FALL SPORTS REVIEW

It was a rewarding season for the 361 student-athletes that participated in a fall sport at HHS! Highlights include:

- HHS hosted 122 different home games on 40 different dates.
- Average team GPA of 3.55 and multi-sport athlete rate of 53%.
- Girls swim & dive was undefeated, MEC champions; their 7th consecutive MEC title & fourth consecutive undefeated. They advanced swimmers to the finals in all 12 events in Section 3AA: four individuals & 3 relays made it to state. Ava McNamara broke 2 school records & was 2nd at state in the 100 fly.
- Girls' tennis earned the #2 seed out of 16 teams in the section playoffs and hosted a quarterfinal round at home.
- Football earned the #2 seed in Section 3AAAAA, winning a home semifinal playoff game and finishing section runner-up.
- Dana Strain was voted Suburban Maroon District Football Coach of the Year.
- Bella Meier finished her HHS career as the girls soccer all-time leading scorer in school history.
- Ty Bushinski was named Academic All State in Cross Country.
- Five student-athletes earned a collegiate athletic scholarship and signed a National Letter of Intent on November 10; Kendal Jenkins (softb), Bella Meier (socc), Lilly Nuytten (bkbll), Jackson Schaffer (baseb), Maggie Schlottman (bkbll)
- Each HHS fall sport had a "partner" program they supported directly. In a cool, new tradition players and coaches from one sport attended the other sport as a large group. Football/soccer, cross country/girls swim, volleyball/girls tennis each showed up for each other to cheer, rally, and support their cross-sport peers.

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



613 Graduation Requirements

I. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to set forth requirements for graduation from the school district.

II. General Statement of Policy

It is the policy of the school district that all students must pass the Minnesota Graduation Basic Standards tests or the Minnesota Comprehensive Assessments Second Edition (MCA-II's,) per state requirements or higher guidelines, and must satisfactorily complete all course requirements as established by the school district and the State of Minnesota in order to graduate.

The school district also recognizes that there are some students who have met the graduation requirements as defined in their IEP or Section 504 accommodation plan.

- A. "Course credit" is equivalent to a student's successful completion of one semester of study or a student's mastery of the applicable subject matter, as determined by the school district. (Two semester credits equals one academic year.)

III. Test Administrator

The Curriculum Director shall be named the school district test administrator. Said person shall be in charge of all test procedures and shall bring recommendations to the school board annually for approval.

IV. Graduation Requirements

- A. All students must satisfactorily complete, as determined by the school district and the State of Minnesota either the basic skills requirements for students enrolled in grade 8 before the 2005-2006 school year or the MCA-II's for students enrolled in grade 8 in the 2005-2006 school year.
- B. Students beginning ninth grade in the 2004-2005 school year and later must successfully complete high school level course credits for graduation as follows:

Students beginning the ninth grade prior in the 2004-2005 school year and beyond must have forty-four (44) high school level course credits for graduation as follows:

1. Eight (8) credits of language arts; English

2. Six (6) credits of mathematics, encompassing at least algebra, geometry, statistics and probability.
3. Six (6) credits of science, including at least two (2) credits in biology;
4. Eight (8) credits of social studies, encompassing at least United States history, geography, government and citizenship, world history, and economics.
5. ~~Four (4)~~ Three and a half (3.5) credits of physical education and health.
6. Two (2) credits in the arts; and
7. A minimum of ten (10) elective course credits.

V. Early Graduation

Students may be considered for early graduation, as provided for within Minn. Stat. § 120B.07.

- A. All course of standards and credit requirements must be met;
- B. The principal or designee shall conduct an interview with the student and parent or guardian, familiarize the parties with opportunities available in post-secondary education, and arrive at a timely decision; and
- C. The principal's decision shall be in writing and may be subject to review by the superintendent and school board.

VI. Notice

The school district will notify students and their parents of the school district's graduation requirements within 30 working days of a student's entry into ninth grade.

Student Travel/Field Trip Resource Document

Action as of February 2021: Suspend all out-of-state domestic travel/field trips through August 2021, and all international travel/field trips through August 2022. All domestic travel/field trips beginning September 1, 2021, must include a COVID Mitigation plan. Domestic and International travel trips will be revisited as a board discussion topic at the August 2021 business meeting.

Action taken in February 2021:

"A motion to suspend all out-of-state domestic student travel/field trips through August of 2021 and international travel/field trips through August of 2022. All domestic travel/field trip plans beginning September 1, 2021, must include a COVID mitigation plan.
