Approval of July Meeting Minutes

Public Comments: Justin Gregory from Riptide baseball with a request of lowered fees for fields rentals, timeline for fee information to Riptide families January 1st, 2026.

\$1200 per kid, 55 games in a season. Want to keep prices low for families. Half of the roster has to be kids from District 145. Board discussed individual fundraising for kids, currently 4 fundraisers yearly fund the entire organization. Requesting an individualized contract between Riptide and the City of Waverly for mutual benefit. Concessions stands bring in extra funds. Further discussion among committee and two city council members is needed. Guaranteed a response with numbers by November 2025.
