




## FACILITIES UPDATE

August 19, 2021

- Reroof at DBHS is progressing. Contractor has received all necessary hardware for the job.
- Gray brick repair is complete.
- Bleacher installation at all sites is complete. Installer is coming back to replace a spring at Gray and adjust bleachers at DCHS.
- Lamar awnings are partially complete.
- Portable buildings have been moved off site.
- Ionization contract is signed and units have been ordered. These are expected to arrive next week. Norwell is ready to begin work as soon as they arrive. Due to the shortage of supply of the FC-24 units all units have been upgraded to FC-48 at no additional charge. This will essentially double the output of ionization.
- Lighting study has been completed by Excel Energy Group. Application has been made to EESI.
- Practice football field at DCHS is in process.
- Rogers Wildlife has completed work at Lamar school.
- Damaged flooring at South Central gym has been removed and drying is complete. We are seeking pricing for repairs.
- A computer board for the chiller at DCHS is scheduled to arrive this week. A temporary chiller is up and running.
- Repainting of ROTC building at DCHS is complete.
- Demolition of the walls at the former BCMS is complete. The contractor is now hauling away the debris and will then begin to remove basement walls and footings.
