- Expected to maintain professional dress, appearance, and behavior.

#### **4025 Superintendent**

- Superintendent hired by and reports to the board.
- Chief administrative officer with authority to make operational decisions.

- Supervises all employees; can hire/terminate classified staff and recommend certified staff.
- Oversees grounds and buildings.
- Other duties per contract/job description/board assignment.

#### **4027 Part-Time Certified Employees**

- Defines calculation of part-time teacher's percentage of time (teaching + prep ÷ school day).
- Extracurriculars not included.
- Salary, benefits, and leave based on negotiated agreement and percentage of time worked.
