**Background Information:**

The School Financial Integrity Rating System of Texas (FIRST) is the State's financial accountability rating system for public school systems. Texas school districts are required to conduct a public hearing on the 2024 School FIRST report. The hearing must be conducted within two months of receiving the official FIRST Rating from the TEA. The information is based on audited 2023-2024 financial data.

Georgetown ISD has accomplished a Superior Achievement rating for 2025. The School FIRST annual financial management report will be presented during a public hearing. In accordance with the requirements of Title 19 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 109.1001(q), public notice of the hearing was published on October 1, 2025. The financial management report will be available upon request and will be posted on the district's website.

### Financial Integrity Rating System of Texas

- ❖ **FIRST** is an accountability rating system developed by TEA in 1999 that holds school districts accountable for the quality of their financial management practices and actual improved performance.
- ❖ Ratings based on 21 indicators established by the Commissioner of Education.



## Types of Ratings

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- ❖ **A for Superior Achievement** is the highest possible score and recognizes the districts with the highest financial integrity.
- ❖ **B for Above Standard Achievement** indicates that the district has performed significantly above the minimum passing score.
- ❖ **C for Meets Standard Achievement** is the minimum passing score and indicates that the district meets the minimum passing standard for financial integrity.
- ❖ **F for Substandard Achievement** indicates the school district did not pass FIRST for the applicable rating year

Consideration and Action to Approve Construction Bond Funds for In-Building Cellular Enhancement

**Background Information:**

The reliability of cellular communication has become a concern, particularly if there is an emergency. The ability for staff and first responders to communicate seamlessly within our buildings should be a safety standard. Furthermore, some students rely on a cellular data connection for health-related devices and applications, making consistent coverage essential for their well-being. This project directly addresses these critical safety and health needs.

We are seeking approval to proceed with a critical project to address the growing need for enhanced in-building cellular (cell carriers such as AT&T, Verizon, etc..) coverage across our new and recently-renovated school facilities. We seek the Board's approval to utilize some remaining construction funds from the San Gabriel Elementary, Frost Elementary, Benold Middle School, and Future Ready Center/Early Learning Center

projects to implement these necessary upgrades in those buildings.

We have selected Mobile Communications America (MCA), a leading solution provider for distributed antenna systems (DAS), to perform the work. Their expertise will ensure a robust and reliable system is installed. Our aim is to begin work in the final weeks of October with a target completion date of January 1, 2026.

The total cost for this project is \$967,558\* and it is allocated as follows:

Frost ES Equipment: \$99,106

Frost ES Implementation & Services: \$88,099

Future Ready Center Equipment: \$160,683

Future Ready Center Implementation & Services: \$177,152

San Gabriel ES Equipment: \$101,167

San Gabriel ES Implementation & Services: \$88,504

Benold MS Equipment: \$120,474

Benold MS Implementation & Services: \$116,373

Roofing and Electrical Allowance: \$16,000.00

\*includes contingency costs

This project is the first phase of our district-wide strategy to improve cellular connectivity. Going forward, these solutions will be integrated into the construction plans for our upcoming new facilities, including High School #3, Middle School #5, and Elementary School #12. We anticipate a future bond will be necessary to retrofit other existing schools that require this essential upgrade.
