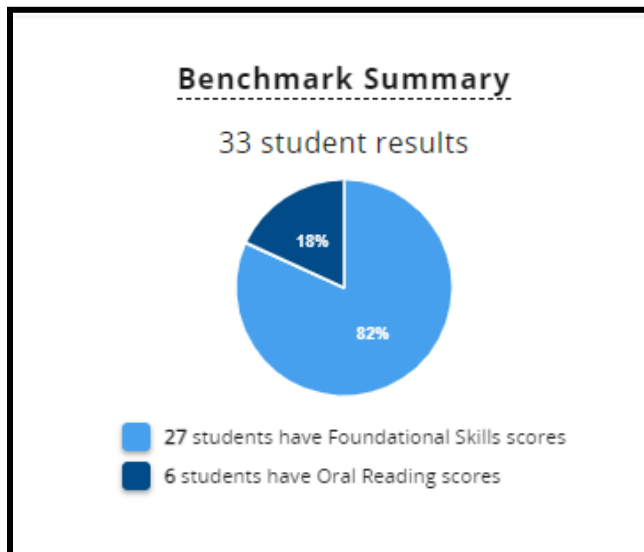

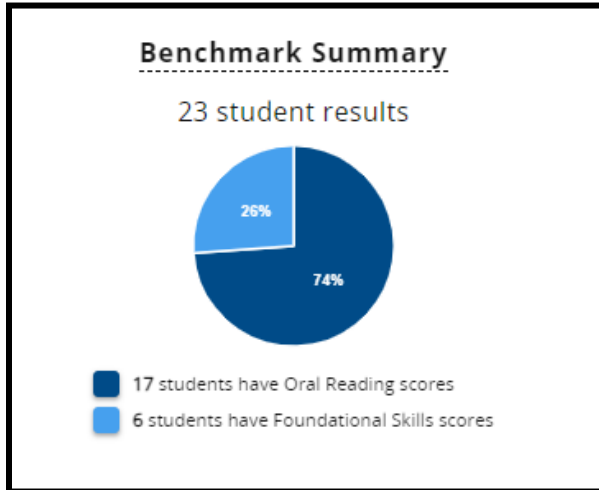

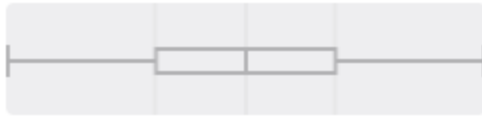
Second Grade



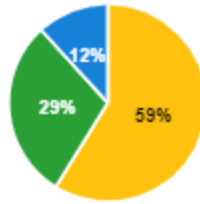

Oral Reading Rate ?



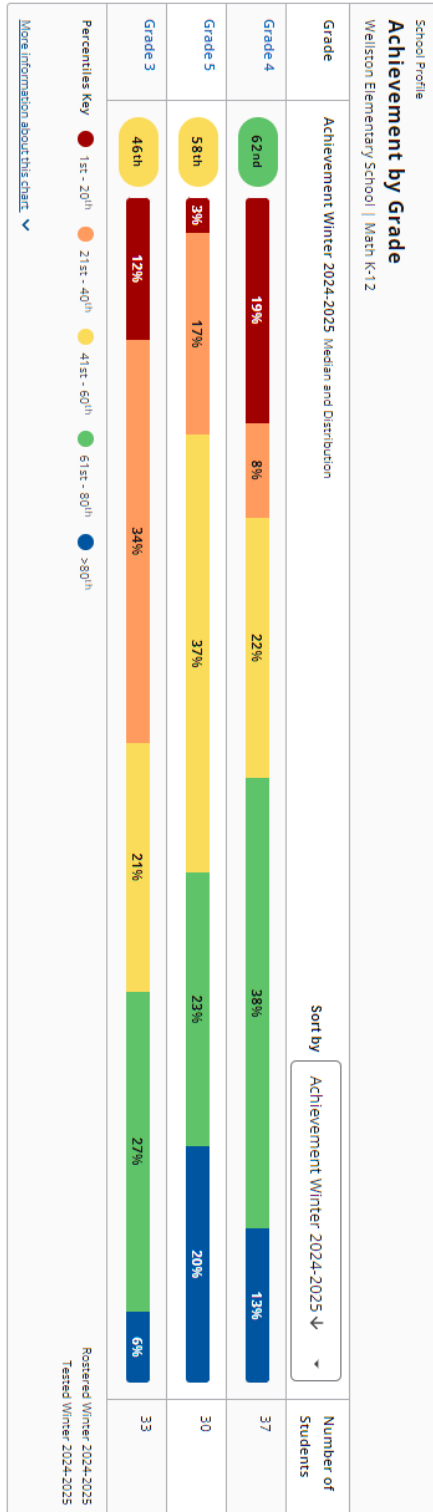

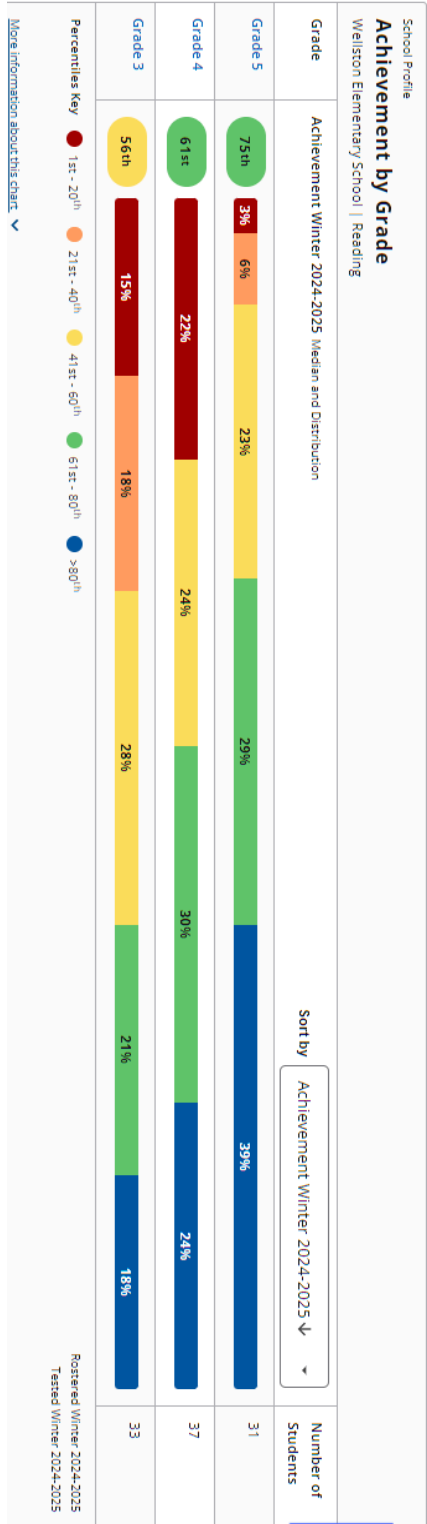
