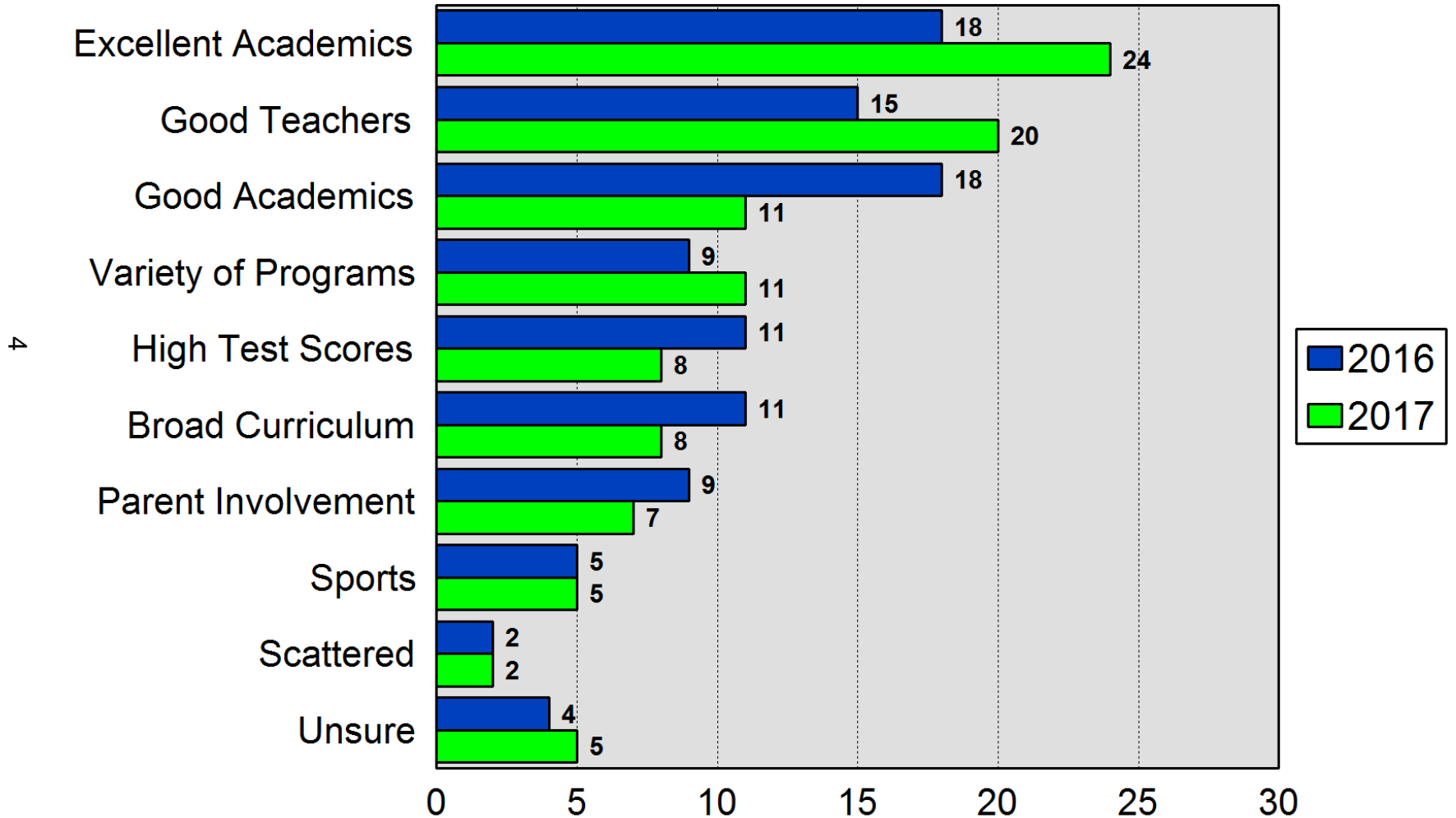

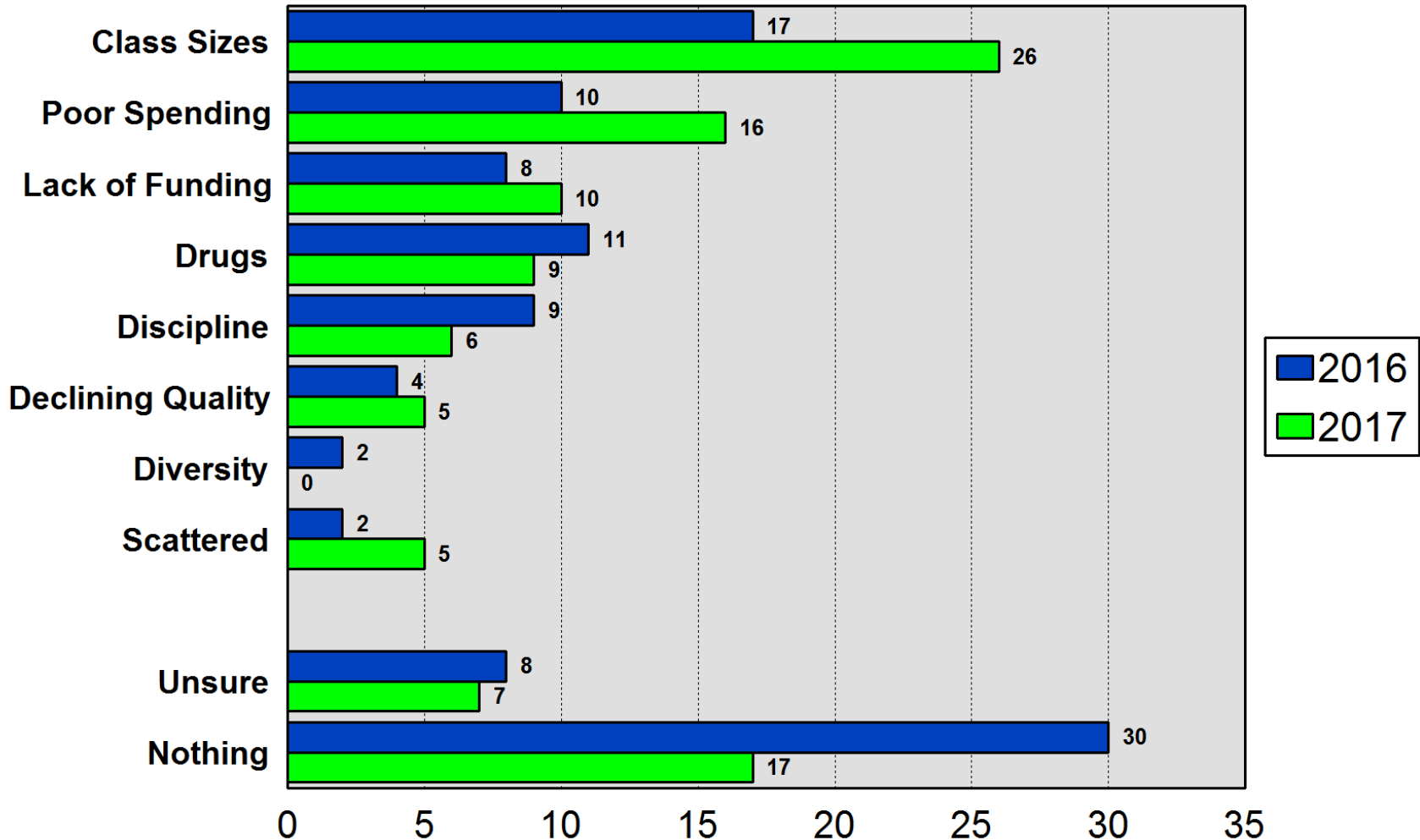

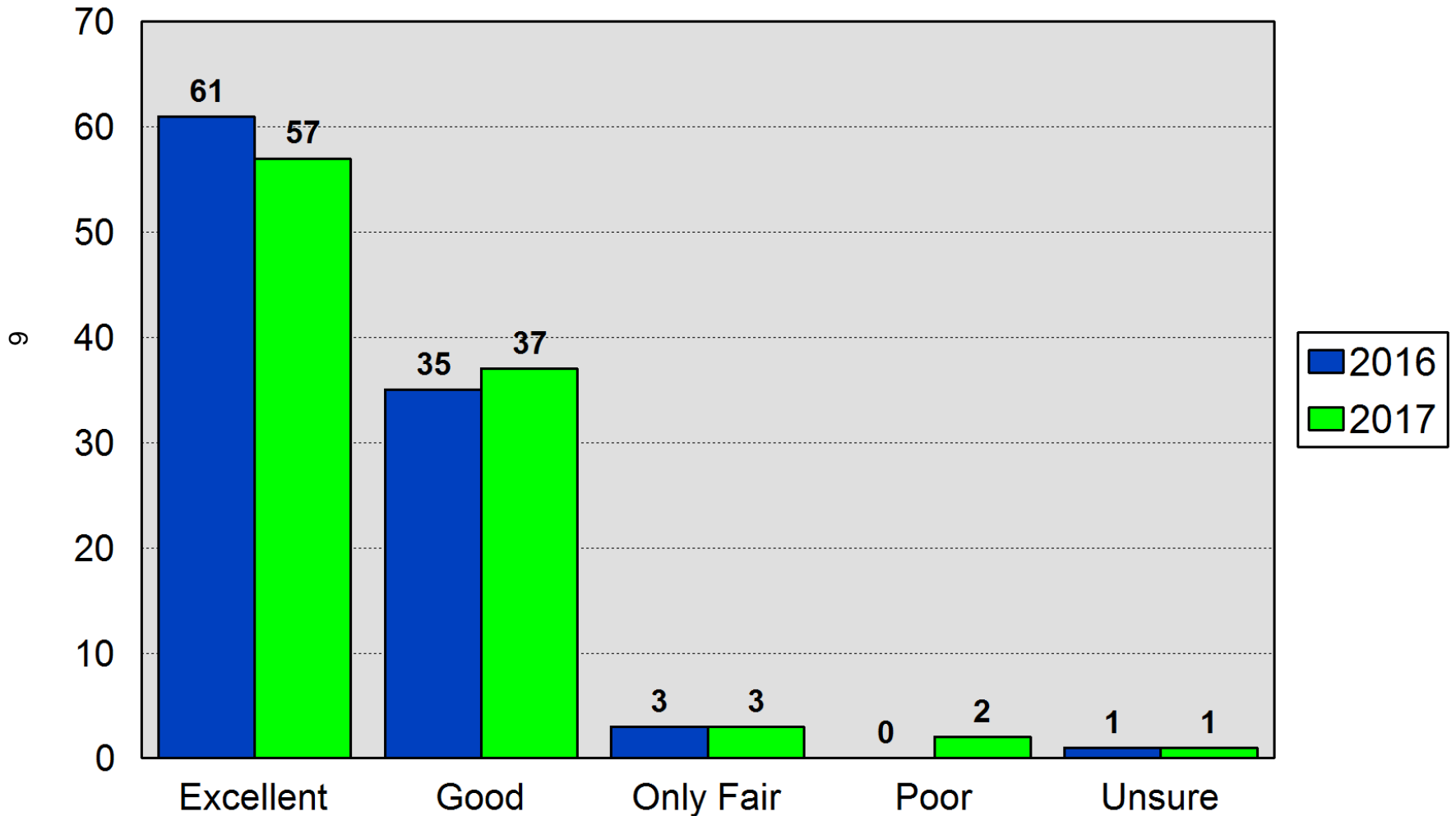
# Most Serious Issue

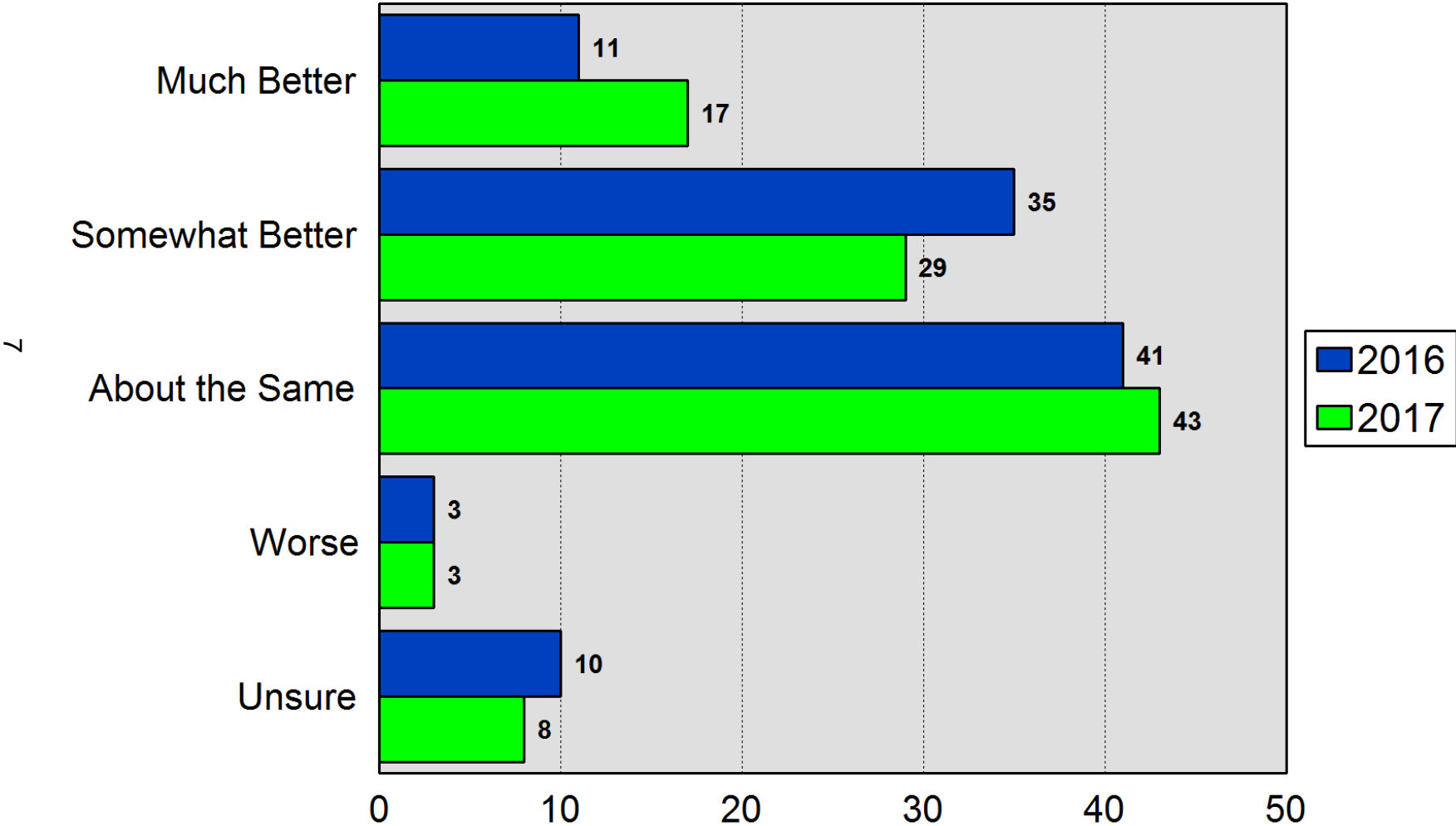

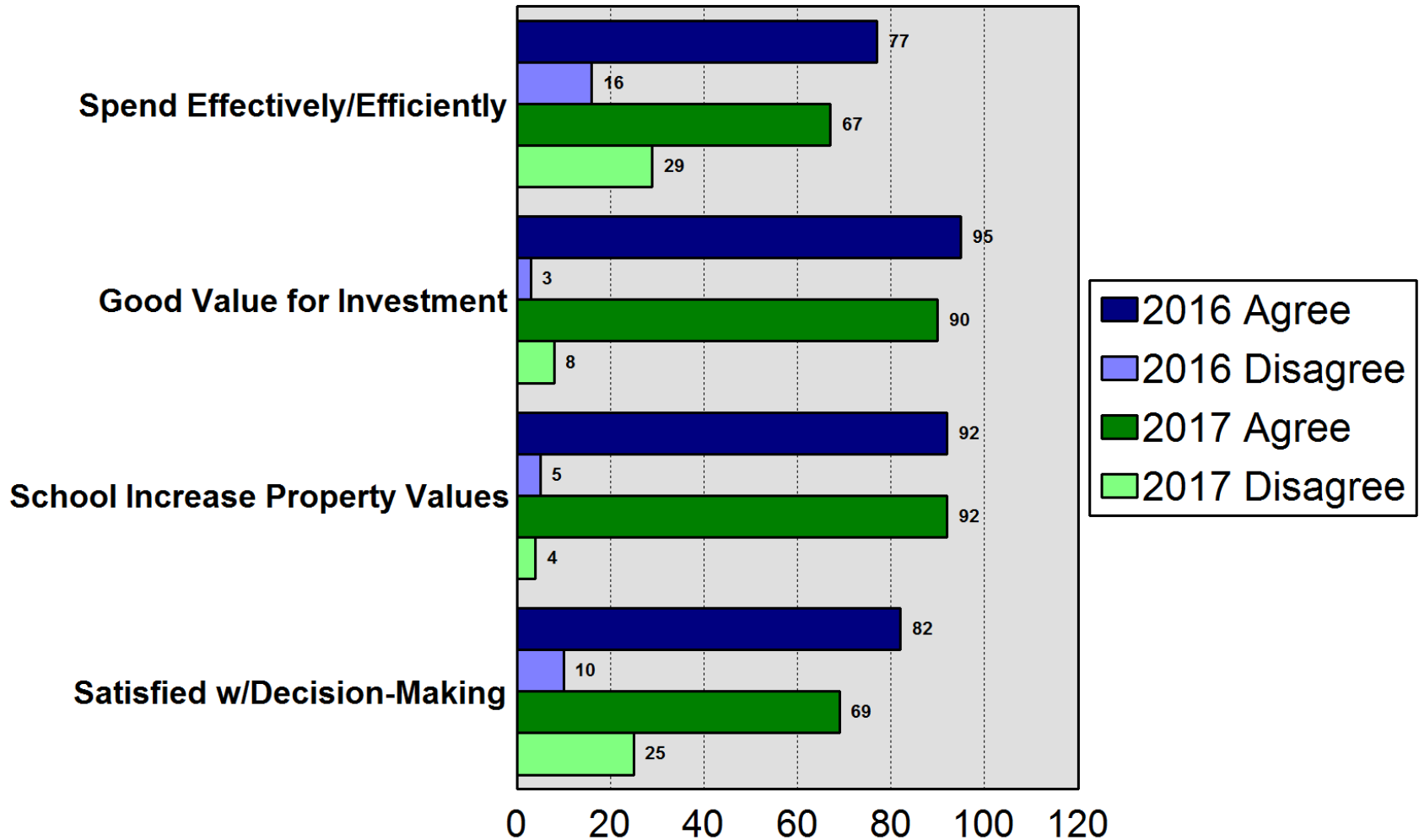
# Compared with Three Years Ago

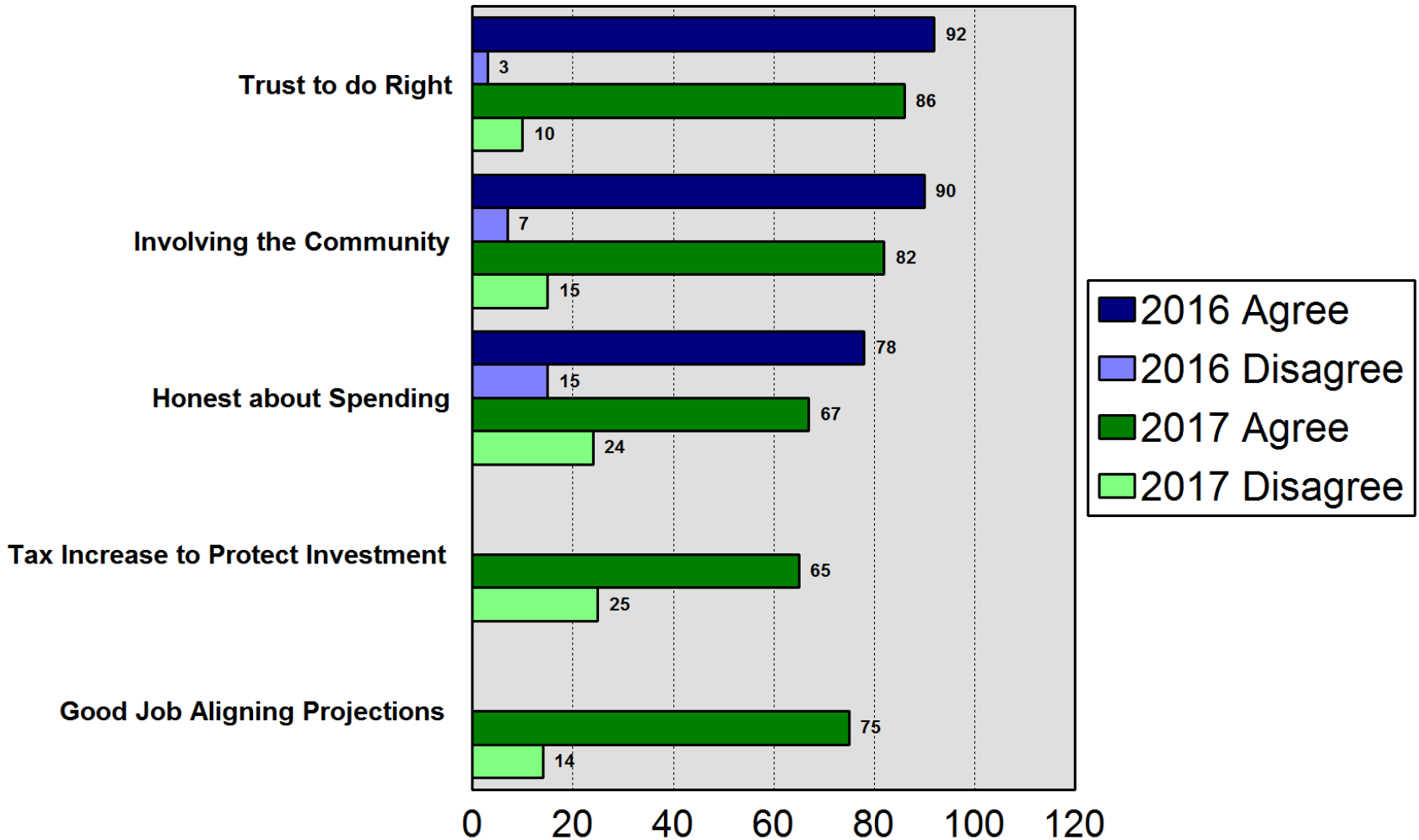

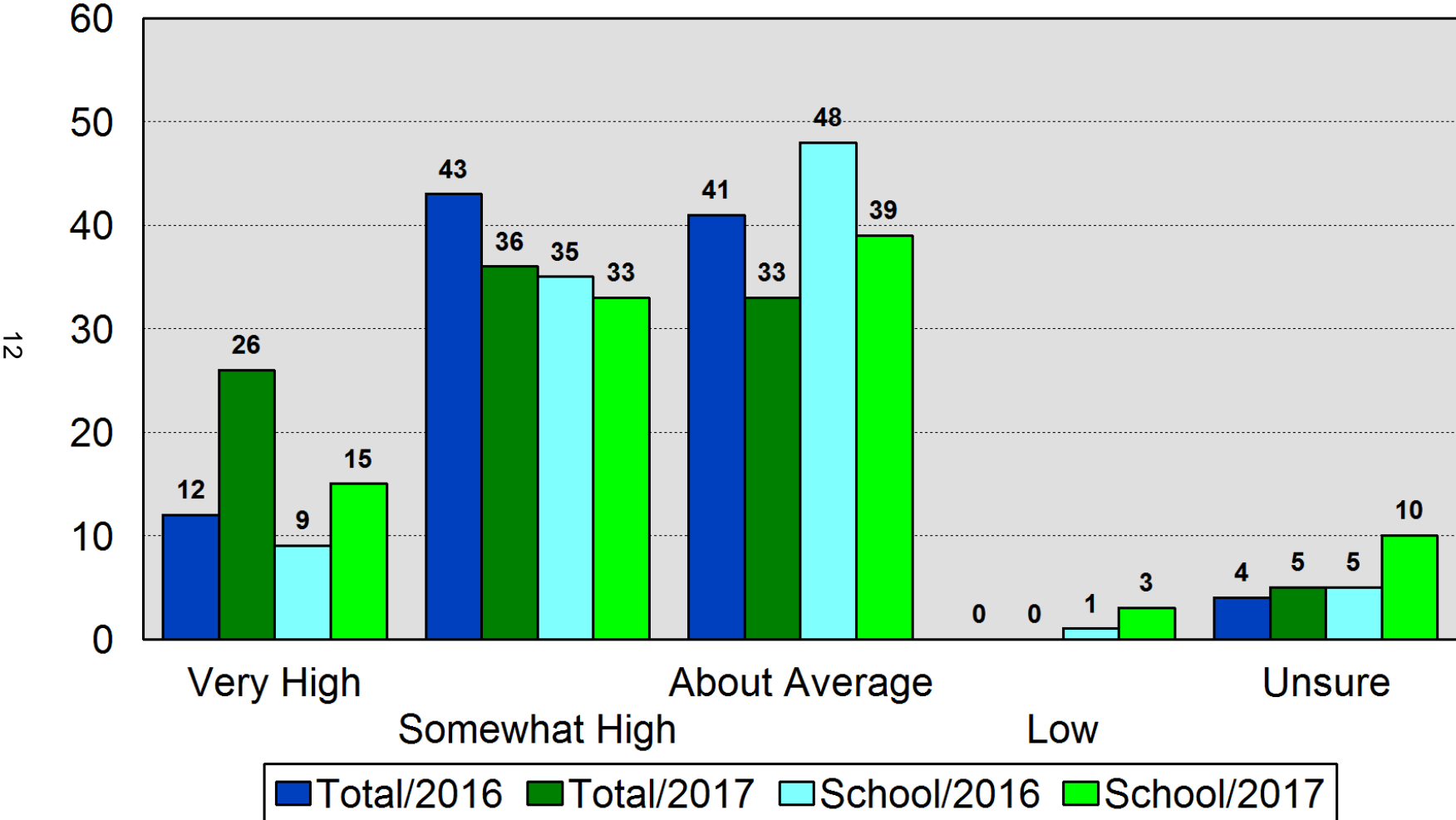

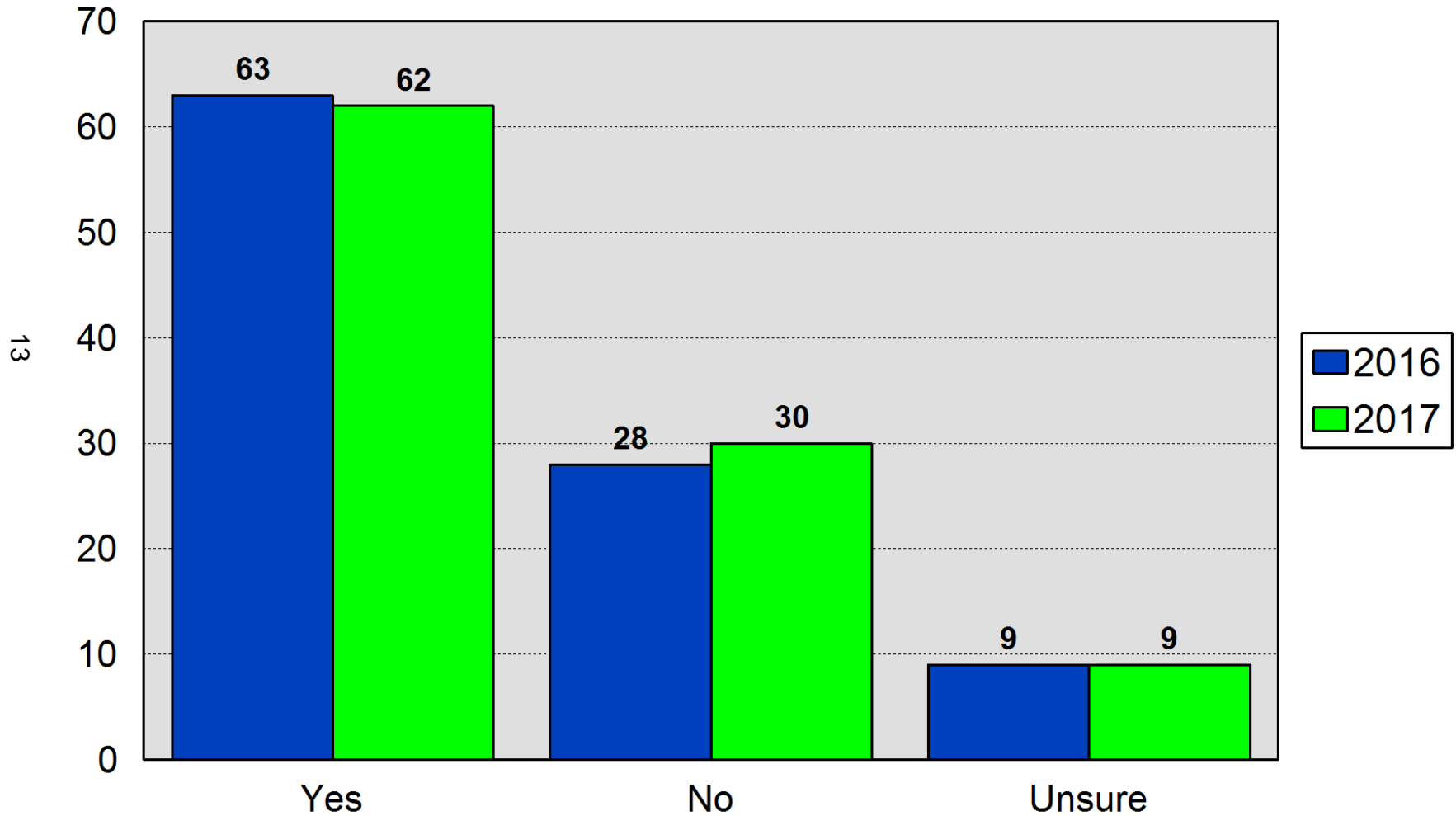
# Property Tax Climate

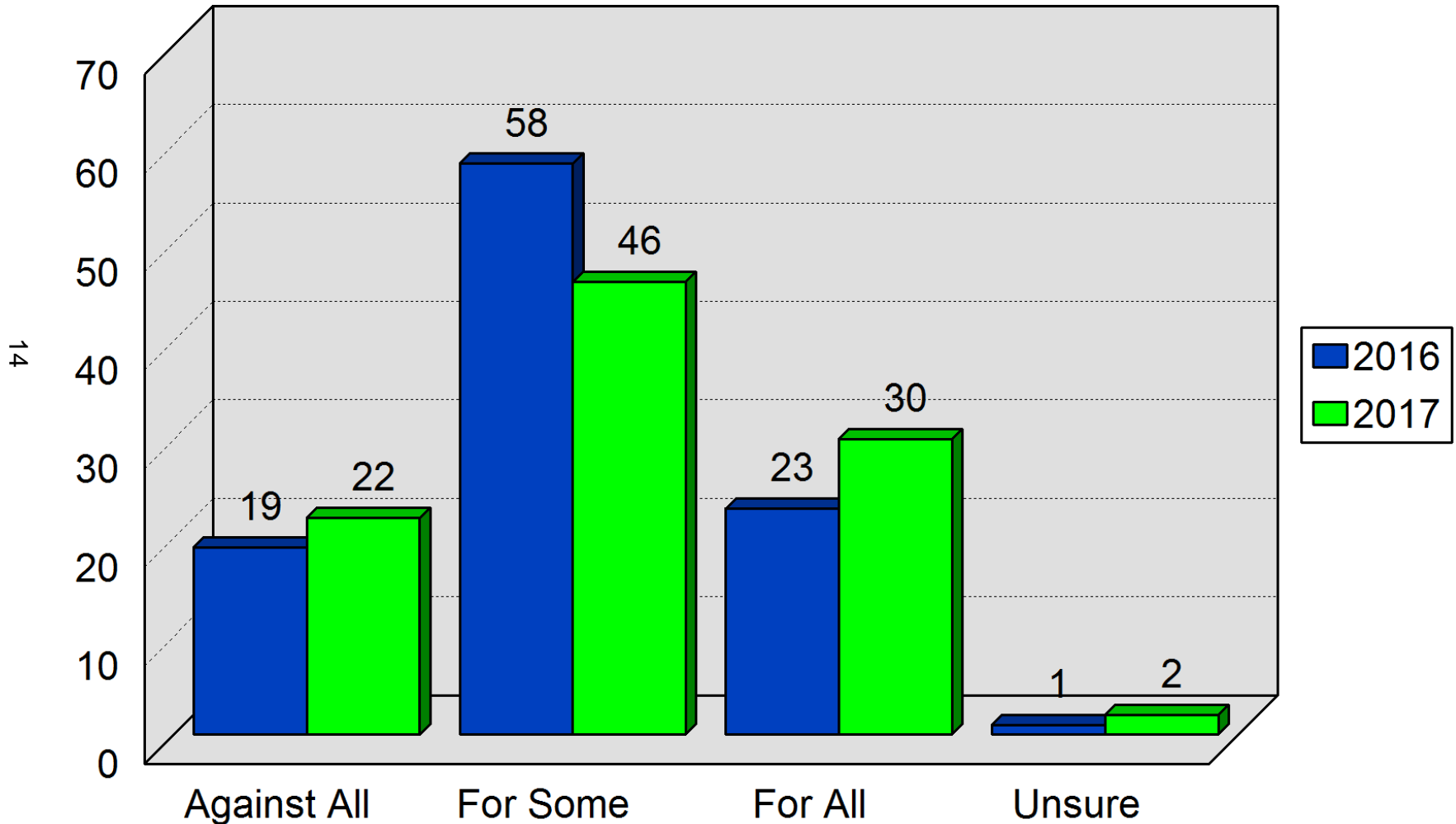

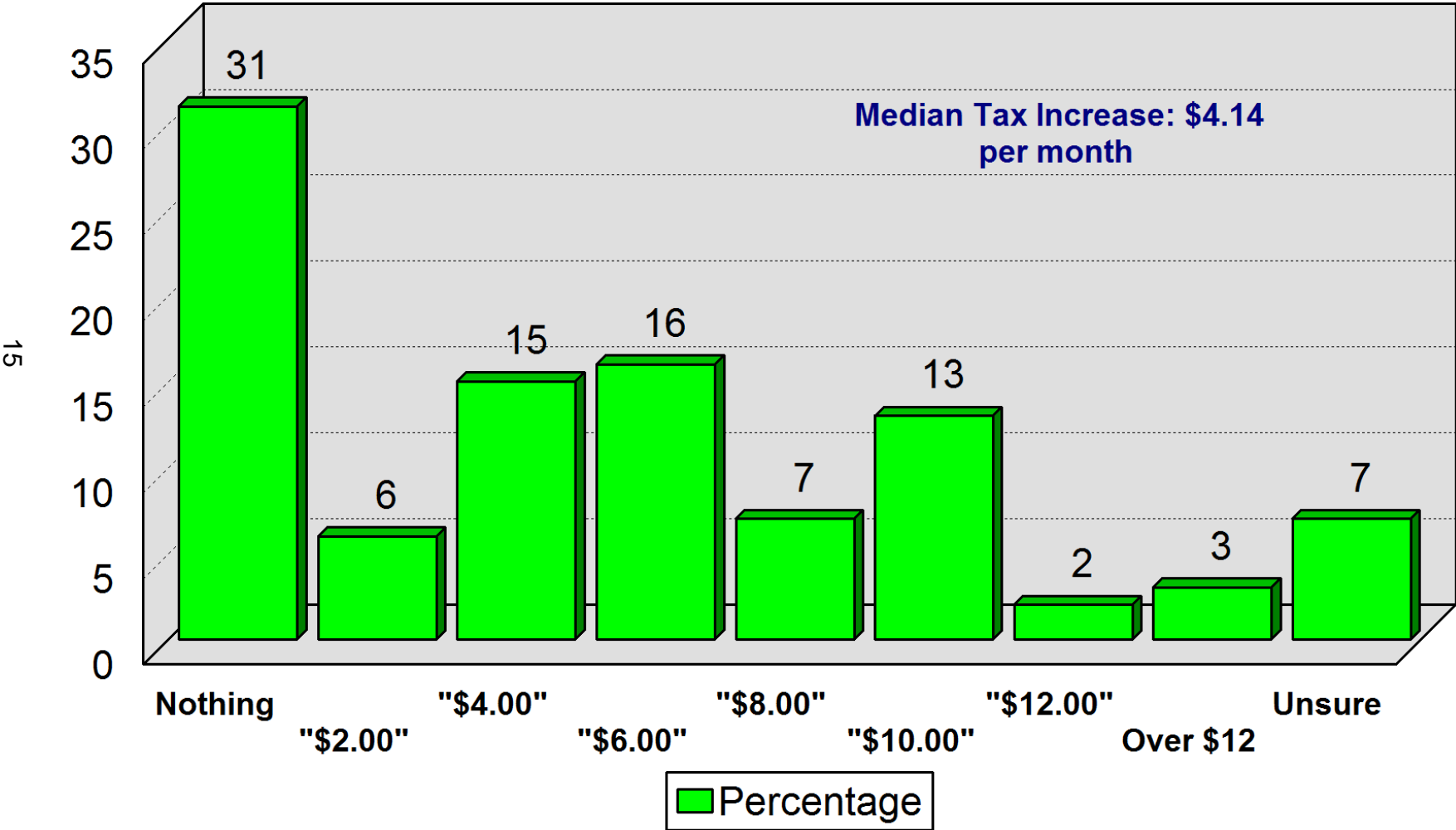
# Tax Increase Predisposition

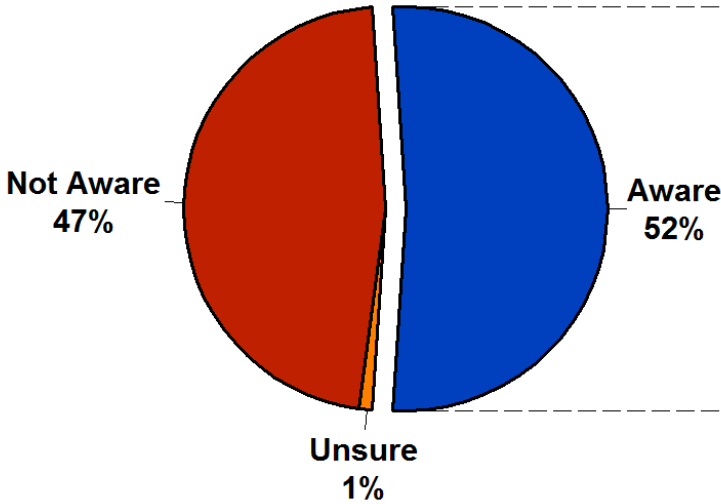

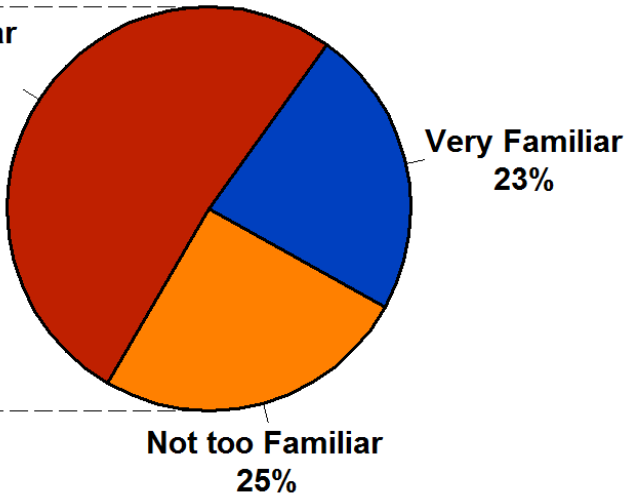

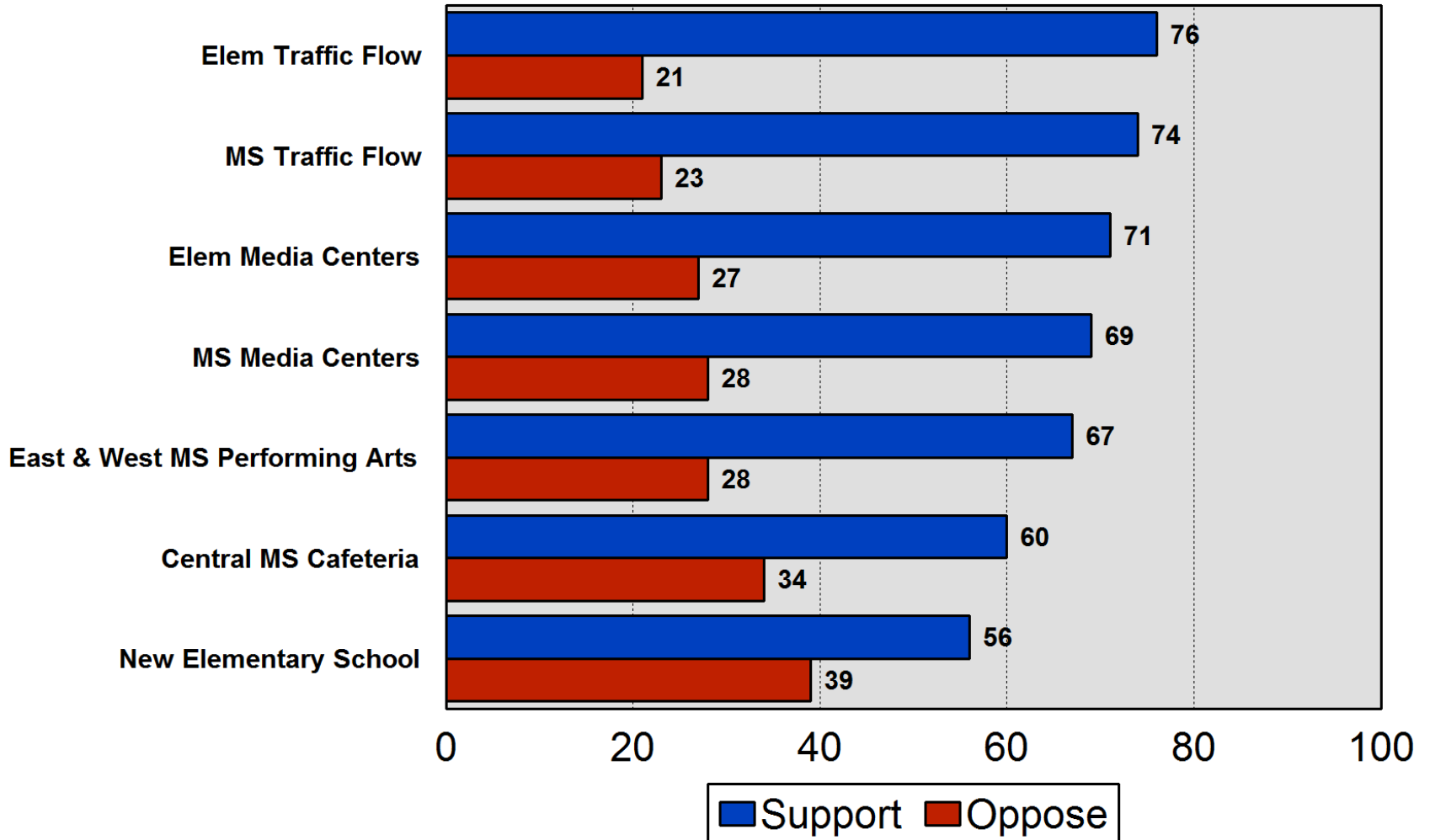

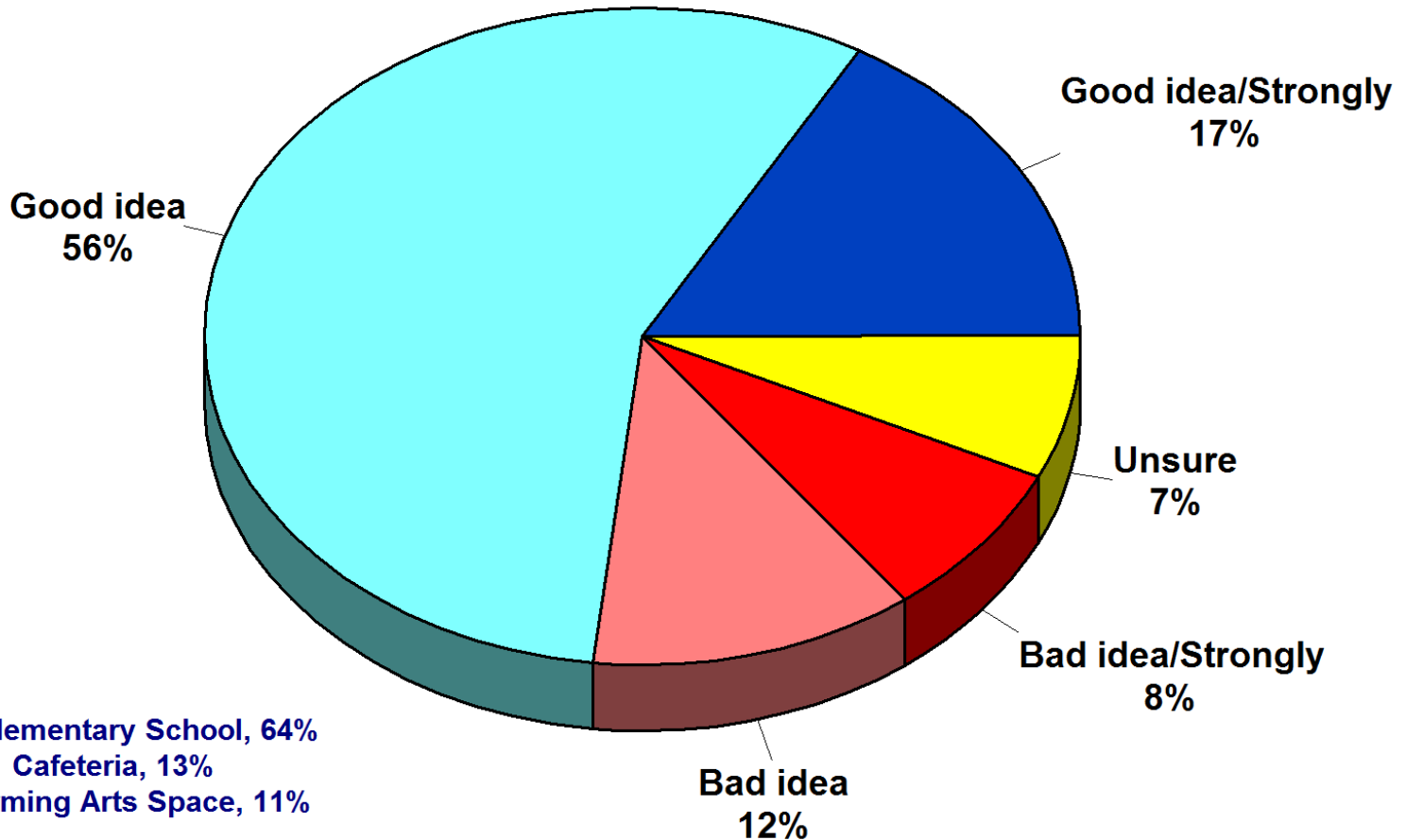

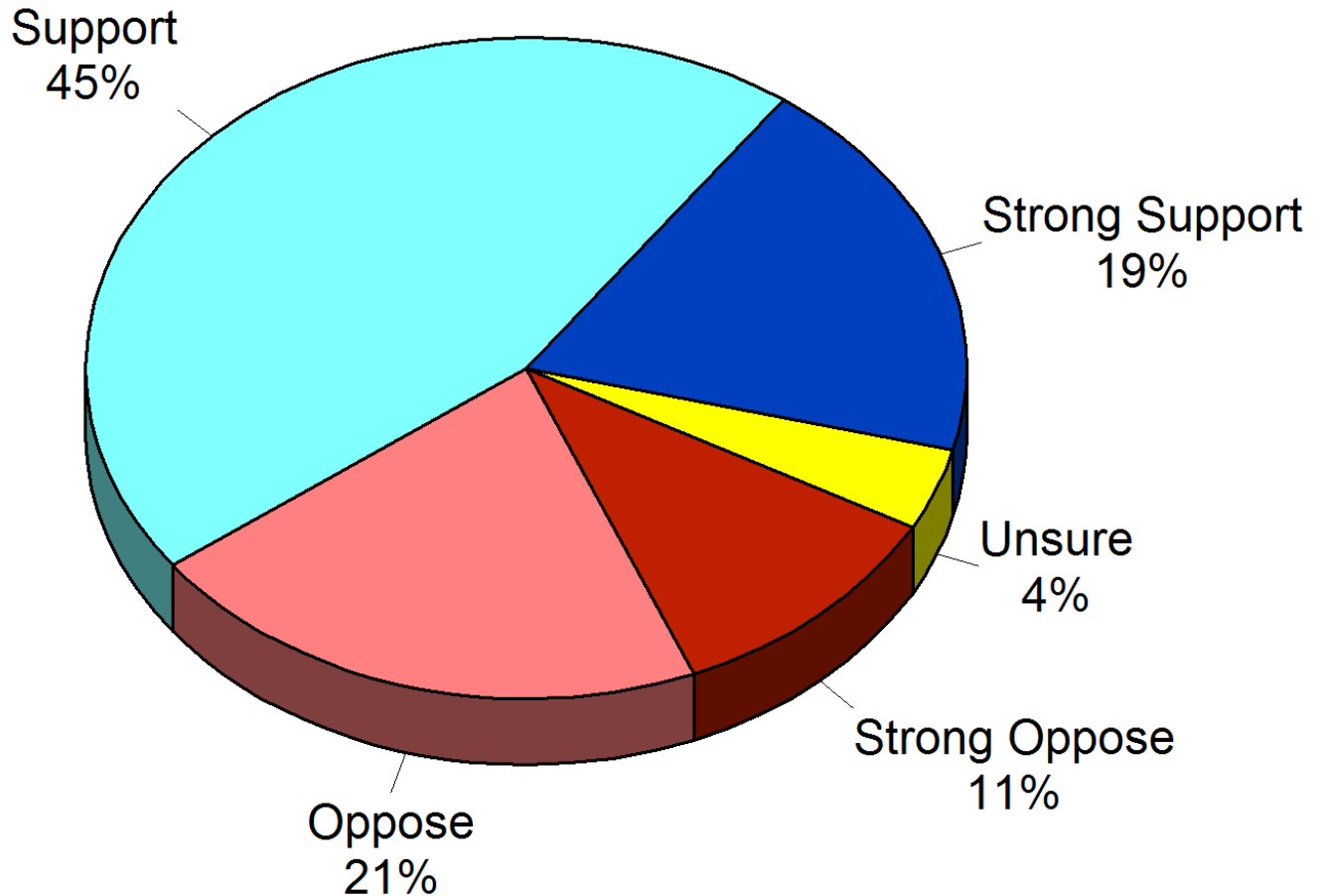

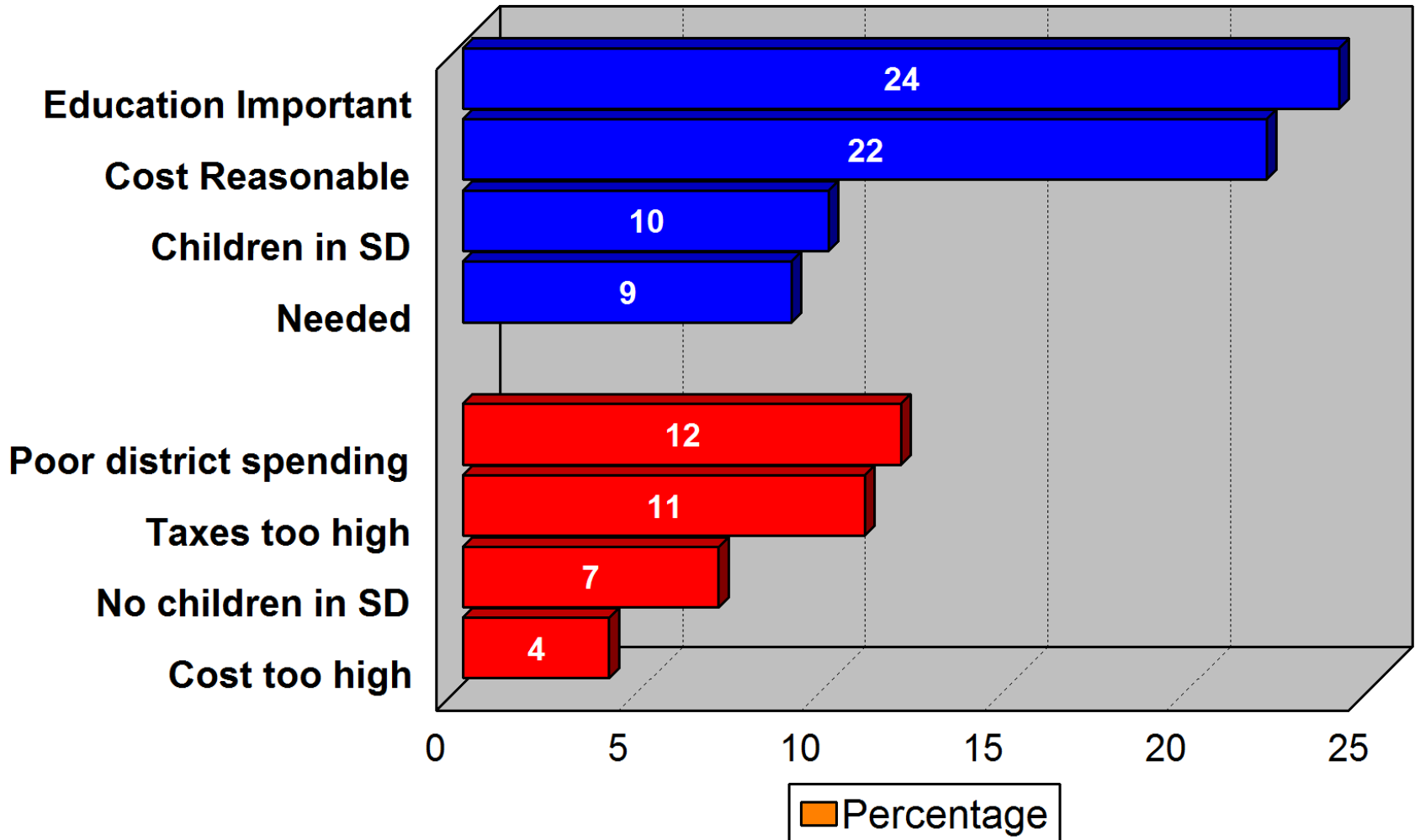

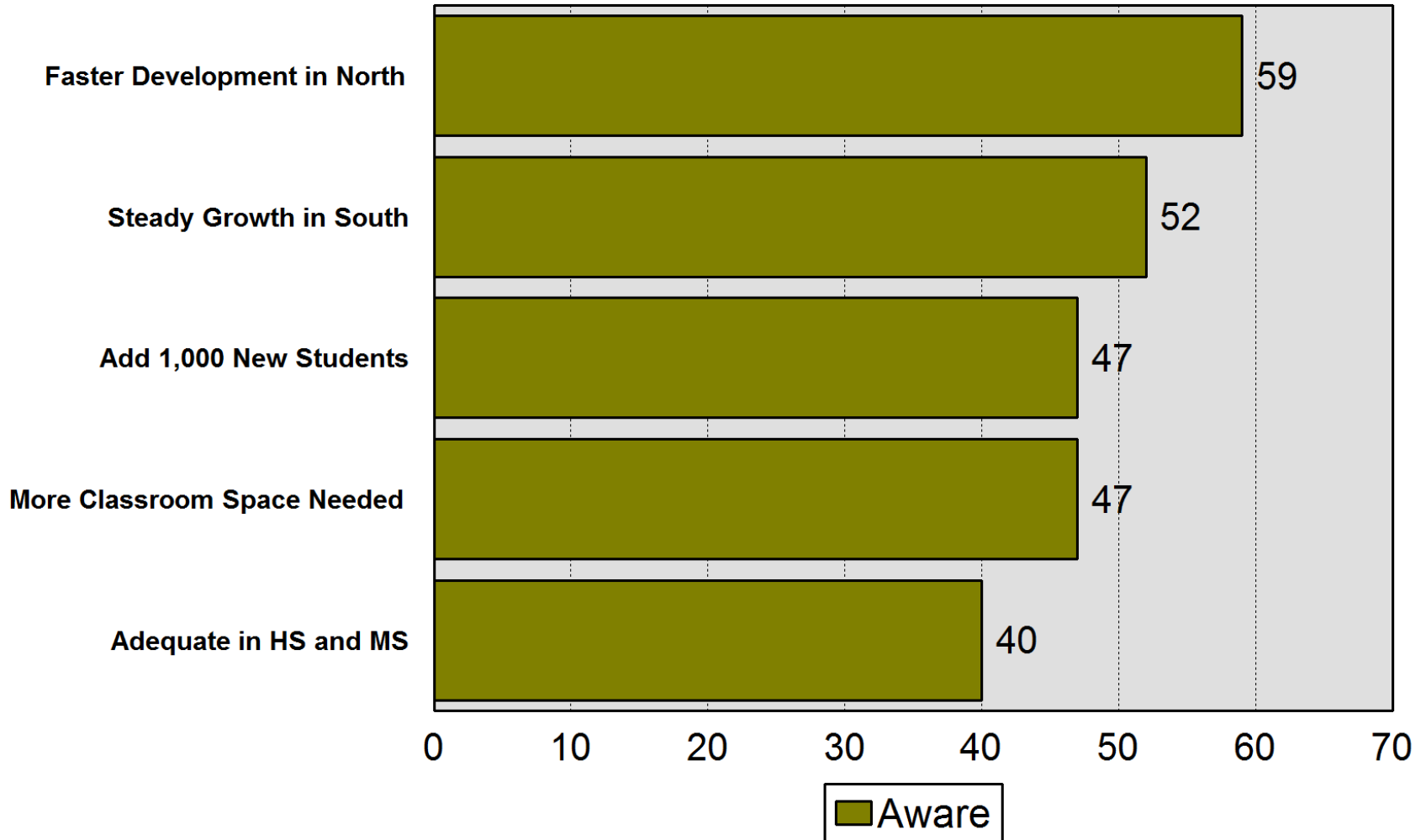

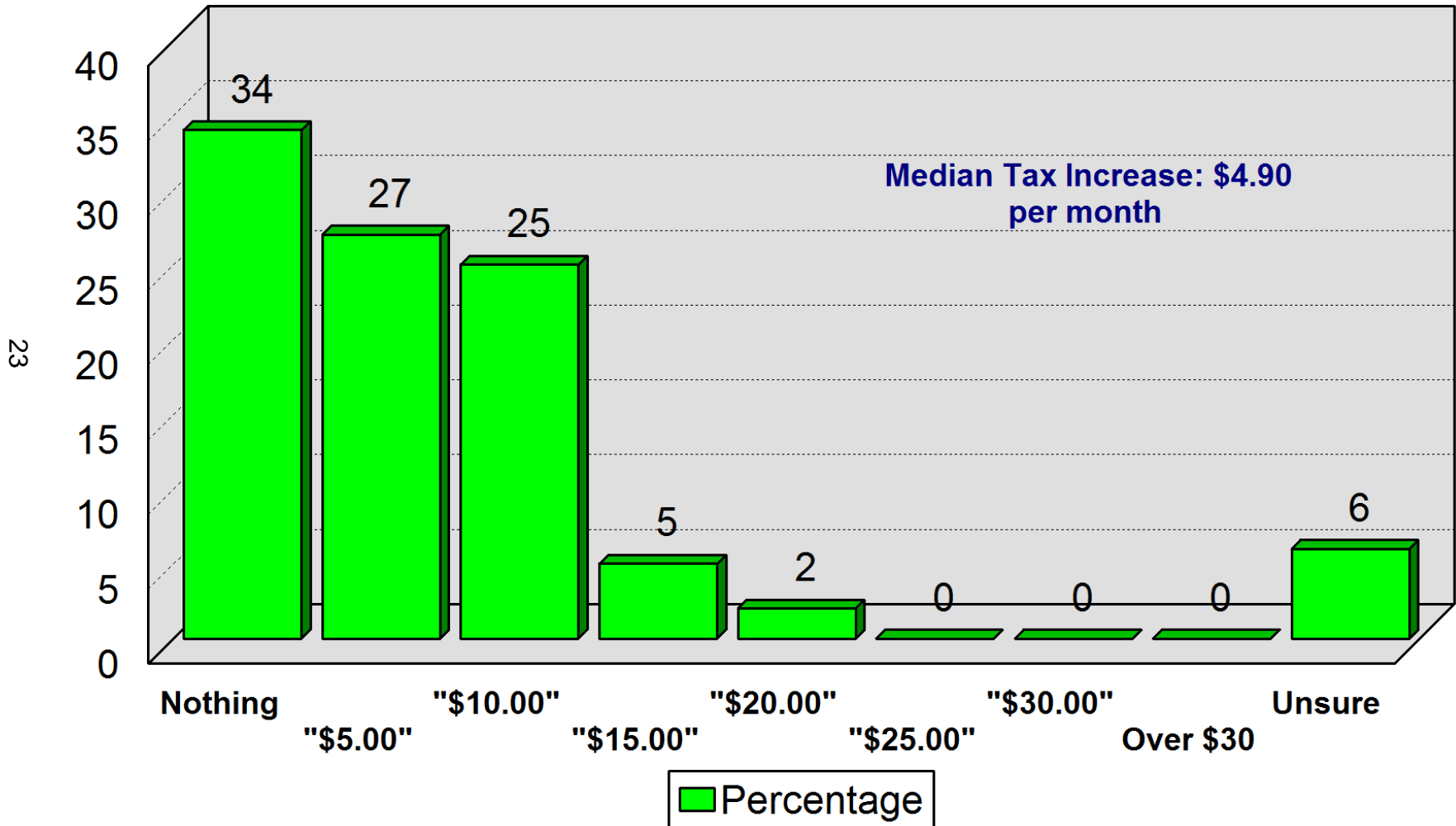

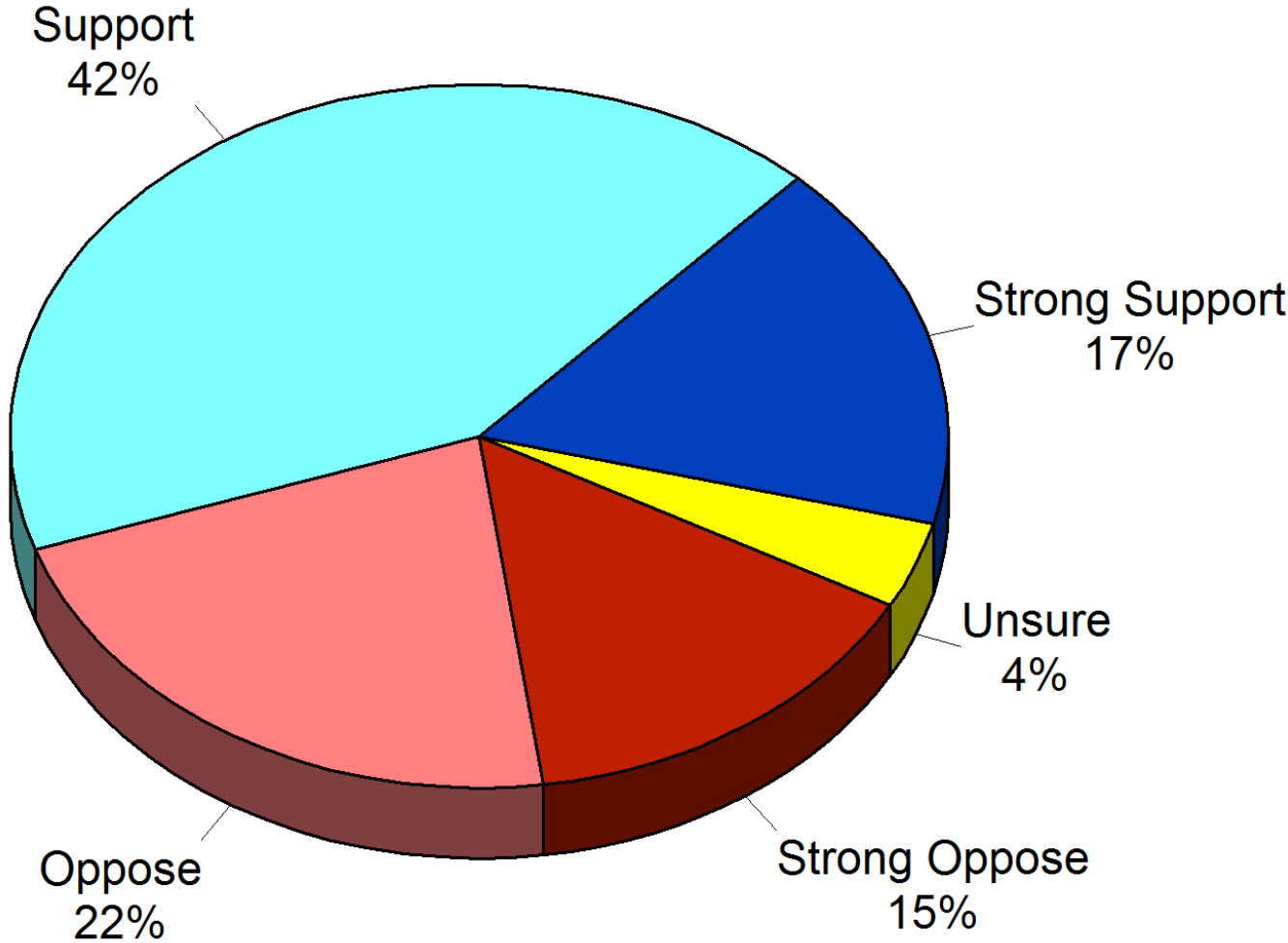
# Tax Increase for Operating Levy

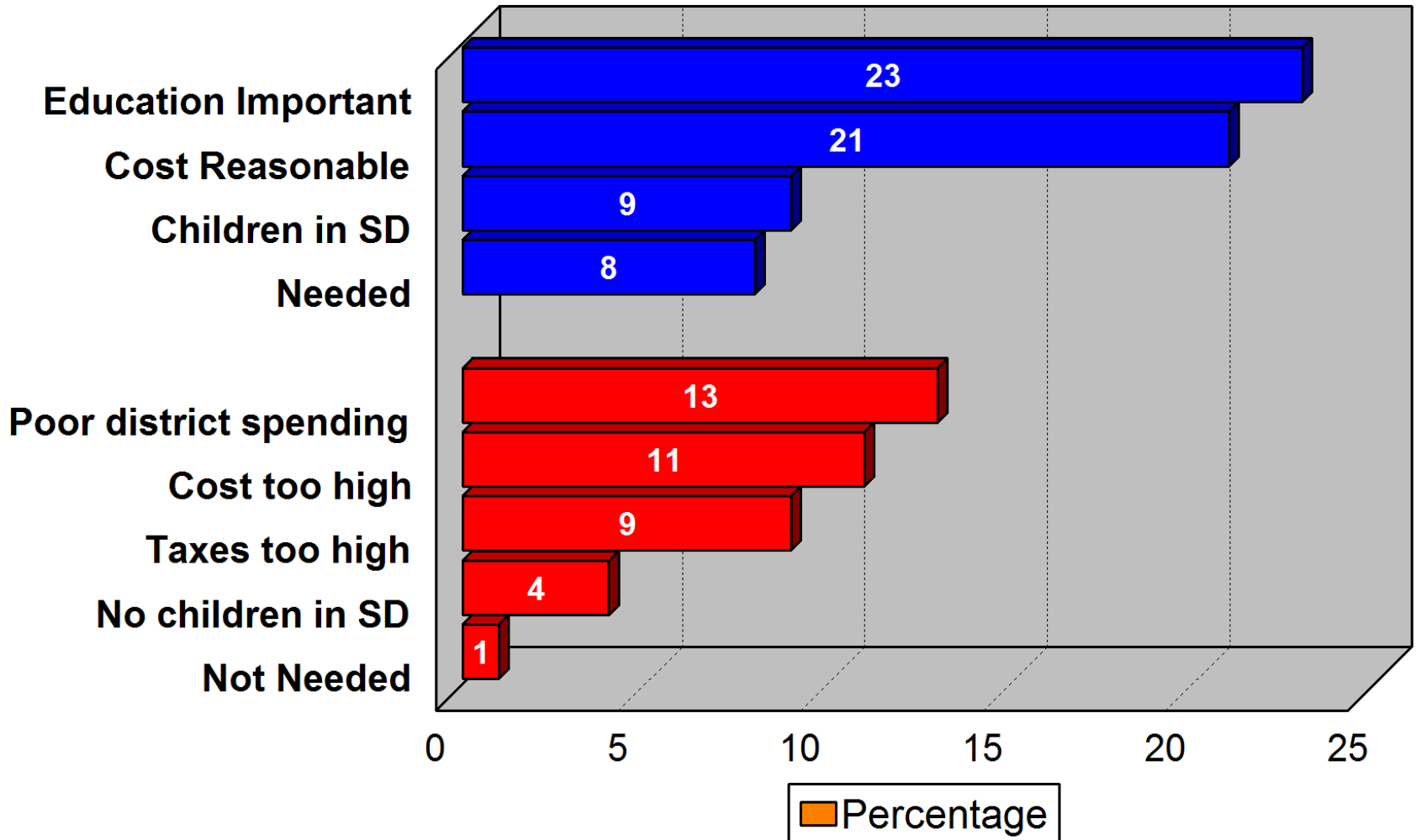

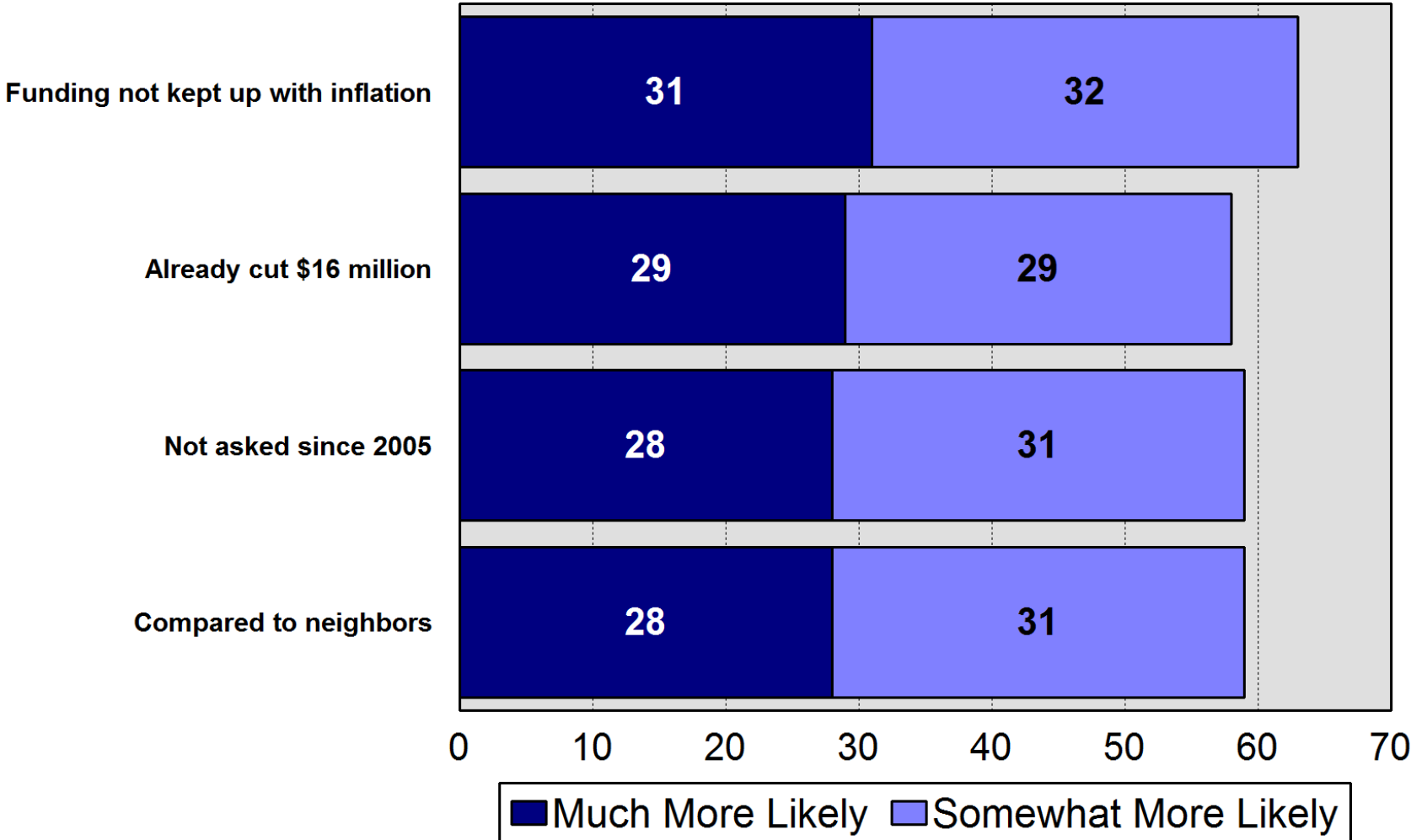

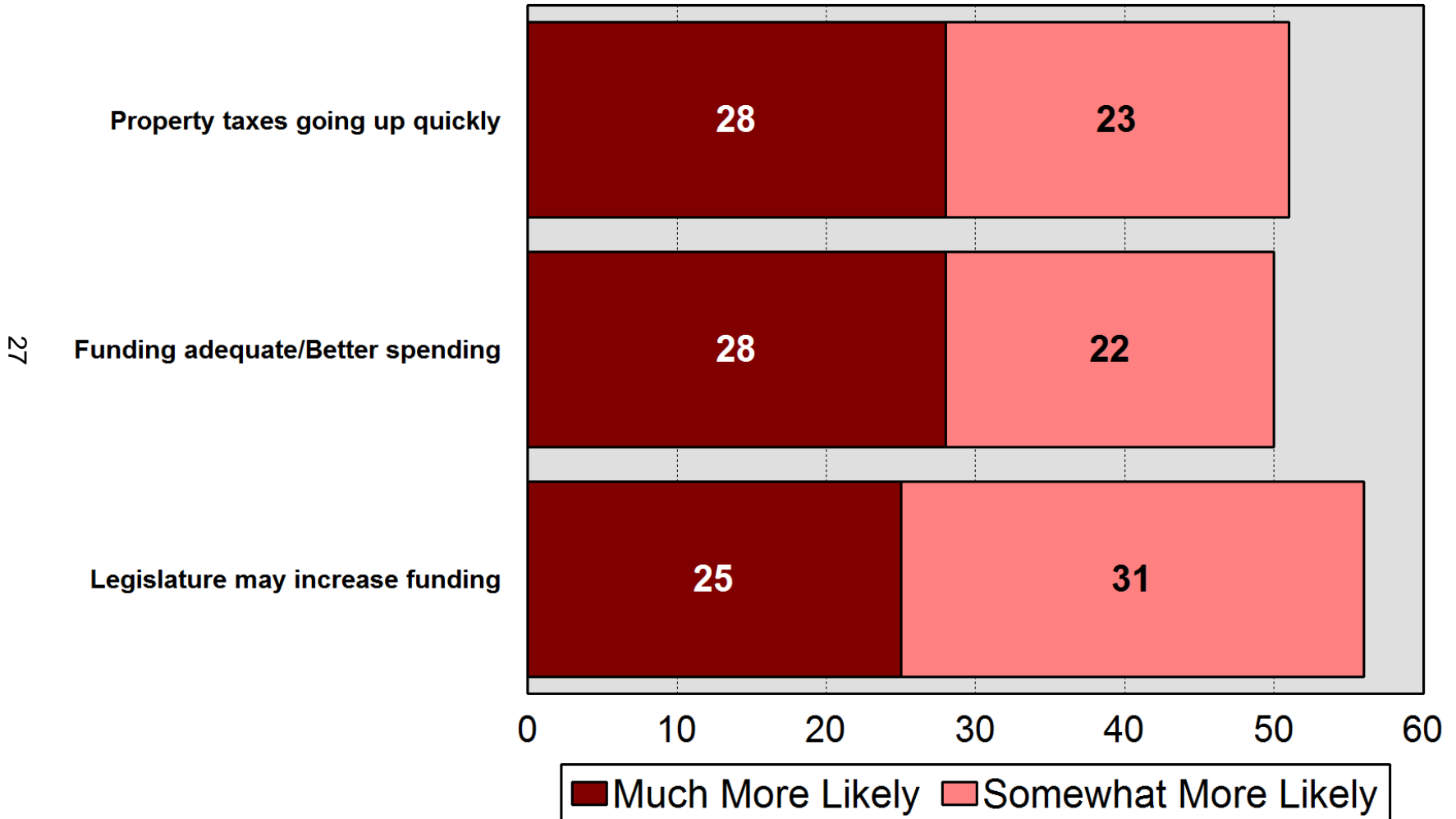

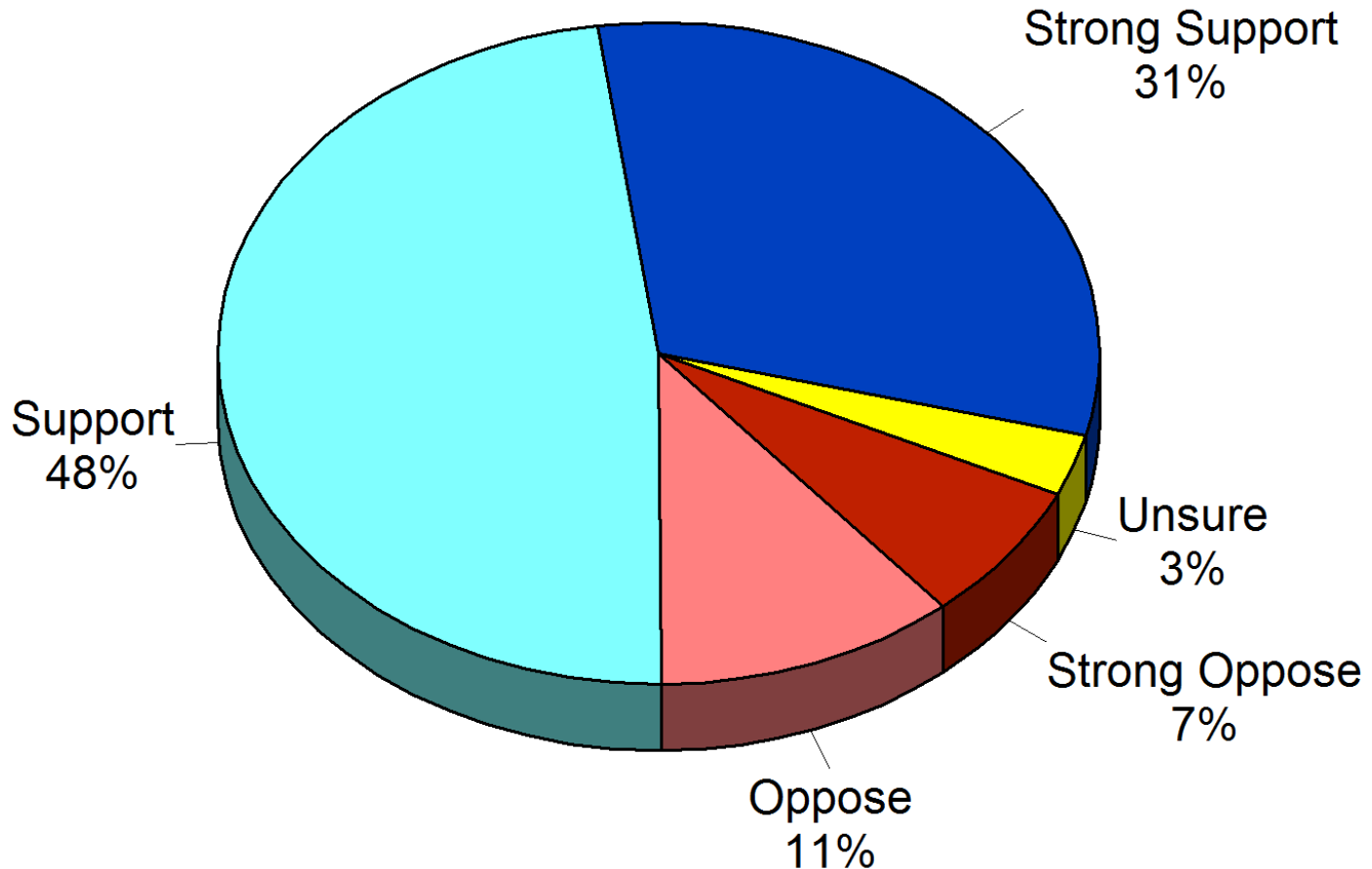

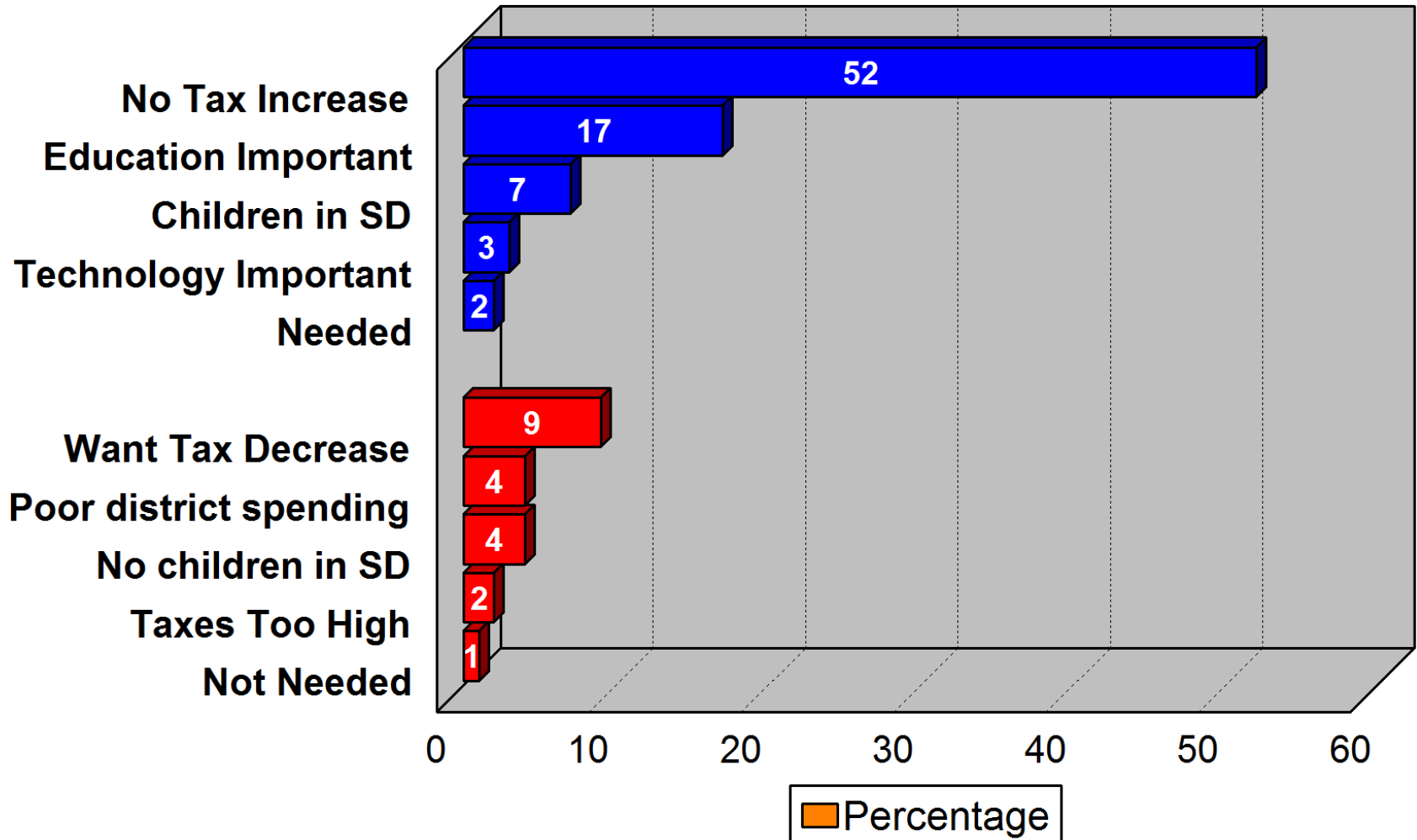

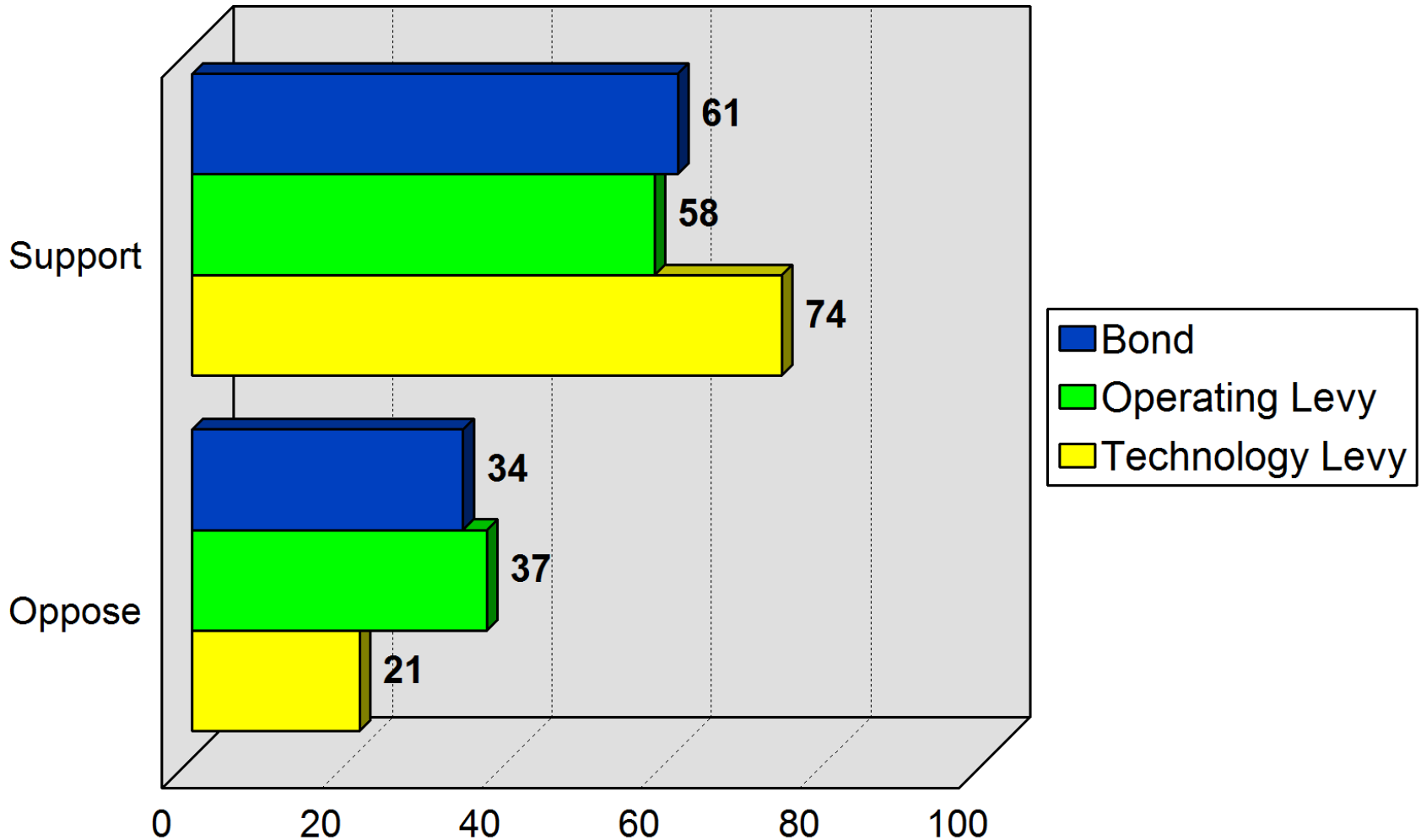
# Reason for Technology Levy

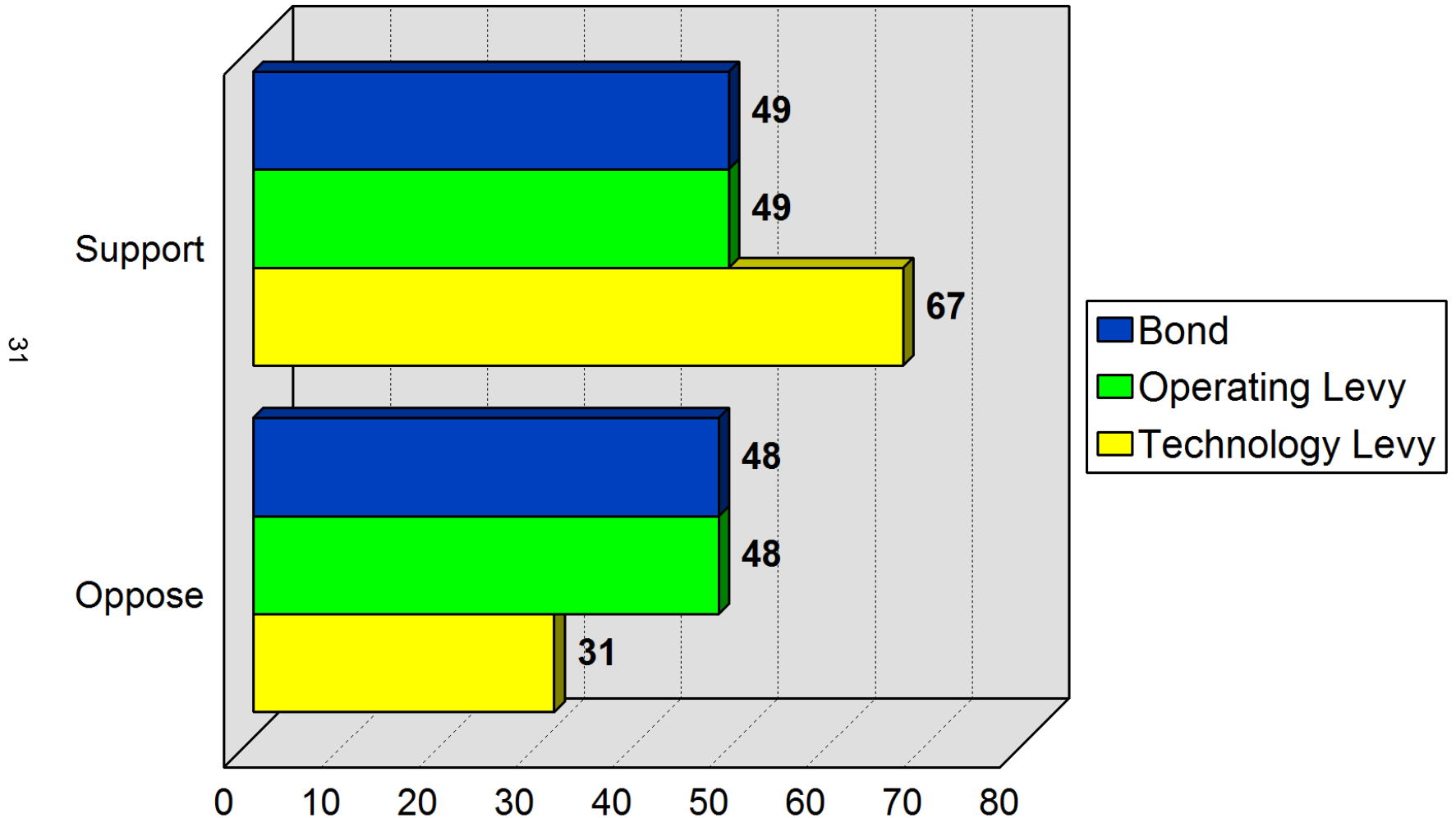

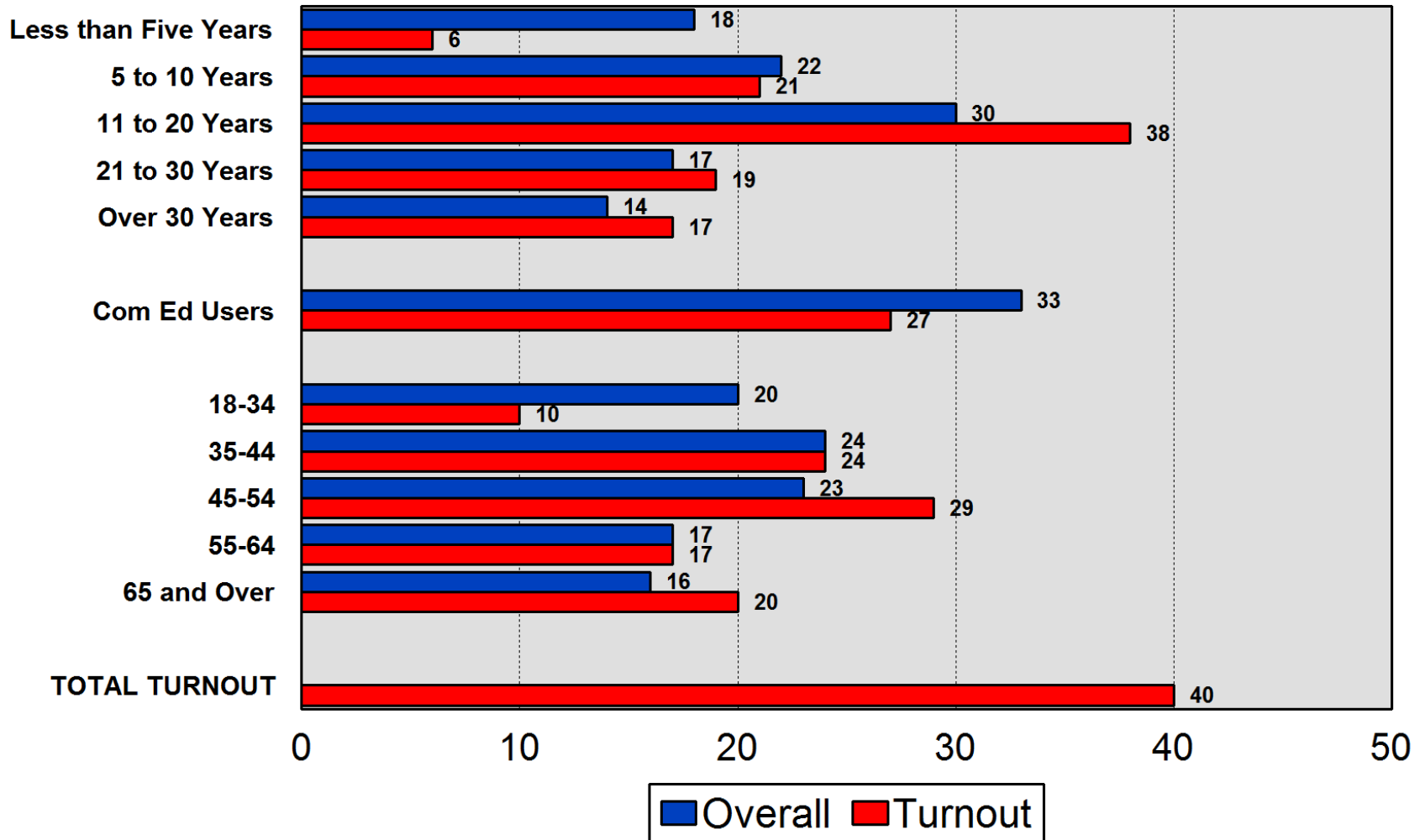
# November Vote (Likely Voters)

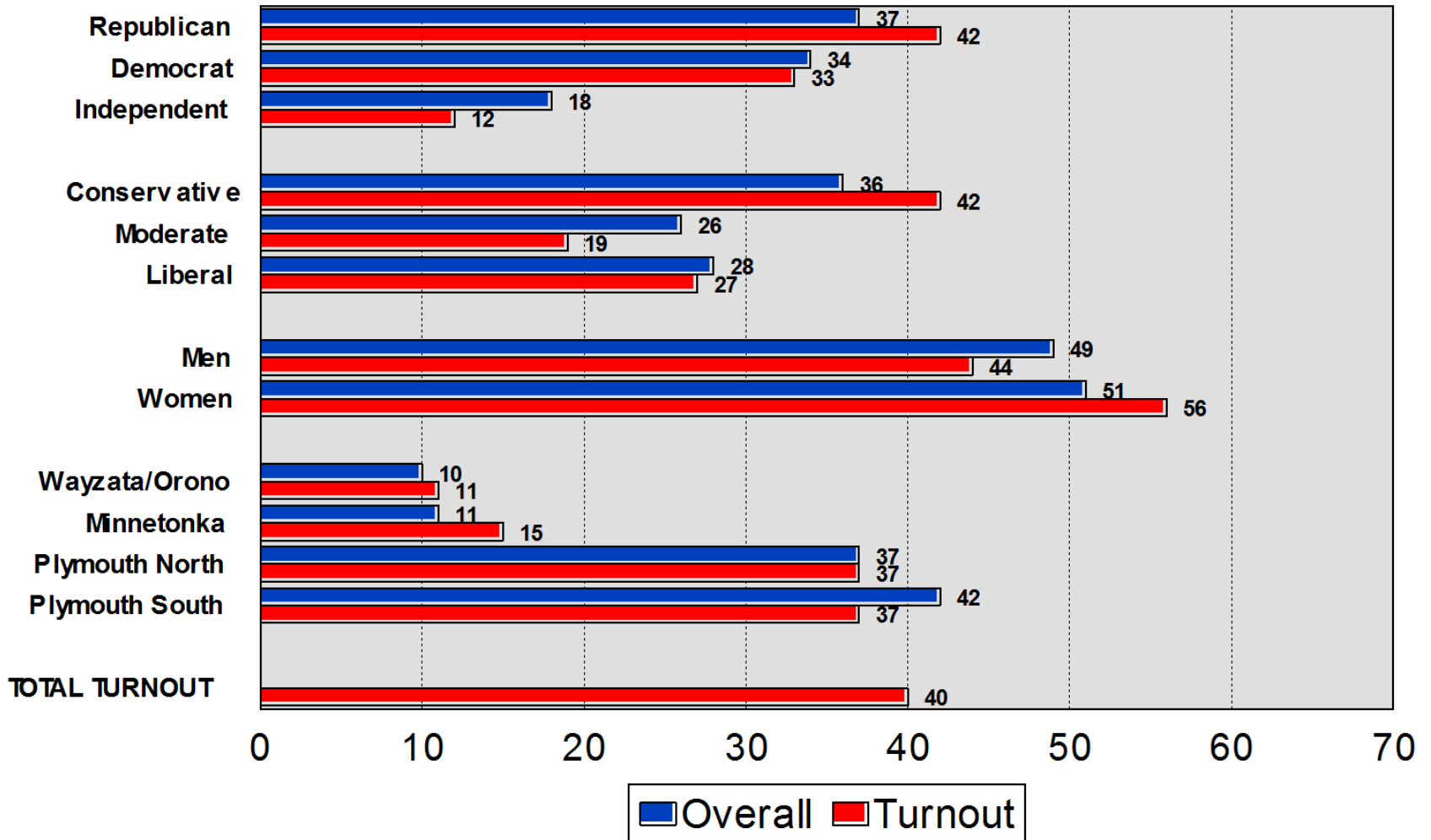

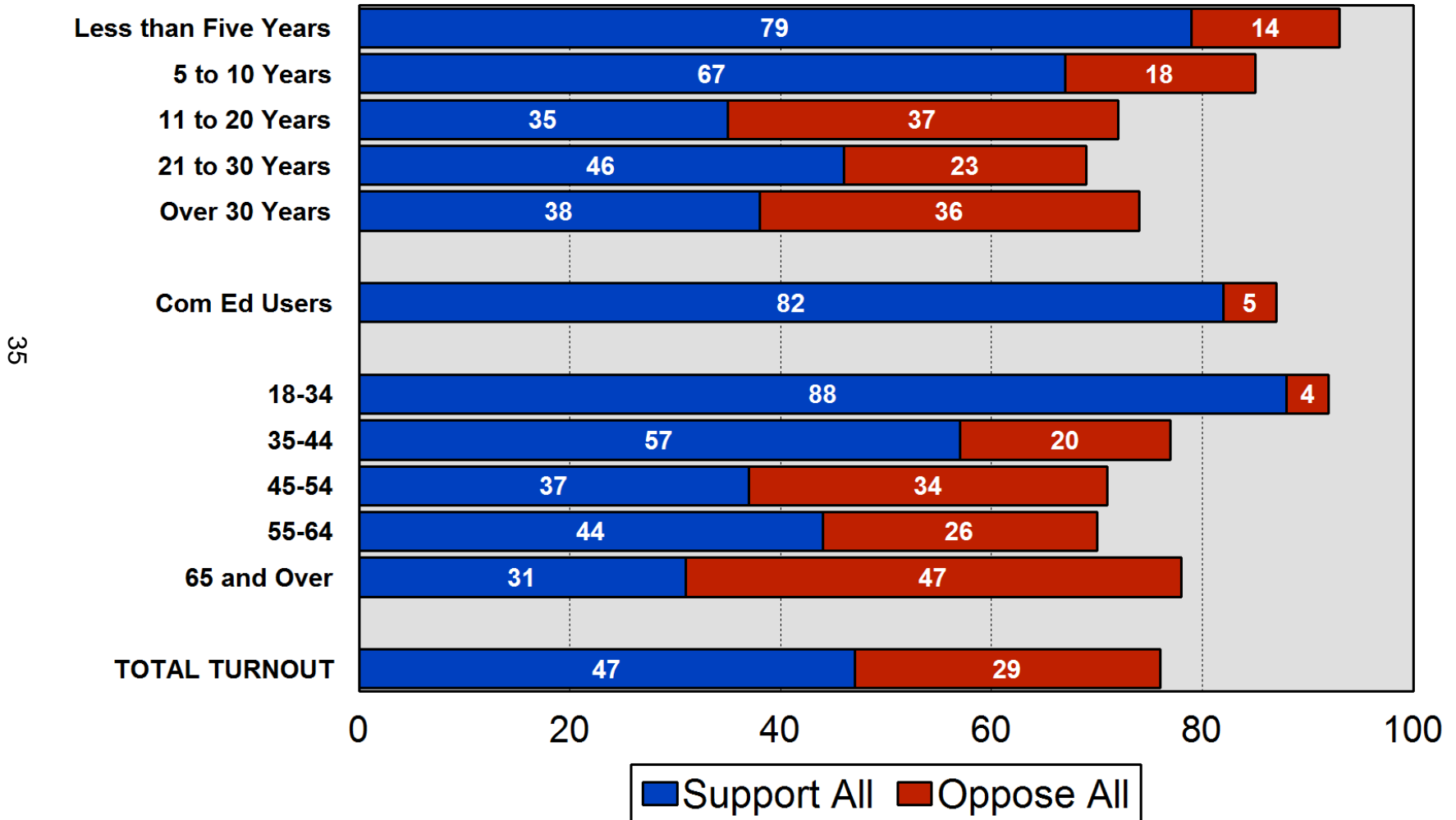

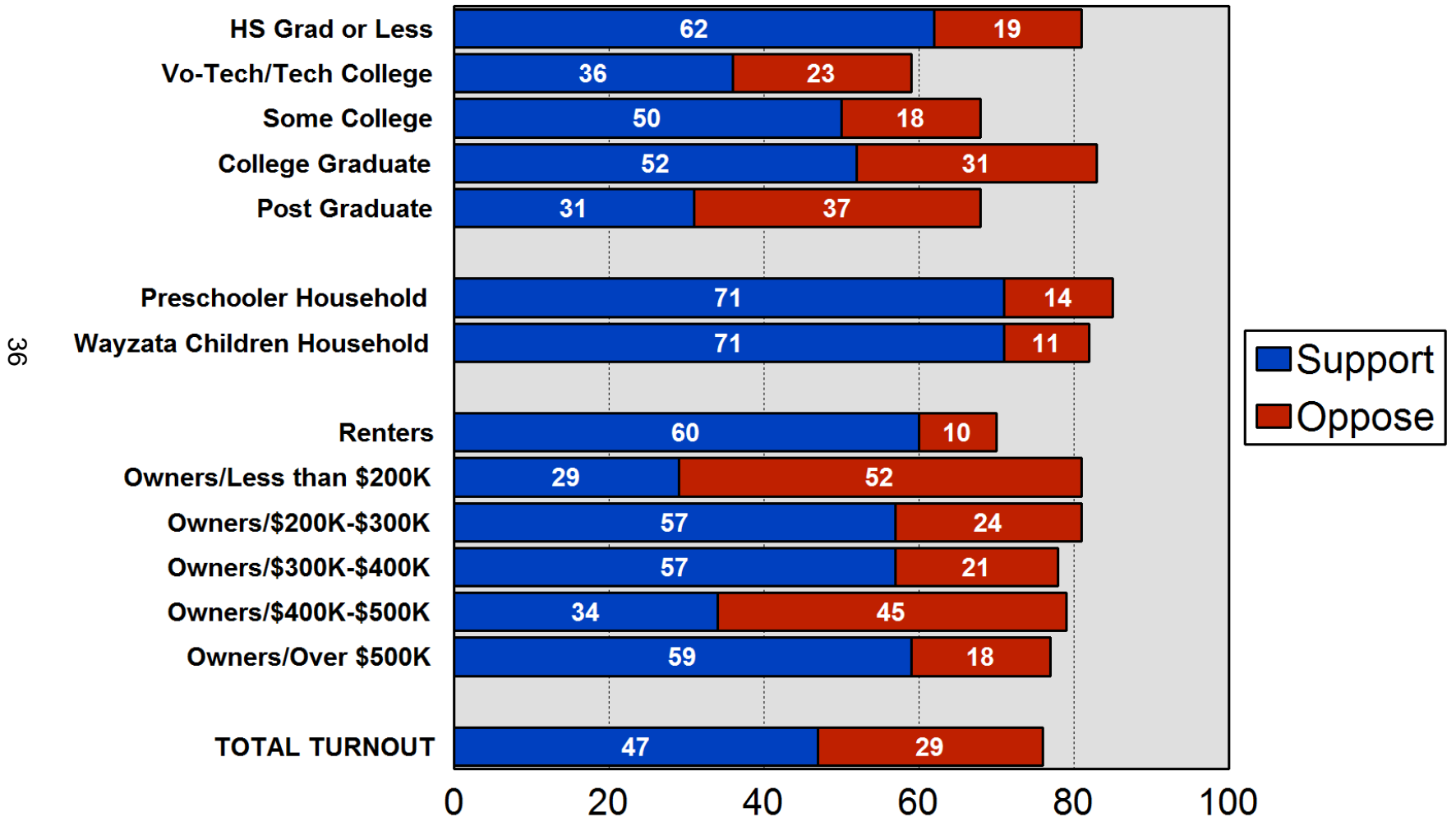
# Likely Voters Referendum Split I

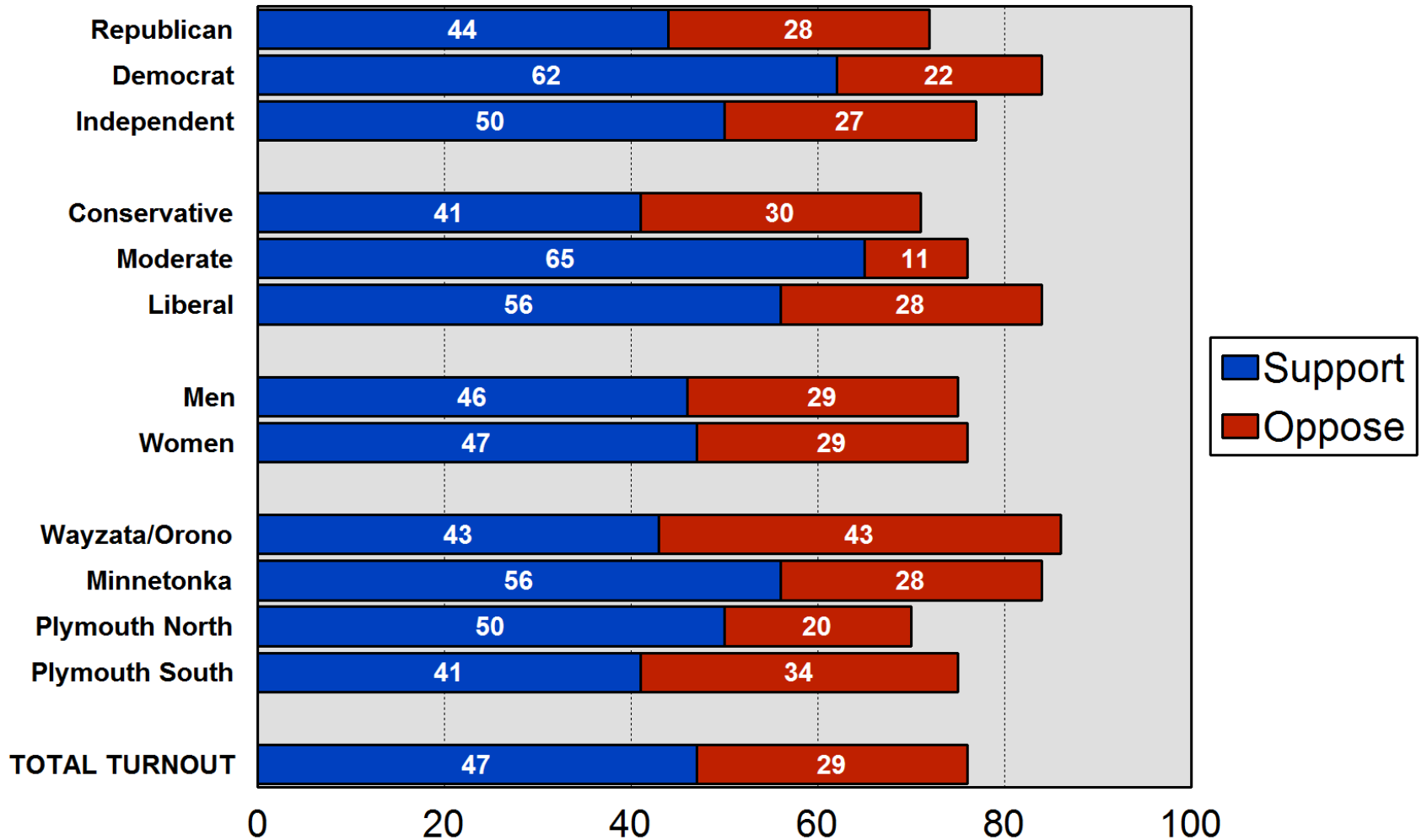
