- On the expenditure side, we have had some early expenditures compared to last year. Again, security is up \$48,000 compared to last year.
- Hopefully, over the next few months this will even out some.
- Oct. 1st was the cut-off for reporting on our enrollment data. This drives our WADM at midterm. As we have discussed, I was expecting to see a larger number due to enrollment and special education and that is bearing out so far. No way to accurately predict because there is just some state level information I can't have access to, but we should have a good revenue jump in state aid.
