As required by Section 10-703.01 of the Bond Act, the Secretary of the Board or the Superintendent shall publish, or shall cause to be published, a separate notice of the Election in the *Niobrara Tribune*, or such other legal newspaper of general circulation in the District, one time each week for four consecutive weeks, the first such publication occurring at least 20 days prior to the Election. Such notice of the Election shall be substantially in the form submitted to this meeting, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.


Section 6. The Secretary of the Board or the Superintendent shall furnish the final form of the ballot for the Election to the Election Commissioner no later than 42 days prior to the date of such Election (or such earlier date as April be requested by the Election Commissioner). The ballot shall be substantially in the form submitted to this meeting (with any changes as April be required by the Election Commissioner), which is attached hereto as Exhibit B. The Secretary of the Board or the Superintendent shall publish, or shall cause to be published, the form of the sample ballot in the *Niobrara Tribune*, or such other legal newspaper of general circulation in the District, one time not more than 10 days nor less than 3 days prior to the Election.

Section 7. Not less than five days prior to the Election, or such earlier date as April be required by the Election Commissioner, the Secretary of the Board or the Superintendent shall certify to said Election Commissioner a list of all registered electors of the District in counties other than Knox County qualified to vote on said proposition, if any.

Section 8. This Resolution shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage as provided by law.


