Summer Sports Contact Changes for 2025-26

- ***Coaches and team members may now voluntarily assemble without restriction from June 1-30 and July 7-31. Note: Football coaching contact must conclude one week prior to the start of fall practice.***
- ***There will be no sport-specific coach contact permitted from July 1-6.***



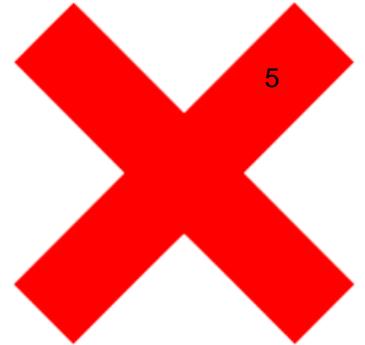
Summer Contact | Pros

- **School coaching staff can coach**
- **School coaching staff can help organize/facilitate “open gym/field” sessions**
- **Lack of accountability in previous “5 contact day” system; change was needed**
- **Decision made based on data from WIAA committee formed last year**



Summer Contact | Cons

- **June 1 start date falls during Spring seasons**
- **Potential negative impact on small schools who rely on the multi-sport athlete**
- **Expectations/pressure from outside to “do more” in summer**
- **No plans at this time to alter coaching salaries for summer work**
- **Conflicts between programs who share student-athletes**



Summer Contact | Impact from 2025

- **Biggest changes came from “Open Gyms” becoming more official team activities**
 - **Coaches had ability to instruct, organize and lead**
- **Fall sports were able to hold more regular team activities, and seemed to benefit the most from the rule change⁶**
- **Capitol Conference AD’s felt it was an overall positive change**

NIL Changes for 2025-26

- ***“Students can pursue NIL opportunities for activities not associated or identified with their school team, school, conference or the WIAA, and in accordance with other prohibited NIL activities, including language attempting to deter undue influence.”***



NIL Changes for 2025-26



- **Why?**
 - **To avoid state from passing a law that would govern how schools must facilitate NIL opportunities**
 - **To be fair to student-athletes, so that they have opportunities to profit from their abilities the same as musicians, artists, etc.**
- **Note**
 - **Very different from college NIL opportunities for student-athletes**
 - **There are a significant number of stipulations that HS students must adhere to compared to NCAA**

Transfers



- ***Transfer Portal. Student enters portal which means other schools are allowed to recruit/entice student to come to their school.***



- ***Unrestricted eligibility is only given to students who complete a family move into a school district. Students are ineligible if there has been “undue influence” in their decision to attend a***

Recruiting / Agents



- ***As a part of the recruiting process, students can be offered any number of NIL opportunities from a wide range of businesses and individuals.***



- ***Cannot use an agent or professional representation to acquire an NIL deal. No individual connected to school (booster club, coach, etc.) can facilitate deal for student-athletes.***

School Uniform



- ***Can represent school; can work with school to facilitate opportunities to promote program for mutual gain.***



- ***Can't represent your school in any branding, advertising, etc.***

NIL | Impact from Summer 2025

- **At this time, we are not aware of any student-athletes with interest in pursuing NIL deals**
- **Capitol Conference discussed hiring a professional resource to guide schools through *dos/don'ts* to be in compliance with WIAA rules, but it was deemed unnecessary at this time**
 - **No individuals in Capitol Conference (New Glarus + 11 other schools about our size in the Madison area) have had students/families explore NIL deals so far.**
