Board Policy Updates

Proposed Adjustments for the 2026-2027 Academic Year





POLICY SERIES	KEY OBJECTIVES	PROPOSED UPDATES / STATUS
FNCD Bullying	Strengthen bullying definitions, reporting processes, and protective measures.	Adds student/staff annual training; principal identified as site Bullying Coordinator; website link updated.
CPACA Cell Phones	Revise employee personal telecommunication limits during class/instruction hours.	Removes general work-hour phone restriction; maintains safety rules for driving district vehicles.
CO District Wellness	Integrate Triennial Assessment developments, nutrition education, and recess guidelines.	Raises elementary recess (40m); adds treats exception; names Director of Child Nutrition as leader.
COB-R Procurement	Formalize state contract guidelines and purchasing standard practices.	Lists specific food service procurement categories.
CFBB-Sanctioning of Parent Organizations and Booster Clubs	Better financial insight into sanctioned organizations.	Changes the financial reporting requirement from yearly to quarterly.



Bullying (FNCD)

- Clarifies that isolated negative acts do not meet the legal threshold for bullying but remain subject to standard student discipline.
- Building principal is named Site Bullying Incident Coordinator.
- Introduces strict disciplinary consequences for retaliation against reporters or witnesses.
- Establishes firm disciplinary actions for knowingly false reporting; record is cleared.





Wireless Devices (CPACA)

- **Staff Rules:** Strikes obsolete sections prohibiting employees from using cell phones during school/employment hours.
- **Driving Rules:** Keeps strict prohibitions on texting or device operation while operating school passenger buses and transport.
- **Exceptions:** Employees must move school vehicles off the roadway before responding to emergencies.
- **Stipends:** Mobile stipend terms remain active for select staff





District Wellness (CO)

- **Elementary Recess:** Formally doubles mandatory daily recess from 20 minutes to at least 40 minutes.
- **Instruction:** Expands nutrition instruction through partnerships with county extensions, tribes, and nursing programs.
- **Treats Exception:** Acknowledges birthday celebrations/parties may feature standard treats; encourages healthier alternatives.
- **Leadership:** Formally designates Lisa Nametska (Child Nutrition Director) as policy leader.



Procurement (COB-R)

- **Bread & Milk:** Restructures formal procurement tables to include specific local purchasing categories (milk, bread, chemicals).
- **Renewal Checks:** Outlines procedural contract lengths, re-bids, and performance oversight.
