The coop committee met and presented highlights including extra duty assignments, coach's evaluation tool and handbook changes.

Superintendent Redinger's report presented information on the following: employment needs, NASB Area Membership Meeting, building sprinklers, looking into splash guards for drainage,

painting for front of building in mid September, help with van for neighboring school when their bus broke down, roofing leaks repaired and HVAC needs completed by months end.
