The subjects to be discussed or considered or upon which any formal action may be taken are listed below. Items do not have to be taken in the same order as shown on this meeting notice. Unless removed from the consent agenda, items identified within the consent agenda will be acted on at one time.

The staff of Bloomington Independent School District believes that all students can learn. We believe that our District's purpose is to educate all students to high levels of academic performance, while fostering positive growth in social/emotional behaviors and attitudes. We accept the responsibility to teach all students and help them achieve their full potential as productive members of society.

1. District will work to increase parent involvement using several different strategies three to four times per year.
2. Each Teacher will receive 12 hours of professional development training before Winter Break.
3. Each Board Member will work to attend every board meeting and special called meeting.
4. The entire Board and Superintendent will attend at least two trainings or team building events during the 2018-2019 school year.
5. BISD will show an average of 95% or better in attendance for 2018-2019 end of school year.
6. BISD will show an improvement of 5 percentage points on state accountability test in areas of Math, Writing, and Reading for the district with a focus on our students being more successful on college entrance exams.
