- Introductions - The committee introduced themselves.
- Matt Clark announced that he is stepping down from SHAC
 - Matt Clark nominated Larry Dominguez to be the new vice chair
- The committee approved the nomination of Larry Dominguez as new vice chair.

- Ms. McKinley reviewed the SHAC Bylaws and Responsibilities

- Ms. McClendon reported on Trauma informed care, which is the situational awareness of how some students come to school having experienced trauma and explained ways in which to respond to students in crisis.

- Mr. Dominguez reviewed the District Threat Assessment Teams process and how it uses student data to drive the level of intervention given to the student.

- Mr. Dominguez also spoke about ongoing ways in which the district is increasing awareness of educator wellness.

- Mr. Dominguez stated that he would explore parent involvement with educator wellness including (e.g. supplies, etc.) and there was a discussion that the PTAs typically help but that participation has been low.

- Ms. McKinley asked why the MS was the only campus without microwaves for student use in the cafeteria. Mr. Dominguez explained that the new logistics of the cafeteria to facilitate social distancing prevented them from being utilized at the beginning of the year. However, after feedback from students, staff began working on a way to place the microwaves in socially distanced locations and should be set up by Friday, 9/25/2020.

 - Physical Education is provided for elementary students on a weekly basis
 - Physical Education is offered to middle school students during a term or semester
 - Physical Education credit is required for graduation
 - Nutrition education is embedded in curricula and offered as specific courses at the secondary level
- Ms. McKinley asked about the window of time that secondary students may get breakfast in the morning and about students who may miss that window.
 - Ms. Reese said that the window is from 8:00-8:30
 - Ms. Reese explained that staff would be picking up breakfasts and taking them to students who are not able to make it to the cafeteria before their first class to ensure they have an opportunity to eat.

- Mr. Dominguez gave a brief update on the district Behavioral Threat Assessment Team.
 - The Behavioral Threat Assessment Team is now called Safe and Supportive School program (SSSP) Team.
 - The change is due to the comprehensive approach to school safety, in which threat assessments are a single component.
 - The district reported Threat Assessment data from the 2019-2020 school year to TEA in November.
 - Mr. Dominguez reviewed the data with the committee.
 - Mr. Dominguez also reviewed data from the 2020-2021 school year.

- Items Reviewed:
 - Current cases of the flu are low
 - Reviewed the Denton County health website, on which districts report COVID cases
 - No evidence of high transmission rate at school
 - Letters go out to stakeholders in the event of a reported positive case
 - Mitigating measures reviewed
 - Social distancing
 - Face coverings required
 - Sanitation stations
