## September 14, 2022 Work Session: Policy Review Cycle Agenda

### 1. 2023-2025 review cycle

### 2. Understanding Policy Committee:

- a. Governance (Board of Directors) vs Management (Superintendent and District Administration)
- b. Board (as a whole) provides the strategic plan and vision for the district, identifies policy needs, and appoints a committee of board members and administration to develop policies.
- c. The board members on the committee take the goals, mission, vision, and objectives of the district and the board and work with administration to review, revise, and develop policies.
- d. Management implements policies into day-to-day operations.
- e. We are a board of progress, not perfection.
- f. Some questions the board and committee should ask when considering policy:
  - i. Does the policy support our strategic plan?
  - ii. Is the policy legal?
  - iii. Does the policy support other policies and procedures? Are there any conflicts with this policy and other policies and procedures?
  - iv. Does the policy support our students, staff, and community?
  - v. Does implementing the policy create any unnecessary burdens on students or staff?
  - vi. For new policies: does this policy need a sub-committee or focus group? If so, who are those key members?

### 3. Review/Revision/Adoption Definitions: we can add these dates at the bottom of our policies to provide clarification and add the definitions into policy 208, if recommended by the entire board.

**Committee Review** - the dates the policy committee has reviewed a policy.

**Board Review approval** - the date that the policy has been reviewed and the final review approval by the board (after third reading).

**Policy Revision Approval** - this is meant to indicate any time that a policy has been revised for legal changes (like we had this year) but hasn't been thoroughly reviewed.

**Yearly review** - a date would be entered here every year for only the yearly review policies.

**Review Cycle year** - would indicate the year that a particular policy is up for review. I don't think that a specific date should be added here as this could change but the year wouldn't.

**Adopted Date** - this is located at the bottom of the last page of the policy and will not be changed so that it is on record forever when a policy was actually adopted for the first time.
