Introductory Statement of Belief:

As an organization we believe that all students are capable of achieving proficiency and being college and career ready.

If we:

Continue using high quality instructional materials (HQIMs) for Tier 1 with a focus on Essential Learning Outcomes (ELOs), and implement a systematic plan for Tier 2 for struggling students, which uses data to identify who is struggling with specific ELOs, provides high quality instruction focused on those ELOs, and regularly assesses whether proficiency has been reached

Then (expected outcome):

We will close achievement gaps and struggling students will reach proficiency.

Tier 2 Checklist of Non-Negotiables:

- _____ Tier 2 instruction is scheduled for at least 4 days per week at the building level, and individual students needing Tier 2 instruction in reading and/or math receive Tier 2 instruction in that subject at least 2 times per week.

- _____ Students that aren't proficient on Essential Learning Outcomes (ELOs) are assigned to Tier 2.

- _____ Tier 2 instruction is focused on the non-proficient ELOs.

- _____ Assessments are given to monitor individual student progress on each non-proficient ELO.

- _____ Data is tracked on Tier 2 students and their progress towards proficiency on ELOs.
