Subject: **Extension of Superintendent's Contract**

Recommendation:

The Waverly Community Schools' Board of Education President recommends the Board extends the Superintendent's contract following a successful evaluation.

Statement of Purpose:

State law provides that a Superintendent's contract can be no longer than five years. The Superintendent's contract has two (2) remaining years through June of 2016.

Historical Perspective/Background:

The Superintendent's Contract of Employment (Section 7) states the contract may be extended by the Board at its discretion, if in the opinion of the Board, the Superintendent's performance merits such an extension.

Discussion of Options:

The Board has two options: No extension or extension of one (1) to three (3) years.

Rationale for Recommendation:

The Superintendent has demonstrated, through Board evaluation, successful management of the Waverly Community Schools. The contract extension offers personal job security for the Superintendent, which in turn results in a high level of job satisfaction and performance.
