c. Superintendent - Josh Sumrall

Mr. Sumrall applied for a \$25,000 grant for local beef. We put it out to bids for local farmers and we had 5 bid on it. We also had some local people call and find out how to get on that

vendor list for next time. We awarded the bid to Native Acres. \$7.50 a pound. There was one lower bid at \$7 a pound but it was out of Minco but we could award to our local people. It is a little over 3,000 pounds of beef.

d. Financial Report

\$3.6 million in general and \$2.2 million in the building fund. Mr. Alig asked about our valuation going down. He asked if Mr. Sumrall has talked to the assessor and Mr. Sumrall has along with other Supt's in the county. They have voiced their concerns about how she has made some deals with tax protests. Mr. Alig would like to look into whether we got the state aide money for teacher pay raises.
