31, 2027.

Each taxing unit must cast its vote **by written resolution** and submit it to the chief appraiser before December 15, 2025. The unit may cast all its votes for one candidate or may distribute the votes among any number of candidates. The amount of votes is based on your levy. They can change from year to year. The five candidates receiving the most votes will be declared the winners.

A voting unit must cast its votes for a person nominated and named on the ballot. Votes cast for someone not listed on the ballot cannot be counted.

The ballot should be dated and signed by the presiding officer of the taxing unit and returned along with a copy of the resolution to the Chief Appraiser, Caldwell County Appraisal District, P. O. Box 900, Lockhart, Texas 78644, before December 15, 2025.
