Walled Lake Consolidated School District solicited bids and received a bid for the procurement

and installation inclusive of, but not limited to, electrical, site preparation, and all necessary permits for a walk-in freezer/cooler to replace the existing one at Central High School. The recommendation is for the Board to approve the District to enter into a contract with Gold Star Products for the procurement and installation of a walk-in freezer/cooler at Central High School for an amount not to exceed \$179,110.00 from Food Service funds.

b. AV Purchase, District-Wide, \$238,294.72 - 2024 Bond Funds

The Project Team has reviewed the bids received for the District-Wide AV purchase. The scope of this project includes the installation of rolling carts and interactive display panels. The Project Team recommends to enter into a Standard Form of Agreement between Owner and Contractor per the award summary. The total award recommendation for this project is \$238,294.72 from 2024 Bond Funds.

c. Security Cameras, Western HS Phase 3 and Northern HS, \$372,176.00 - 2024 Bond Funds

The Project Team has reviewed the bids received for Western High School Phase 3 and Northern High School security cameras. The scope of this project includes providing both interior and exterior security cameras at both locations. The Project Team recommends to enter into a Standard Form of Agreement between Owner and Contractor per the award summary. The total award recommendation for this project is \$372,176.00 from 2024 Bond Funds.
