SUBJECT: Approval of Canvass of Results for the Mission CISD School Board of Trustees Election, May 7, 2022

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The canvass is the official tally of votes for any given election. The purpose of the canvass is to account for every ballot cast and ensure that every valid vote cast is included in the election totals. The canvass accounts for every ballot cast on Election Day, every on-time absentee ballot, every accepted provisional ballot, and every on-time overseas and military absentee ballot.

The Texas Secretary of State May 7, 2022 Election Law Calendar states that the local canvass for the May 7, 2022 General Election must be held not earlier than the third day after election day, Tuesday, May 10, 2022 and not later than the eleventh day after election day Wednesday, May 18, 2022.

Pursuant to Texas Election Code Section 67.004 the Local Canvassing Authority, Mission CISD will canvass the results for the May 7, 2022 Board of Trustees General Election.
